TOCSET TAKES IT TO 'EM

A five-time winner on the East Coast this season, **Tocset** (Awesome Again) proved he could handle the West Coast crowd as well with a gallant victory in the GI Hollywood Futurity yesterday. The hero of the Oct. 5 GI Champagne S., he wasn't at his best on Breeders' Cup Day and finished ninth in the GI Juvenile, but bounced back to take the Nov. 16 GIII Laurel Futurity and the Nov. 30 GI Remsen S. Showing speed from the start, the Dan Borislow homebred tracked **Roll Hennessy Roll** (Hennessy) early, then joined the leader as they raced around the far turn. **Kafwain** (Cherokee Run) went after him as they straightened for home, but bumped **Coax Kid** (Kissin Kris) as he was making his move. He put a nose in front as they raced to the wire, but Tocset would not be denied, battling back for the win. Borislow, who has been campaigning for an Eclipse Award for his colt, said, "I've spoken a lot about this horse and I'm going to say something outrageous right now. Maybe this horse should be champion this year, and maybe he should be the champion of the last 20 years. He did what the champions did in the '70s." Future plans for Tocset have not yet been mapped out. Kafwain finished second, but was disqualified and placed fourth. WHO WANTS TO BE A MILLIONAIRE?

Closing out her racing career in style, **Critical Eye** (Dynaformer) reeled in **Ellie's Moment** (Kris S.) in the final strides to take yesterday's GIII Ladies H. at Aqueduct by a 1 1/4 lengths. The \$64,440 winner's share of the purse pushed the five-year-old mare's earnings to \$1,060,984. "She really ran 'lights out,'" said trainer Scott Schwartz, who earned his first Grade I win with **Critical Eye** in the 2000 Gazelle H. "She has done everything and then some. This is the way to go out." **Critical Eye** had taken back-to-back allowance wins at Belmont Sept. 12 and Oct. 18, but had to settle for third in the Nov. 3 GIII Turnback The Alarm S. at Aqueduct. The New York-bred was the crowd's choice in the restricted Montauk S. Dec. 1, but managed only fourth in her penultimate outing and was 5-1 in her final race-track appearance. Surya was sent off the favorite and appeared to have this race in her pocket until veteran Tout Charmant drove down the center of the track to get her nose even with the crowd's choice as they hit the line.

Surya, who started her career in France, returned after an eight-month layoff to take a May 5 allowance at Hollywood and added a win in the July 6 GIII Royal Heroine S., but could only get fourth as the favorite in the July 27 GI Ramona H. She shipped to Saratoga to post a 9 1/4-length victory in the off-the-turf Ballston Spa Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 24, but tired late to be third in her latest, the Oct. 4 GII WinStar Galaxy S. at Keeneland. Tout Charmant, who began the season with a win in the Jan. 13 GII San Gorgonio H., had started just twice since. In her latest, she came back after more than seventh months off to finish a tired seventh in the Nov. 3 GII Las Palmas H., but improved sharply with that one under her girth. Settled at the back of the pack early, she bided her time as Surya, who had stumbled slightly at the start, moved up to battle stablemate Honest Darling through moderate fractions. Surya grabbed a short lead in the stretch, but Tout Charmant had kicked it into gear and got up to share the victory.

Critical Eye trailed the field of six as 1-2 choice **With Ability** (A.P. Indy) took them along through six furlongs in 1:12.94 and a mile in 1:38.48. The favorite still held a daylight lead as they raced into the stretch, but **Ellie's Moment** was on the move, catching the pacesetter as they hit the eighth pole and looking the winner until Critical Eye motored past in the waning strides. "She kicked in and just buried them," Schwartz said, adding, "She'll stay in the barn for a week and then we will send her to Kentucky. She's going back to Taylor Made, where she was raised." Critical Eye, who also took the 2001 GI Hempstead H., retires with 14 wins, four seconds and three thirds from 38 starts.

Winner of the G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn) in October, **Symboli Kris S.** closed strongly for third in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 24, the best finish among Japanese horses in that event. The three-year-old colt will be piloted by Olivier Peslier. "Peslier is the jockey who brings out the horse's ability well," said trainer Kazuo Fujisawa. "I hope to end this season with a great result." Unbeaten three-year-old filly sensation **Fine Motion**, a 3/4-sister to Japan Cup hero Pilsudski (Ire), makes her first start against older horses. She took the G1 Shuka Sho and the G1 Queen Elizabeth Commemorative Cup in succession and has been installed as the second choice on the morning line. "She has a good attitude and is very relaxed," said trainer Yuji Ito.

Winner of the Gill Herecomesthebride S. last February at Gulfstream, Cellars Shiraz had been unbeaten in three previous starts on the Calder turf. She tried the main track in her latest and was beaten a half length when third in the E. Heubeck Distaff H. Nov. 16, returning to the turf here as tepid favorite in this 13-horse field. Never far from the front, the blinkered bay made the lead turning for home and strode home with authority. "We'll just go on to that Sunshine Millions race on [Jan. 25], the mile and an eighth on turf," said winning trainer Bill Cesare. Sept. 21 and promptly added the GIII Valley View on the lawn at Keeneland Oct. 19, but was outfinished in the GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill, finishing third by a half-length Nov. 16. Content to settle well off the pace, Bedanken ranged up six wide turning for home, grabbed the lead in midstretch and kicked into gear for the stakes-record setting victory. "On this turf course you wait for the turn home and get your spot," said winning rider Don Pettinger. "I got my spot." Bedanken will now get some time off.
