### TWO STRAIGHT STAKES FOR THE SNAKE

Winless in three starts overseas, **Snake Mountain** (A.P. Indy) won for the sixth time in 10 tries in the U.S., taking yesterday's GIII Queens County H. at Aqueduct. Fourth in the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 17, the gelding bounced back with a 2 1/2-length allowance tally at Belmont Oct. 4 and was coming into this off a half-length score in the GIII Stuyvesant H. on Election Day. Perfectly placed in fourth down the backstretch, the chestnut angled out four wide for the drive and held sway to defeat **Docent** (Waquoit). "We had to go a little wide today, but it doesn't matter. This horse keeps dig-

### MCKEE: SUNLINE WILL NOT SELL

Trevor McKee, the co-owner and trainer of Australasian sensation **Sunline (NZ)** (Desert Sun {GB}), told the *Daily New Zealand Thoroughbred News* that the seven-year-old mare will not go through the ring during the January Horses of All Ages sale at Keeneland. "She is still here and will definitely not be going through that sale," McKee told the *News*. She was to have been consigned by Taylor Made on the opening day of the sale Jan. 6. "She was entered by them [Taylor Made] about a month ago after an approach was made to us. The current situation is that she will not be going to the Keeneland auction and at this stage she has not changed hands," McKee added.

### SARASOLA DISPERSAL TOPS DEAUVILLE DAY 1

The five-year-old broodmare **Hidalguia (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}), part of the 29-horse dispersal from the estate of Enrique Sarasola, brought a final bid of €530,000 to top the opening day of L'Agence Francaise's December Mixed Sale in Deauville yesterday. A Group 3 winner in foal to Rainbow Quest, **Hidalguia** was purchased by Charlie Gordon-Watson. Two hips later, the mare's full sister, the three-year-old **Hispalis (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}), was hammered down for €160,000 as the dispersal's second-highest priced lot. She was purchased by B Le Metayer Bloodstock. The second dam of the duo is Group 1 winner Hurry Harriet II (GB) (Yrrah Jr.), who is herself the dam of Grade I winner Load the Cannons (Cannonade). For the Sarasola dispersal, a total of 28 lots were reported as sold for gross receipts of €1,427,000 and an average of €50,964. The unraced three-year-old filly **Shemita (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), a daughter of G1 Prix de Diane winner Shemaka (Ire) (Nishapour {Fr}), topped the main section of the sale, bringing €300,000. Consigned by The Aga Khan's Studs SC, the bay was purchased by F Sauque. She is from the family of G1 Epsom and Irish Derby winner Shahrastani (Ire) and Grade I winner Sharannpour (Ire). The three-day sale continues this morning at 10 a.m. (*Toppers, p4*)

Third in a Saratoga money allowance test Sept. 2, Wander Mom was no match for **Tates Creek** and company when seventh in the **GIII Noble Damsel H.** at Belmont Sept. 21, but atoned for that effort with a solid runner-up finish sprinting a grassy seven-eighths over a yielding Belmont turf Oct. 21. She most recently celebrated her return to the Sunshine state with a 2 1/2-length victory over this turf course Nov. 9, but was a generous 9-1 on the hike back up in class. On an afternoon where speed was king (or queen in this case), jockey **Eibar Coa** sent the chestnut to the front and got away with pedestrian splits of :25 and :49 3/5. She shook loose after a sharp third quarter mile, carried a two-length advantage past the eighth pole and just held off a furious late rally from **Strawberry Blonde**, with favored **Babae** another half length back in third. "I didn't plan for her to go to the front, it just kind of developed," admitted winning trainer **Eddie Plesa, Jr.** "[Jockey] **Eibar [Coa]** is a great judge of pace and was able to take advantage."

