26, is the headliner in the GI Hollywood Starlet at Hollywood Park this afternoon. "I was disappointed she didn't win the Breeders' Cup--I think she lacked one more race," trainer Bob Baffert said. "She's been doing great." Prior to her half-length defeat in the Breeders' Cup, the bay posted a

three-length victory in the Oct. 6 GII Oak Leaf S. going the Starlet distance at Santa Anita. **Summer Wind Dancer** (Siberian Summer) also has a stakes win at a mile and a sixteenth, closing to win the Nov. 2 Cal Cup Juvenile Fillies by a half length. The gray, three-for-four versus fellow state-breds, makes her first foray into open company. **Watching You** (Coronado's Quest) tries two turns for the first time in her graded-stakes debut. The chestnut bested **Rmisvesta** (Boston Harbor) by 2 1/2 lengths in her six-furlong career opener Oct. 5, then stretched out to seven furlongs and dueled for the lead before settling for second in the Nov. 16 Mocassin S.

Champion **Xtra Heat** gives her eight rivals from 11 to 15 pounds in her first start since running sixth in the Oct. 26 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. The four-year-old filly, who finished off the board in a sprint for the first time in her career in that event, has compiled an outstanding record of 14 wins from her 19 starts at six furlongs. She will sport the ClassicStar colors for the first time, running in this event for new owners S. David Plummer, Tony Ferguson, Thom Robinson and John Parrott after being purchased privately for \$1.5 million. She will continue to race through March, and possibly until the end of next year, if she stays sound. "If she comes out of this good, we'll look at the Barbara Fritchie [GII, at Laurel Park Feb. 15] and then the race in Dubai [G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Nad al Sheba Mar. 29]," trainer John Salzman Jr. commented.

**Malhub's Sprint Run in Doubt...**

**Malhub** (Kingmambo) may have to miss his start in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint after tying up Thursday. The four-year-old colt appeared to be better yesterday morning, according to trainer John Gosden. "He certainly was a little muscle tight after work [Thursday], so he just had a walk and a trot [Friday]," Gosden said. "I am very happy with him. He is on good terms with himself, is loose and moving very freely--we are very much back on course." But the Hong Kong Jockey Club's senior veterinary surgeon, Dr. K.L. Watkins, said yesterday he considers the G1 Golden Jubilee S. winner a doubtful starter Sunday. Malhub will be examined by Watkins, HKJC veterinary surgeon Dr. C.P.H. Osborne and HKJC senior veterinary officer Dr. Brian Stewart today before a final decision on his Sprint status is reached.

**Indian Creek Preps for the Cup...**

Group 3 winner **Indian Creek (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), sixth in the G1 Champion S. last time out, tuned up for the G1 Hong Kong Cup yesterday on the turf at Sha Tin, clicking off 400 meters in :22.70. "He is naturally a lazy horse, so that was a good effort," trainer David Elsworth said. "I am very, very pleased with him, though I am now rather nervous as things are so right, it can only go wrong." G1 Hong Kong Mile hopeful **Dupont (GB)** (Zafonic), winner of the G2 Italian 2000 Guineas and G2 German 2000 Guineas, worked in company with Indian Creek with jockey Darryll Holland in the irons. "I was very pleased with him," Holland said. Added trainer William Haggas, "The horse is in good shape. Whether he is good enough is another question--all I can say is that I am very happy with his health."

**Aquarelliste Stretches Her Legs...**

Three-time Group 1 winner **Aquarelliste (Fr)** (Danehill), coming off a solid sixth-place finish in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, was out on Sha Tin's all-weather surface yesterday morning, quickening in the straight to come home the final 400 meters in a 3/4-speed :25.30. "That was just what we wanted," trainer Elie Lellouche said. "We're just looking forward to the race now." The four-year-old filly takes on the boys again in the G1 Hong Kong Vase.

