HOMETOWN HEROES

Led by **Precision (Fr)** (Anabaa), Hong Kong-based horses starred at Sunday's International Races 2002 at Sha Tin, winning three of the day's four featured events. **Olympic Express (GB)** (Bishop of Cashel {GB}) prevailed over **Electronic Unicorn (Housbuster)** for a Hong Kong exacta in the G1 Hong Kong Mile, while **All Thrills Too (Aus)** (St Covet {Aus}) provided another victory for the home team in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint. The lone winner based overseas was **Ange Gabriel (Fr)** (Kaldounevees {Fr}), who got the better of fellow French runner **Aquarelliste (Fr)** (Danehill) in the G1 Hong Kong Vase. "What a day," said Lawrence Wong, chief executive of the Hong Kong Jockey Club. "Certainly the greatest day in Hong Kong racing. Quite a scorecard, wasn't it? It's a strong endorsement of the drive to improve the quality of horses here."

Cup Upset

A 65-1 longshot, Precision came running late to prevail in a tight finish, edging Germany's **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}) by a short head with Danish raider **Dano-Mast (GB)** (Unfuwain) a half-length further back in third. "I had a smooth run down the outside while everyone else was having a rough time on the rail," said winning rider Mick Kinane. "When I asked him to quicken, he did it really well. I have to admit it is a bit of a surprise, but it's great to get a result and finish the season like this."

Precision had just one win in eight previous starts this year, taking a handicap over this course back in January. He was the runner-up to Olympic Express in the G1-HK Hong Kong Derby Mar. 17 and most recently finished seventh in the G3-HK Chevalier Cup Nov. 24. Held up near the back of the pack through soft early fractions, Precision was kept in the clear on the outside approaching the straight. He set sail for Paolini and got his nose

down on the wire. American representative **Sarafan** (Lear Fan) flew down the center of the course for fourth, beaten a length. Favored **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) pulled a bit and never looked comfortable on his way to a seventh-place finish.

French Flavor

From the first crop of Haras du Quesnay sire Anabaa, Precision was purchased as a yearling at Deauville August for FF750,000 before being exported to Hong Kong. He is the fourth Group 1 winner for Anabaa, who made his name on the racetrack as a top sprinter, but has already proven himself as a sire of classic winners. Precision was bred by the Devin family at Haras du Mesnil, who also bred and still own Ange Gabriel (Fr), conqueror of the G1 Hong Kong Vase. That four-year-old could have his sights on England next year. "My grandmother won the King George in 1961 with Right Royal," said Henri Devin. "I'd love to win it with Ange Gabriel too."

Ange Gabriel, who beat Aquarelliste into third in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint Cloud last June, had the filly's number again yesterday, outfinishing that rival to score narrowly in the Hong Kong Vase. Third in the G2 Prix Jean de Chaudenay May 20 and second in the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly prior to his Group 1 success, the four-year-old returned from a four-month absence none the worse for wear, winning the Oct. 20 G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris at Longchamp. The early stages of the 1 1/2-mile event unfolded in similar fashion as 2001, with last year's runner-up Ekraar (Red Ransom) assuming command and towing the field along through soft splits of :50 4/5 for the half and 1:16 1/5 for 1200 meters. The Godolphin colorbearer still held the call as the field turned for home, but Ange Gabriel charged up on the outside to overtake the front runner at the 200-meter mark and held on late for the win. Aquarelliste, unraced since her sixth-place finish in the G1 Arc de Triomphe Oct. 6, ran on well from the back of the pack and rallied along the inside in the drive, but could not get to the winner. "Ange Gabriel is a very well-balanced horse," commented winning trainer Eric Libaud, who also sent out Terre a Terre (Fr) to a third-place finish in the Hong Kong Cup in 2001 for the same ownership. "He needs a firm surface as he has a huge stride, which gest lost when it's soft. His acceleration is amazing." The winner could resurface in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 29.