Chispiski held a 5 1/2-length advantage at the eighth pole and needed every inch of that cushion to prevail over the late-running Abundantly Blessed. The Florida-bred bay had a four-race skein snapped when running second in a Calder optional claimer Aug. 12, but she came back to add victories in the Roamin Rachel H. Sept. 5 and the U Can Do It H. Oct. 5. Second in the Birdie Belle H. Nov. 10 at this oval, she was sent off at 9-1 in this eight-horse field, each of whom was seeking their first graded-stakes victory. Chispiski rushed up to take the lead soon after the break with an opening quarter of :21.72 and began to inch away approaching the stretch. She opened up a lonely lead by midstretch, but she began to tire and found the wire just in time. "This is a very fast filly, but I had some doubts about her going seven-eighths," trainer Ron Spatz explained. Debonair Joe shifted out dramatically at midstretch and powered past F J's Pace in the waning strides to give Julie Krone her first stakes victory since returning to riding a month ago. The gelding, a stakes winner at two, was claimed from his breeders for \$12,500 at the Fairplex, but recouped those costs with a win versus \$28,000 company at Santa Anita Oct. 10. Third for a \$40,000 tag in Arcadia Oct. 26, the bay shipped to Northern California to defeat \$40K optional claimers at Golden Gate Nov. 8, but was understandably the longest shot in his graded-stakes debut. Settled a bit off the rail for the run up the backstretch, he advanced approaching the stretch, came out under a full head of steam leaving the eighth pole and was along late for the win. "When a longshot like this wins, it just goes to show you that you can't have any preconceived notions," the winning rider said. "You always have to try hard and have faith." Men's Exclusive (Exclusive Ribot), looking for a third consecutive victory in this event, had every chance in deep stretch, but was outfinished and settled for a close fourth. Krieger returned from a 10-month hiatus to finish second to Balto Star in a swiftly run turf allowance at Saratoga Aug. 11 prior to finishing an even eighth behind Good Journey in the GI Atto Mile at Woodbine Sept. 8. Fourth after setting the early pace in the GII Kelso H. at Belmont Oct. 5, the homebred dropped in to wire a field of Aqueduct allowance foes by 2 1/4 lengths Oct. 31. The chestnut colt stumbled slightly out of the gate, but recovered and set a comfortable pace in hand for the opening six furlongs. He kicked it in leaving the three-eighths pole and covered that final distance in a shade less than 35 seconds en route to victory. "He's got speed, but you don't have to run as hard as you do going a mile," winning trainer Joe Orseno said. "I was concerned when he stumbled coming out of the gate, but he recovered well." The winner could make his next start in the GII Appleton H. at Gulfstream Jan. 4. The race lost some of its luster when morning-line favorite Band Is Passing (Pass the Line) was declared yesterday morning. [Click here](#) for the **brisnet.com** chart.

**BAND IS PASSING SCRATCHED AT CALDER**

**Band Is Passing** (Pass the Line), the 5-2 morning-line favorite for yesterday's GIII Tropical Turf H. at Calder, was scratched due to a minor ankle problem. "He's fine now, but he had a little swelling in an ankle Thursday morning," owner/breeder/trainer Stanley Ersoff said. "I think it might have just been an allergic reaction of some kind from a topical lotion or something like that. We put him in ice and it came right down." But, he added, "In any event, I wouldn't want to run him when I'm not as sure as I can be that he is 100 percent. It wouldn't be fair to the horse or to the public. It was just a matter of exercising due caution." The six-year-old, who dead-heated for second in the 2000 Tropical Park Turf, won the race last year.

**Godolphin Duo Arrive...**

**Noverre** (Rahy) and **Ekraar** (Red Ransom) arrived in Hong Kong yesterday, joining stable companion **Grandera** (Ire) (Grand Lodge) ahead of next Sunday's International meeting at Sha Tin. Noverre will represent Godolphin in the G1 Hong Kong Mile, while Ekraar will bid to go one better than when runner-up last year in the G1 Hong Kong Vase over 12 furlongs. Grandera has pleased trainer Saeed bin Suroor as he gets ready for the G1 Hong Kong Cup. "The good thing about Grandera is that he is a very tough horse," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "That is the reason we have sent him all over the world--Dubai, Singapore, Australia, Ireland, England and Hong Kong." Other European challengers to touch down yesterday included **Aquarelliste** (Fr) (Danehill), **Agnetha** (Ger) (Big Shuffle), **Continent** (GB) (Lake Coniston {Ire}), **Dano-Mast** (GB) (Unfuwain) and **Paolini** (Ger) (Lando {Ger}).

**The Latest Withdrawals...**

Trainer Marcus Tregoning has been forced to withdraw **Mubtaker** (Silver Hawk) from the Vase due to a "below par" workout on Friday. "Unfortunately, he's not going to go because we weren't particularly happy with him yesterday. We decided we couldn't possibly run him," Tregoning told *PA Sport*. Tregoning now hopes to send the G2 Geoffrey Freer S. winner to Dubai for a tilt at the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. **Rainbow and Gold** (Gulch) will take Mubtaker's place in the line-up. The five-year-old, who raced as Garcia Marquez in the U.S., captured Hong Kong's Centenary Vase earlier this year.

**WALTER VISCHER DIES**

Walter Vischer, one of Germany's prime thoroughbred breeders, died Nov. 27 in Baden Baden. Among his most famous acquisitions was the broodmare Prairie Rose (GB). Purchased as a yearling at the start of the 1960s, she went on to become a notable foundation mare for the domestic breeding scene. Her Group 1-winning descendants include the leading sire Platini (Ger) and Paolini (Ger). Vischer's Zank (Ger) earned Derby glory in both Germany and Austria and was a top German sire as well. Vischer owned Ballylea Stud in Ireland until the late 1980s and also initiated foal shares with Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum more than 10 years ago that resulted in stakes winners Royal Touch (GB), Mardonius (GB) and Foresee (GB).