**RECORD PRICE AT HONG KONG SALE** A colt by Desert King (Ire) brought a final bid of HK\$4.8 million to set a record at the Hong Kong International Sale, held yesterday evening. Trainer John Moore, bidding on behalf of a partnership comprised of Hong Kong shipping magnate George Chang and neurosurgeon Dr. Andrew Wong, signed the ticket on the sales topper, who is a 3/4 brother to Australian champion filly Ha Ha (Aus). Moore and Wong first met in the early 1980s. The trainer's brother-in-law, jockey Phillippe Paquet, was involved in a spill during morning workouts and suffered severe injuries, and Wong was the surgeon who saved Paquet's life. Moore was pleased with the amount he paid for the colt. "It's a great purchase," he said. The price broke the record that had been set just four hips earlier when a colt by Danehill went for HK\$4.7 million to Hong Kong real estate developer Rusty M. Shroff, MBE. The grey, a half-brother to MGSW Le Zagaletta (Aus) (Last Tycoon {Ire}), will be trained by Geoff Lane. "I saw him breeze at Sha Tin last Sunday and was highly impressed," Shroff said. As there are no reserves, all 35 lots through the ring sold. The four horses that topped the HK\$2 million mark were bred and raised in the Southern Hemisphere, and all four had Danehill as their sire or paternal grandsire. While the record price for an individual was broken for the third consecutive year, the average for the sale was down nearly 4 percent. Still, Hong Kong Jockey Club Director of Racing Winfried Engelbrecht-Breges was encouraged by the results. "All in all, we have to be happy with the results this year," he said. "Our buyers are discerning about conformation and open-minded about pedigrees. We saw some very wise bidding to-night." For complete results, click [here](#).

**NTRA LEADS THE WAY** An optimistic report on new and responsive wagering integrity initiatives spearheaded by the National Thoroughbred Racing Association drew favorable reviews from attendees on the closing day of the University of Arizona's Symposium on Racing. "The events of Oct. 26 [Breeders' Cup Pick Six scandal] should be a major wake-up call to racing," declared Tim Smith, commissioner and chief executive officer of the NTRA. "We think Oct. 26 can actually be an historic and positive date for our industry--a day that 'good enough' ended and a transition to best practices began." In the six weeks since the Breeders' Cup, under the leadership of the NTRA, disparate segments of the racing industry have joined forces to initiate sweeping changes. Long-needed technological enhancements have been forced upon the totalisator companies, and industry leaders have reached out to core customers, soliciting their input and taking action based upon their responses. Coordinated, consistent communications with the media, fans, track operators and regulators have been raised to a new level. Tote companies are in the process of installing software changes to eliminate the delayed transmission of multiple leg bets. Upgrades will be completed on all systems in the U.S. and Canada before the end of the year.

**Core Players Voice Concerns...**

James Quinn, a noted handicapping author and professional bettor, reported on surveys and focus group sessions conducted with over 200 core players (handicappers that wager over \$1,000 per week). The findings highlighted several serious concerns, key of which were overall tote system security and the fairness of the wagering process to all participants. "Even though the facts show otherwise, the perception that cheating is pervasive must be stopped," Quinn, echoing the sentiments of many of the players he surveyed, said. The cycle times for transmitting odds data throughout the country are in the process of being reduced from the current 45 seconds to 30. The goal ultimately is to transmit bets from simulcast outlets into host track pools in as close to "real time" as technology will permit. Moves are already underway to shave close to a minute off the time it takes to transmit pools and update closing odds once a race has started.

**PRIZE MONEY BOOST FOR IRELAND**

Ireland's racing authority, Horse Racing Ireland (HRI), has announced a record level of prize money for next year. The overall prize fund is set to rise by €3.4 million to €49 million, with HRI's contribution to be €27.9 million. The increase in HRI's prize money allocation was agreed upon to ensure that the base value of races can be maintained and in some cases improved despite the addition of 20 new fixtures. There will be no reduction in the absolute minimum values and no change to the pattern race minimum values for 2003. Below pattern race standard, higher quality races have been pinpointed for prize-money increases by the racing authority. HRI's Director of Racing Jason Morris told *PA Sport*, "Horse Racing Ireland has reaffirmed its commitment to offering prize money which bears the most favourable international comparison. By revising and simplifying the structure for distributing prize money, HRI intends to ensure that all horses are rewarded broadly in accordance with their ability throughout their careers."

**JAPAN AND HONG KONG TO FIGHT ILLEGAL**

**GAMING** The Japan Racing Association and the Hong Kong Jockey Club yesterday signed a formal agreement aimed at fighting illegal gambling in their two countries. Under the agreement, the JRA and the HKJC will refuse to accept bets from residents of the other organization's country, and they will not market wagering without prior authorization from their partner in this 'Good Neighbor Policy.' HKJC Chairman Ronald Arculli said, "By signing this agreement, we aim to draw a clear line between those racing organizations which respect the integrity of other racing jurisdictions and those illegal and unauthorized operators which don't." He added, "Recognizing the challenge, the Executive Council of the Asian Racing Federation has already endorsed the Good Neighbor Policy as something good for the region. Moreover, racing's highest body, the International Federation of Horseracing Authorities, is now developing a Good Neighbor Policy framework for member jurisdictions to adopt. I urge all racing jurisdictions to join us in expanding the Good Neighbor Policy worldwide."
