SHASHZAYA TOPS DAY TWO AT DEAUVILLE

Day two at Deauville's December Mixed Sale progressed smoothly with session totals gaining slightly in both gross receipts and average while RNAs increased from 25 percent in 2001 to 28 percent in Sunday's action. Lot 294, the four-year-old filly **Shashzaya (Ire)** (Ashkalani {Ire}--Shashna {Ire}, by Blakeney {GB}), earned top honors when she was hammered down for €250,000 to the MAB Agency. Consigned by His Highest the Aga Khan's Studs SC, the unraced Shashzaya is a half sister to Group 1-winning Shemaka (Ire) (Nishapour {Fr}) and is believed to be in foal to Marju (Ire). Peter Boyle Bloodstock nabbed the second highest-priced lot on the afternoon after going to €110,000 for **Mouriyana (Ire)** (Akarad {Fr}--Mamoura {Ire}), by Lomond). The six-year-old mare, who won at first asking as a two-year-old, is a half sister to Mouramara (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}), winner of the G2 Prix de Royallieu in France. She is in foal to Highest Honor (Fr) and was also consigned by HH the Aga Khan's Studs SC. The third and final session kicks off today at 10:00 a.m.

WAKE AT NOON CANADA'S HORSE OF THE YEAR

Wake at Noon (Cure the Blues) was honored as Canada's Horse of the Year at the 28th Annual Sovereign Awards at the Fairmont Royal York Hotel in Toronto Saturday. The five-year-old, who scored in Woodbine's GIII Vigil H. and GIII Highlander H. earlier this year, also collected top honors in the sprint and older horse divisions. Owned and bred by Bruno Shickedanz, the Ontario-bred won 16 of 35 career starts and has amassed earnings of \$1,245,696 over four seasons on the track. **Added Edge** (Smart Strike), who was also in the running for Horse of the Year honors, garnered a juvenile championship for owner Team Valor and trainer Mark Casse. The Kentucky-bred colt won the Swynford S. and the Silver Deputy S., both at Woodbine, before capping off his juvenile campaign with a 2 1/4-length score in the GIII Nashua S. at Aqueduct Nov. 2. A perfect four for four, the chestnut has earned \$250,328 to date.

ARGENTINE STAR MISS TERRIBLE SOLD TO U.S. INTERESTS Argentine Triple Crown winner **Miss Terrible (Arg)** (Numerous--Teidi {Arg}, by Farnesio {Arg}) has been purchased by Chip and Carol Hammersmith, reports the *Thoroughbred Times*. Brad Ross, representing the Elburn, Illinois residents, paid well over six figures to acquire the three-year-old filly, who will be sent to Florida to clear quarantine. Argentine bloodstock agent Luis Bouza brokered the deal on behalf of the fillies' owner and breeder Juan Carlos Bago's Haras Firmamento. Originally scheduled for Sunday's G1 Copa de Plata, the full sister to Group winner Miss Tita (Arg) will miss an attempt at extending her record to eight-straight Group 1 wins. A winner of five races from six starts as a juvenile, the filly is a perfect three-for-three as a sophomore, including victories in the G1 Premio Enrique Acebal and the G1 Argentine 1000 Guineas (Polla de Potrancas).

Xtra Heat, sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint behind Orientate Oct. 26, has won 24 of 32 lifetime starts for earnings of \$2,223,305.

Housebuster Mare Tops Fasig-Tipton:

The unraced Housebuster mare **Jennymeg**, out of the Green Forest mare Astreak, was the highest-priced hip through the ring yesterday at the opening session of Fasig-Tipton's Midlantic December Mixed Sale at the Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium, Maryland. Hector Alcalde paid \$50,000 for the Muirfield East (agent) consignee, whose first foal, the Smoke Glacken three-year-old filly Smoke Buster, won the T.T.A Sales Futurity S. in 2001. Jennymeg is believed to be in foal to Two Punch. Today's second and final session will offer weanlings by sires such as Not for Love, Pine Bluff, Belong to Me and current freshman sire Deputy Commander, as well as yearlings by freshman sires Awesome Again, Cape Town, Awad and Lucky Lionel. Bidding gets under way at 10 a.m.

Rock Slide became the fourth stakes winner for his dam with this brave effort on the front end. The bay colt doubled up on allowance victories at Ellis and Arlington before being the runner-up to Crafty Shaw in the GIII Turfway Fall Championship H. Sept. 28. He returned Nov. 19 to run second by 3/4-lengths to GISW Booklet in a Churchill allowance, a showing which earned him a Beyer Speed Figure of 115. Breaking from post seven, he cleared the field early, set soft fractions and had enough to narrowly withstand Discreet Hero's prolonged challenge. "It was a very salty race and I'm thrilled with the way the horse ran," said winning trainer Neil Howard. "The ultimate goal would be the New Orleans H. [GII, Mar. 2, \$500,000]."

Madame Pietra, the winner of the Soviet Problem H. at Golden Gates last spring, weakened late in the restricted Fantastic Girl S. at Del Mar Aug. 3 to place in that return from a 4 1/2-month layoff. Once again the runner-up almost three weeks later in a 6 1/2-furlong optional claimer over that surface, the mare was given another two-month breather. Sent off the solid choice due to a two-length score last time in the Cascapedia S. at Santa Anita Oct. 31, the dark bay would have to meet the challenge of multiple Grade 1 winner Habibti this time. Harrisand stamped himself as one to watch among California turfers with this impressive effort. A winner of three of four starts in France, he had mixed success since moving stateside, finishing third in the Gill Kent Breeders' Cup H. at three and, in his most recent outing, winning a Belmont allowance May 26. The crowd's choice stalked the pace from third, loomed boldly turning for home and pulled away powerfully.

SEA OF SHOWERS (f, 3, Seattle Slew--Chimes of Freedom {G1SW-GB & Ire, \$503,431}, by Private Account) unleashed a powerful turn of foot to win her U.S. bow. The royally-bred bay had run a close third in the G3 Prix de Sandringham June 2 at Chantilly and concluded her French campaign with a fifth in the G3 Prix Chloe June 26. Off since then, she broke slowly and raced near the back of the pack before gradually making up ground on the inside heading into the far turn. Still well back at the top of the stretch, she angled to the far outside and closed with a rush and ran right by Teresa Ann (Boston Harbor) for a two-length tally.
