ANOTHER CUP FOR JAPAN?

Three of the last seven winners of the G1 Hong Kong Cup have come from Japan, including last year's winner, Agnes Digital. The Land of the Rising Sun will look to make it two in a row with **Eishin Preston** (Green Dancer). The five-year-old earned the highest rating in all of Hong Kong last year with his 3 1/2-length victory in the G1 Hong Kong Mile. He proved he could handle 2000 meters with his win in the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin in April, where he beat Agnes Digital, with **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) back in fifth. He has been held winless since that score, but prepped for the Cup with a second in the Nov. 17 G1-JRA Mile Championship at Kyoto. "Actually, I was a little worried about the 2000 meters in the QEII Cup, but he handled it that day and I think he'll handle it again [today]," trainer Shuji Kitahashi said. "He is very relaxed and he is eating well. I don't think he will win easily, but I am happy with the way he is coming into the race." Grandera has won three of his five races since his last trip to Sha Tin, taking the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji, the G1 Prince Of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot and the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. He comes off a third-place finish in the Oct. 26 G1 Cox Plate. (*Hong Kong Cup field, p2*)

Malhub out of Sprint...

As expected, **Malhub** (Kingmambo) was withdrawn from the G1 Hong Kong Sprint after tying up Thursday. "Although the horse is looking well in himself, his muscle enzymes have not come down sufficiently to race at the highest level," trainer John Gosden said. He will be replaced in the gate by **Thunder (NZ)** (Carolingian {Aus}), a Group 2 winner with two wins from three starts in Australia. The four-year-old gelding was sold to continue his career in Hong Kong and, in his lone local start, set the pace before tiring to finish off the board in the International Sprint Trial. Thunder will break from Malhub's post seven. There were two more late scratches, with **Jeune King Prawn (Aus)** (Danahill) withdrawing from the G1 Hong Kong Mile after coming up lame in his left front leg, and **Red Pepper (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) is out of the G1 Hong Kong Cup after developing an infection in his left front leg. There were no replacements named for the two.

SHOW ME THE LUV

Elloluv (Gilded Time) went into yesterday's G1 Hollywood Starlet S. with only a maiden win under her girth, but she belied her inexperience and her 30-1 odds to take the field from gate to wire. "When I legged [jockey Pat Valenzuela] up, I said, 'Don't look at the odds,'" trainer Craig Dollase said. "She is an up-and-coming filly who never disappointed me and had been training real well. I thought **Composure** (Touch Gold) was a standout, but Elloluv had given indications she would run a big race. We had some tough beats in Grade Is this year with Momentum...this is sweet." While the longshot drew off to win by a handy four lengths, Composure could do no better than second as the 1-5 favorite. Multiple Group 1 winner **Aquarelliste** is rounding into top form and should prove difficult to handle this afternoon. Bred by the late Daniel Wildenstein and owned by his estate, the four-year-old filly had something of a disappointing summer, finishing third in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint Cloud and fourth in the G1 King George VII and Queen Elizabeth II Diamond S., but rebounded to take her Arc prep, the G1 Prix Foy Sept. 15, besting eventual G1 Japan Cup winner Falbrav (Ire) in the process. Runner-up in the Longchamp centerpiece at three, she finished a creditable sixth, two lengths behind Marienbard (Ire) Oct. 6, but faces an easier task today. Owner Gary Tanaka is no stranger to success in this event, his Ela Athena (GB) finishing second two years ago. His green and yellow silks will be carried today aboard **Falcon Flight**. The winner of the GIII Arlington H. in his seasonal bow July 27, he was a very unlucky fifth in the Aug. 17 GI Arlington Million, second in the GI Canadian International Sept. 29 and most recently a solid third to High Chaparral (Ire) in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf in Chicago. Beaten a head in this event a year ago, **Ekraar** is winless in three tries this season and will benefit from his third place finish in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club Oct. 20, his first start in five months.

Another competitive field takes shape for this event, headed by Godolphin's **Noverre**. Making his final career trip to the post, the blaze-faced bay is the class of the field, despite the lack of a victory since the G1 Sussex S. in August 2001. The four-year-old, to be piloted by Frankie Dettori, has managed to finish in the top three in five of six starts this term and was last seen when third to Storming Home in the 10-furlong G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 19. He will be well suited with the cutback in trip for this. Coming into the race in sneaky good form is **Tokai Point**, who will try to provide the Japanese with its second consecutive win in the Mile, following Eishin Preston a year ago. The runner-up in the G2 Sapporo Kinen Aug. 18, the four-year-old was a troubled fifth in the G3 Fuji S. Oct. 19, but atoned for that defeat with a 23-1 upset of Eishin Preston in the G1 Mile Championship Nov. 17. The chestnut has looked sensational on the track and could spring another surprise. "The track condition here is like Sapporo...and Tokai Point likes Sapporo, so it should suit him," assistant trainer Tomohiro Sato said. "I expect he will deliver a strong challenge in the closing stages of the race." Local favorite **Electronic Unicorn**, second in the 2001 renewal, has had just two runs this season and will need to bounce back from a subpar effort in the G3 Chevalier Cup Nov. 24. **Gateman** has place possibilities based on his close third to subsequent GI Breeders' Cup Mile hero Domedriver (Ire) in the G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein at Longchamp Oct. 5.

