RED BULLET RETIRED

Red Bullet (Unbridled--Cargo, by Caro {Ire}), the winner of the 2000 GI Preakness S., has been retired and will stand the 2003 breeding season at Adena Springs Kentucky in Midway. The five-year-old made his final career start in the Nov. 30 GI Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct, finishing seventh. In addition to his Classic victory, the chestnut also captured the 2000 GIII Gotham S. and the 2002 Foggy Road S. at Delaware Park in his penultimate start. He was second in the GII Wood Memorial and third in the GII Dwyer S. at three, third in the GI Cigar Mile at four and second in the GIII Skip Away S. at five. Overall, he compiled a record of six wins, two seconds and two thirds from 14 outings for earnings of \$1,161,920. "As a Classic winner by one of the world's best sires of sires, Red Bullet offers breeders an extraordinary opportunity," Adena Springs owner Frank Stronach said. "He has the speed, the race record, the looks and the pedigree to be a world-class sire." Red Bullet's 2003 stud fee will be \$30,000.

Dupont Called Up...

Dupont (GB) (Zafonic) has been invited to replace **Decarchy** (Distant View) in next Sunday's G1 Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin. The William Haggas-trained colt took the G2 Premio Parioli at Rome May 1 and G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen at Cologne May 20 before finishing fourth behind Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 18.

Fairy King Prawn Out of Sprint...

Trainer Ivan Allan has withdrawn **Fairy King Prawn (Aus)** (Danehill) from the G1 Hong Kong Sprint. His spot in the line-up has been awarded to **Anabatik (Aus)** (Anabaa), a winner in five of his eight career starts. The three-year-old gelding was third, beaten a length and a half, in the International Sprint Trial last time out.

SUNLINE SELLING AT KEENELAND JANUARY

Southern Hemisphere star **Sunline (NZ)** (Desert Sun {GB}) headlines the 1,907 horses catalogued for the Keeneland January Horses of All Ages Sale, which will be held in Lexington, Kentucky Jan. 6-10. Winner of 13 Group 1 races and a three-time Australasian Horse of the Year, the bay mare was retired in late October with earnings of over A\$11 million. The seven-year-old will head through the ring as hip 134. "Sunline is a phenomenal horse," said Geoffrey Russell, Keeneland's director of sales. "We are very fortunate to offer her at our sale. With the record she amassed, she will long be considered one of the best horses to ever race anywhere." Keeneland will offer 913 broodmares, 232 broodmare prospects, 130 racing/broodmare prospects, 492 yearlings and 116 racing prospects as well as six stallions. "We've been very encouraged by what we have seen in the middle markets this year," Russell added. "We hope that bodes well for this sale." Among the covering sires are Coronado's Quest, Forestry, Forest Wildcat, Fusaichi Pegasus, Giant's Causeway, Monarchos, Pulpit, Tiznow, Unbridled's Song and the late Saint Ballado. At the 2002 auction, 936 head grossed \$34,688,000 for an average price of \$37,059.

Of the 345 mares who will go through the ring, **Panarea (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}), a full sister to G1 Prix Saint-Alary winner Marotta (Fr) in foal to King Charlemagne (Nureyev), should attract significant interest. Other eye-catching mares include Haras de Bernesq's offerings **Celtic Miss (GB)** (Celtic Swing {GB}), a half sister to Deputy Governor carrying a foal by Cape Cross (Ire), and **Shadai Stone (Jpn)** (Real Shadai), a daughter of Breeders' Cup Turf heroine Pebbles (GB) in foal to Spinning World. The pick of the Haras d'Etream draft may be **Torreglia (Ire)** (Elmaamul), a 3/4 sister to Halling in foal to Septième Ciel. Of the 170 foals to be sold, first-season sires Diktat (GB) (Warning {GB}), Indian Danehill (Ire) (Danehill), Sendawar (Ire) (Priolo) and Xaar (GB) (Zafonic) will be represented. GREAT STATE CHALLENGE DRAWS 48 A total of 48 horses from 10 different states have been entered for the first-ever NTRA Great State Challenge, to be held this afternoon at Sam Houston Park in Texas. The Challenge, which is comprised of six races worth \$275,000 apiece, is restricted to horses from states where the official horsemen's association is a member of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association. Horses will earn points for their state based on their finishes in the Challenge. The state that collects the most points will be named the NTRA Great State Challenge Champion. Kentucky has the largest contingent for the event with 11, followed by Texas and Maryland with eight each and Florida with seven. The other states taking the Challenge are California (4), Illinois (3), Washington (3), Indiana (2), Iowa (1) and New York (1). The shortest-priced morning-line favorite is Kentucky representative and multiple Grade I winner **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere), who is 2-5 for the Great State Challenge Distaff. Stakes winner **Souris** (Defrere) (KY), third in the Pocahontas S. at Churchill Downs last time, is the choice in the Juvenile Fillies. **Only The Best** (Smokester) (CA) tops the Juvenile, **My Cousin Matt** (Matty G) (FL) is favored in the Sprint, **Forbidden Apple** (Pleasant Colony) (FL) headlines the Turf and Iowa Derby hero **Easyfromthegitgo** (Dehere) (KY) is the early chalk for the Classic.

