

DAT YOU MIZ BLUE RETIRED

Top New York-bred **Dat You Miz Blue** (Cure the Blues--Emma Loves Marie, by Wild Again), who defeated champion Xtra Heat in the Garland of Roses H. last Saturday, has been retired from racing. The five-year-old will be bred to Chief Seattle. Racing in the colors of Cynthia Knight, the bay mare was a graded-stakes winner of \$806,291, while running her career record to 33-14-9-4. "I made the decision last year that this would be her final year," Knight told *Daily Racing Form*. "At the end of her two-year-old season, she got hurt with a slab fracture. She has screws in that knee, and I always was worried about that. You have to give her a lot of credit. I wonder what her potential would have been if she didn't get hurt?" Dat You Miz Blue captured the GII Vagrancy H. in 2001 and tried the turf with some success this year, winning a Saratoga allowance before running third to the talented duo of **Tates Creek** and **Amonita** in the GIII Noble Damsel H. at Belmont Sept. 21. She is a half-sister to **Dust Me Off** (With Approval), who captured the GII Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream earlier in the year.

STORMY ATLANTIC TO HILL 'N' DALE One of the year's leading freshman sires, **Stormy Atlantic** (Storm Cat--Hail Atlantis, by Seattle Slew) will leave Florida's Bridlewood Farm for Hill 'n' Dale Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. His 2003 stud fee will be \$12,500 live foal. "We at Bridlewood are very excited about Stormy Atlantic graduating to the Kentucky stallion ranks following such sires as Mr. Prospector, Fappiano and Saint Ballado," said George Isaacs, general manager of Bridlewood. "He's a big son of Storm Cat with a big pedigree who is clearly a shooting star on the horizon." From his first crop of 44 foals, he has sired nine winners and three stakes winners, topped by graded-stakes winner Atlantic Ocean. That filly first put her sire in the headlines when she topped the Barretts March Sale at \$1.9 million, a record price for a two-year-old filly in training.

RECORD STAKES SCHEDULE FOR CHURCHILL IN 2003 Churchill Downs has announced its 2003 stakes schedule, which will be worth a record \$8.5 million in total purses. The Spring Meet, which will run from Apr. 26 to July 6, is headlined by the \$1-million GI Kentucky Derby May 3. The 129th Run for the Roses will be accompanied by the \$500,000 GI Kentucky Oaks May 2, the \$400,000 GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic May 3 and the \$200,000 GI Humana Distaff May 3. The GI Stephen Foster H., a \$750,000 event for the handicap division, will be run June 14. The Fall Meet will run from Oct. 26 to Nov. 29 and will feature a stakes-packed Thanksgiving holiday weekend. The \$400,000 GII Clark H. is on tap for Nov. 28; Churchill will also run the \$250,000 GII Falls City H. Nov. 27. Closing out the 2003 meet will be a pair of juvenile stakes Nov. 29, the \$200,000 GII Golden Rod S. for fillies and the \$200,000 GII Kentucky Jockey Club for males. "Our 2003 stakes schedule offers strong competition in every racing division and it should be attractive to horsemen throughout North America," said Doug Bednar, racing secretary. "Purses were raised in several stakes races that have grown in quality in recent years and that additional money should help make those races even more attractive." She returned from a three-month layoff in a Nov. 11 money allowance at the Big A, finishing fourth to the promising Wilzada, and was the fourth choice in the wagering this time. Breaking from post two, the dark bay took command after a quarter mile and gradually opened up to earn her first victory of 2002.

It's a Giggle Euthanized:

Top steeplechaser **It's a Giggle** (Northern Baby--Martie's Delighted, by Mo Bay) was euthanized Dec. 13 due to complications from colic. The eight-year-old had won three of his five starts this year, including the GI-NSA Royal Chase at Keeneland, and set a new course record at Saratoga. "It's very unfortunate and we are all just devastated," said Jonathan Sheppard, who trained It's a Giggle for Bill Pape. "We tried to protect him and do what was right this fall so he could come back and compete for a championship next year. I think we did right by the horse, which is all you can do. Then this happens, and it's very hard." It's a Giggle earned \$353,160 while winning nine of 19 career starts.



After a nose loss to David Copperfield--defeating Delta Form--in a \$125,000 optional claimer at Del Mar Aug. 15, the grey ran seventh to the latter in the GII Del Mar H. Sept. 1 and was given a bit of a break. He returned to run third in the Cal Cup Mile Nov. 2 and was sent off as the second choice this time. Settled in behind the early leaders, he angled out for room in the lane and swept to the front in the final yards.

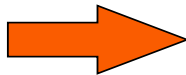