A year ago, **Falvelon** arrived in Hong Kong off a runner-up finish in the G2 Emirates Classic at Flemington and picked up his second straight Sprint victory. He comes into this year's three-peat attempt off a similar effort in his native country Nov. 7. Though winless since repeating in the G1 Doomben 10,000 over 6 1/2 furlongs in May, the bay has thrived since coming to Sha Tin 10 days ago and will take some beating today. "We've done all we can and really everything has gone to plan," trainer Dan Bougoure said. One of the fastest horses produced by the late Sunday Silence, **Believe** rides a four-race winning streak into the Sprint. Owned by Koji Meada, who also campaigns GII Peter Pan S. winner Sunday Break (Jpn), the four-year-old filly lowered the Hanshin track record by half a second when winning the G3 Centaur S. by four lengths Sept. 9 and returned to defeat Mile hopeful Admire Cozzene (Jpn) and **Shonan Kampf (Jpn)** by a half length in the G1 Sprinters' S. at Niigata Sept. 29, covering the 1200 meters in 1:07.7. **Texas Glitter** makes the final start of a solid career this afternoon. In search of his 10th overall stakes victory, the Todd Pletcher trainee has won two straight, including the GIII Hollywood Turf Express Nov. 29. **All Thrills Too** represents the home team's best chance at a win today. A close third to Falvelon last year, the five-year-old came from just off the pace to take the G3 International Sprint Trial over course and distance Nov. 24.

ODDS-ON UPSET FOR COMPOSURE The winner of the Oct. 6 GII Oak Leaf S., **Composure** (Touch Gold) was the heavy favorite off an excellent second-place finish in the Oct. 26 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Slow into stride and five wide on the first turn, she closed on **Elloluv** (Gilded Time) at the top of the stretch, but couldn't catch her while holding on for second. "Your guess is as good as mine as to what happened to her," jockey Mike Smith said. "She was forging real bad, which means she was hitting...the front leg with the back leg. They cut themselves a lot when they do that. That's the only excuse I've got." The winner, third in her Oct. 20 debut at Bay Meadows, broke her maiden with a 1 3/4-length score going six furlongs in the mud at Hollywood Nov. 10 and handled her two-turn and stakes debut with aplomb. "When I asked her to run at the quarter pole, she absolutely cut," said jockey Pat Valenzuela. The win payoff of \$63.60 was the highest in the 22-year history of the Starlet.

Freddy, making his first career start on the turf, flew down the center of the track and drew off impressively to win South America's most important race, in what served as a subtext to some bizarre events at the starting gate. With the field of 15 loaded and ready for the start, there appeared to be a gate malfunction leaving El Realizado (Arg) (Montreal Marty) apparently stranded in the stalls. The remainder of the field had already traversed the opening furlongs of the race and had turned onto the backstretch when the riders were instructed to pull up their mounts. The field was reloaded and the race re-started, but upon replay, it was determined that El Realizado had simply refused to break. In the race itself, Rodeno (Arg) (Roy) sprinted to the early lead and set easy fractions, but was collared turning for home by multiple Group 1 winner Peasant, who scooted clear and looked a likely winner. Pellegrino took a failed run for the lead, but Freddy, who foiled Peasant's Triple Crown bid with a victory in the G1 Gran Premio Nacional Nov. 16, inhaled his rivals and won with authority. El Realizado finished ninth. The winner's regular jockey, Jorge Valdivieso, was injured in the previous race and was forced to miss the mount aboard Freddy. Jockey Pedro Robles, who was replaced aboard Peasant following his loss in the Nacional and without a ride for the Pellegrini, picked up the mount on Freddy. Both the winner and the runner-up could represent Argentina in the G2 UAE Derby at Nad al Sheba Mar. 29. *(Thanks to Tom Tribolet for his assistance with this information).*

Second in the G1 Chilean St. Leger and fourth in that country's G1 El Derby, Pienza Sonando made his U.S. bow after an eight-month layoff and was third in an optional claimer at Santa Anita Oct. 2. He came back three weeks and a day later to win going a mile at that level and was the crowd's second choice trying American stakes company for the first time. Allowed to settle off the fractions set by the battling Gentle Giant (A.P. Indy) and Daunting (Sea Hero), the dark bay closed ground along the inside as they raced into the stretch, angled outside for the final drive and just got up to beat longshot Fleetstreet Dancer in the very last stride. "This horse is improving all the time," winning jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. said. "He's very sound and he tries hard, but he's got some bad habits. He likes to get in, and I have to be careful about that. Today, I thought I had the race won pretty easy the way he was moving, but he switched leads at the wrong time. It was close at the wire and he kind of lost his punch, but he kept trying...and he still won." Added trainer Ron McAnally, "I got this horse about seven months ago through [South American bloodstock agent] Fernando Fantini. This looks like a nice horse, and it looks like he can get a mile and a quarter. And Laffit gave him a phenomenal ride." MGSW Euchre (Personal Flag), the 9-5 favorite off a close-up second in allowance company Nov. 22, stalked the pace, but faded in the stretch to be seventh. [Click here](#) for the brisnet.com chart.

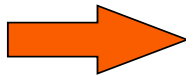

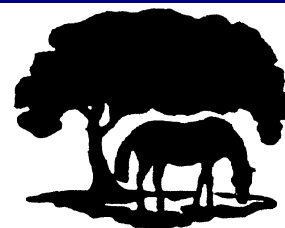