Florida's top two-year-old filly **Ivanavinalot** (West Acre) has returned to training after spending a month on the farm. She was forced to scratch out of the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies with a high white blood cell count. "She came back here on Thanksgiving week-end and is doing super," said trainer Kathleen O'Connell. "She had a good 30 days on the farm just being a horse, enjoying the sunshine and grass--never saw tack. She's galloping and is probably two weeks from her first breeze." Ivanavinalot will likely return to action on Sunshine Millions Day at Gulfstream Jan. 25.

Suffolk to Increase Stakes Purses:

Suffolk Downs has raised the minimum purse for stakes races to \$35,000 for the 2003 Winter-Spring meet that begins Jan. 1. With the increase, the Suffolk stakes will remain eligible for black type.

SELKIRK HONOURED AT TBA AWARDS Selkirk (Sharpen Up {GB}) was yesterday named the leading British-based flat stallion at the 2002 Thoroughbred Breeders' Association Awards. Lanwades Stud's owner Kirsten Rausing, who stands the stallion alongside **Hernando (Fr)** (Niniski), commented, "I am naturally delighted that Selkirk has received this award, particularly as our other stallion Hernando is also a leading British-based sire [by progeny earnings in Europe]. I am personally very pleased at the recognition that Selkirk has now achieved, particularly as I have only started with three stallions from scratch--namely Niniski who achieved a TBA award for first season-sire in 1984; his son Hernando [leading British-based sire in Europe] and now Selkirk." That stallion was the narrow victor over Darley Stud's **Machiavellian** (Mr. Prospector) in total prize money. Cheveley Park Stud picked up an award with the deceased **Polar Falcon** (Nureyev), who produced the most individual flat winners, while the National Stud took the award for leading first-season British-based flat sire with **Air Express (Ire)** (Salse), who also died this year.

LODER TO RETIRE David Loder, who served the last four years as a private trainer for Godolphin's two-year-olds, has announced that he will retire following the 2003 season. "It's time for me to do other things," said the 38-year-old, who will give up his position at Desert Stables in Dubai and Godolphin stables in Newmarket. "I will hand in my licence at the end of next season and after that I plan to be very much involved in the bloodstock world. I have one or two interesting projects to look at." Although **Desert Prince (Ire)** (Green Desert) provided the conditioner with his highest-profile successes in the 1998 G1 Queen Elizabeth II S., G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and G1 Prix du Moulin, it was with the Maktoum family's horses that Loder excelled. Among the best horses he trained were **Diktat (GB)** (Warning {GB}), **Noverre** (Rahy), **Lujain** (Seeking the Gold) and **Starborough (GB)** (Soviet Star). He singled out **Dubai Millennium (GB)** (Seeking the Gold) for owner Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum to rename as a two-year-old. "I am very disappointed that David has decided to give up training, but I understand his reasons," Sheikh Mohammed said yesterday. "I would have liked him to continue, but he was adamant that he wanted to stop and I must respect that. I would like to place on record my appreciation of the excellent work he has done for Godolphin. He was a key member of our team." Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford said that no decision had been made on the direction of the Godolphin juveniles from 2004.

JOCKEY CLUB INVESTIGATES MORPHINE CASES

British and Irish racing authorities are reacting to a current spate of samples testing positive for morphine, it was announced yesterday. Issuing a statement yesterday, the Jockey Club confirmed that "the Turf Club and the Jockey Club are gravely concerned that in recent days, over 20 samples in Ireland and Britain have screened positive for morphine, which is a prohibited substance." It continued, "To date, eight of the samples have been confirmed as positive. The contamination appears to have arisen from feed, and tests are ongoing to identify the source of the problem."

TAX-FREE STATUS REMAINS INTACT

Despite fears that the Irish bloodstock industry would lose its tax-exempt status for stallions, the Irish government did not tackle the issue in the budget speech on Wednesday. With the 33-year exemption providing an estimated stallion income of €100 million per year, the bloodstock industry contributes €150 million per annum in export earnings as well as employing 25,000 people. Having campaigned against the proposed changes to the tax status, Jock O'Connor, chairman of the Irish Thoroughbred Breeders' Association, told the *Racing Post*, "It is good for the breeding industry and I think it's good for the country too."