The winner of the G1-HK Hong Kong Derby last spring, Olympic Express fell flat in a pair of subsequent international Group 1 events, finishing eighth in the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup in April and fourth in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup the following month. The gelding made an inauspicious return to the races in Hong Kong, checking in last of 14 in the G3 International Sprint Trial Nov. 24, but his trainer was never dissuaded by that effort. "I gave him a real chance," Ivan Allan said. "Even though he had only the one run, he'd had the right work and he was pleasing me coming into the race." Dismissed at longshot odds, Olympic Express was content to linger towards the back of the pack before making forward progress while in the clear with 600 meters to run. Jockey Weichong Marwing asked his mount to kick it in with a quarter mile to run and he responded to hit the front at the 200 before holding off last year's Mile runner-up Electronic Unicorn and a fast-closing Tokai Point for the win. "Olympic Express came into the race a fresh horse and he gets the mile well," the winning jockey commented. "He traveled so well for me. It's incredible, a great feeling." Favored Noverre (Rahy), making his final start before heading off to stud, broke alertly and saved ground early, but had no rally and finished eighth. "He ran flat," jockey Frankie Dettori admitted. "It's come at the end of another long, hard season for him."

A very close third to Falvelon in this event a year ago, All Thrills Too got the afternoon off on a bright note for the home team, charging from just off the speed to earn his first Group 1 success. Second to Firebolt in the G1-HK Centenary Sprint Cup last March, the gelding filled the same spot in the G1-HK Chairman's Sprint Prize the following month before going off form and earning a five-month breather. The five-year-old bested Electronic Unicorn in the National Panasonic Cup H. in his Nov. 2 return to action and was most recently the half-length winner of the G3-HK International Sprint Trial Nov. 24. Covered up in midfield early, the chestnut swept to the front with just less than 200 meters to run and pulled clear. Firebolt completed the first ever Hong Kong exacta in any of the International Races, while two-time defending champ Falvelon finished a good third. "I had a dream run," commented winning rider Gerald Mosse. "He is normally a bit keen, but he was quiet, almost too quiet and at the 400 [meters] I was harder at him earlier than I wanted. But it worked." American Texas Glitter (Glitterman) showed some early interest, but lacked a late response and finished eighth in his career finale. Australian-bred horses have won each of the four runnings of the Hong Kong Sprint.

Starrer returned to the winner's circle for the first time since her victory in last year's GII Bayakoa H., rallying up the rail in good style. She was transferred from Dave Hofmans' barn after her 2001 swan song and made her first start for John Shirreffs in the GI Vanity H. June 22, finishing third to the venerable Azeri and Affluent. After a pair of losses on the East Coast to Summer Colony, Starrer returned to Southern California and was the runner-up to Azeri in the GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. Oct. 2 at Santa Anita. She ran fourth to that filly in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff Oct. 26, but was a solid favorite to earn her first win of the year in the Bayakoa. Tucked in behind the pacesetters down the backstretch, the dark bay waited patiently for the rail to open up on the far turn and came through willingly at the top of the stretch. Jockey Pat Valenzuela asked her to kick on and Starrer responded, drawing off smartly by five lengths. "It's true there were no Azeris or Summer Colonys in here, but I do think that she is getting back to herself," said Valenzuela. With a pedigree well suited to the grass, Starrer could find herself on that surface next year. "At some time [owner George Krikorian] wants to try her on the turf," said Shirreffs. "It's hard to say because the turf division is so tough, there's probably more chances to win races on the dirt than there are on turf around here. We don't want to see anymore of Azeri, we've seen enough of her."

Amonita, heroine of the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac in Longchamp in just her third start as a two-year-old, only managed to win one start in six trips to the track in her sophomore campaign, a Listed event in France in September of 2001. She went missing for nearly a year before making her victorious stateside debut against open Saratoga allowance foes Sept. 2. In her last outing, she finished a respectable second to Bates Creek in the Gill Noble Damsel H. at Belmont Sept. 21, a race that went a flat mile in a sizzling 1:32 3/5. Amonita was hammered down to prohibitive odds here and proved she deserved the respect, parlaying a powerful wide move through the lane into a smart win.

Asked for his best at the quarter pole, Grey Comet advanced to challenge Unswep and outlasted that one to get the win. "These are two very nice New York-breds," said Contessa. "Grey Comet worked so well going a mile; he finished up the last quarter in :24, and I thought he'd handle the distance."
