TOCSET TAKES ON HOLLYWOOD

Maryland-based **Tocset** (Awesome Again) will take on five California rivals, headed **Kafwain** (Cherokee Run), in the GI Hollywood Futurity this afternoon. The only serious blemish on the bay colt's record was a tough-luck ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 26, but

he rebounded to win the GIII Laurel Futurity over a sloppy track Nov. 16 and most recently added a sharp victory in the GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct Nov. 30. With each of his five previous victories coming over five different surfaces, Tocset seems unfazed by travel and will be tough to top in this spot, especially if the forecasted showers materialize. But he will have to overcome the presence

of Kafwain, a multiple graded-stakes winner in his own right who was the runner-up to unbeaten stablemate Vindication in the Breeders' Cup. Hoping that lightning can strike twice is trainer Craig Dollase, who sends out maiden **Logician** (Tabasco Cat). Dollase's Elloluv upset the GI Hollywood Starlet last week. "He was nominated all along, and we're just taking a shot," said Dollase. "It's a short field, it's a big purse and if it's an off track, he should like it. He's bred to like an off track and he needs to stretch out." Logician finished third, beaten 1 3/4 lengths, in a Cal-bred maiden Dec. 11.

The four-year-old was an easy winner of the off-the-turf Ballston Spa H. at Saratoga back in August and has made just one start since, finishing third in the GII WinStar Galaxy H. over a yielding Keeneland course Oct. 4. Highweight **Tates Creek**, who will only run if trainer Bobby Frankel deems the turf acceptable, is a deserving favorite. The chestnut has just one loss in her last five starts, finishing sixth to Golden Apples (Ire) in the GI Beverly D. S. Aug. 17, and is coming off a game victory in the GII Las Palmas H. Nov. 3 at Santa Anita.

RED BULLET TO FLORIDA The recently retired **Red Bullet** (Unbridled--Cargo, by Caro {Ire}) will stand at Adena Springs South in Ocala, Florida, not Adena Kentucky as had been announced. His stud fee will remain \$30,000. Owner Frank Stronach, whose Magna Entertainment operates Gulfstream Park and Santa Anita, cited the creation of the Sunshine Millions as one of the reasons behind standing the 2000 Preakness hero in the Sunshine State. The inaugural Sunshine Millions, which pits Florida-breds against California-breds in eight races (four each at Gulfstream and Santa Anita) worth a total of \$3.6 million, will be held Jan. 25, 2003. "A horse like Red Bullet will open doors and encourage other breeders to improve the quality of the bloodstock residing in Florida," Stronach said. "There will be a trickle-down effect that will impact the entire state, from the higher demand for Florida-bred racehorses to improved prices for yearlings bred in the state."

Lone Star to Offer Four Graded Stakes in 2003:

Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas will offer four Grade III races next season. The track's 2003 stakes schedule, unveiled yesterday, is highlighted by the \$500,000 Lone Star Derby on May 10, the \$300,000 Texas Mile on Apr. 26 and the \$300,000 Lone Star Park H. and \$200,000 WinStar Distaff S. on May 26. Another race on the Lone Star calendar, the May 24 Stonerside S. for three-year-old fillies going seven furlongs, now is part of a series along with two other Stonerside-sponsored races. The connections of any filly that can sweep the GIII Stonerside Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream Park, the GII Stonerside Beaumont S. at Keeneland and Lone Star's event will receive a \$200,000 bonus.
