**SYMBOLI KRIS S. TAKES ARIMA KINEN**

Three-year-old **Symboli Kris S.** (Kris S.), coming off a solid third-place effort in the Japan Cup, bested a field of older horses to take yesterday's G1 Arima Kinen at Nakayama Racecourse by a half length. Symboli Kris S. enjoyed a ground-saving trip while racing in mid-pack. He angled to the outside for the drive and overtook longshot **Tap Dance City** (Pleasant Tap) in the final strides to earn his second Group 1 victory of the year. The win secured Kazuo Fujisawa's eighth straight Japanese trainer's title. Fujisawa said Symboli Kris S. could make his next start in Hong Kong or Dubai. The popular filly **Fine Motion (Ire)** (Danehill), sent off the favorite by the crowd of nearly 122,000, suffered the first loss of her seven-race career. On the front from the start, Fine Motion began losing ground on the backstretch and tired to finish fifth. "She just didn't run today," jockey Yutaka Take told the *Japan Times*. "It wasn't like she gave it her best and lost. It's really too bad because I had high hopes for her."

**FAMILIAR FACES RETURN IN MALIBU**

A field of 11, peppered with returning sophomore standouts, was entered yesterday for Thursday's renewal of the G1 Malibu S. at Santa Anita. The field includes the promising **Sunday Break (Jpn)** (Forty Niner). The Neil Drysdale trainee finished third behind Buddha and Medaglia d'Oro in the G1 Wood Memorial before winning the GII Peter Pan, but he has not started since finishing third in the G1 Belmont S. last June. Another one making his first start since the Triple Crown races is **U S S Tinosa** (Foxhound). The gray, second behind Medaglia d'Oro in the GII San Felipe, has been off since finishing sixth in the G1 Preakness S. Also making a return to the races is the speedy **Mayakovsky** (Matty G). Winner of the GIII Gotham S. last March, the colt has not been seen since running fourth in the GII Amsterdam at Saratoga in August. He worked a bullet six furlongs from the gate at Santa Anita yesterday in 1:10.80, and, after the move, trainer Patrick Biancone commented, "This race had been a question mark for him, but he worked very well this morning. He came out of the work very good and we need to come back [at some point] anyway." **Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West), who gained fame when he accompanied stablemate Johannesburg to the Kentucky Derby, takes to the dirt for the first time since that 12th-place effort in May.

Outta Here started in three graded stakes before actually breaking his maiden--an indication of how good his connections think he might be--and the chestnut notched his second win in style here as he took the inaugural running of the as-yet-ungraded Delta Jackpot S. Coming off a second-place finish in his bow in early July, Outta Here again hit the runner-up spot in the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship, got third in the GIII Best Pal S. in mid-August, then finished off the board in the GII Del Mar Futurity Sept. 11. Dropped back in against maidens, he necked out a win at Santa Anita Oct. 14 and looked sharp in his turf bow when third by 1 3/4 lengths in the GIII Generous S. at Hollywood Nov. 30. The Bill Currin trainee was unhurried through the early stages under jockey Kent Desormeaux, who saw fit to make the trip east for the mount, but moved into contention with a wide move on the turn. With only Comic Truth to beat, Outta Here determinedly made up three lengths through the lane and was up in time to catch that one for his first stakes success.

**TANAKA BUYS SHOLOKHOV** Gary Tanaka has purchased Irish Derby runner-up **Sholokhov (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) for an undisclosed sum, according to *Racing Post*. Under the tutelage of Aidan O'Brien, Sholokhov was used mainly as a pacemaker for his more famous stablemates. In addition to his second-place finish behind stablemate High Chaparral in the Derby, the bay colt was second behind O'Brien's Hawk Wing in the G1 Eclipse S. Where Sholokhov will race next is still to be determined. "We are going to ship him to England and to [trainer] Michael Jarvis," Tanaka's racing manager Andy Smith told *Racing Post*. "We will give him plenty of time off and then decide what to do in the spring. He has had quite a hard year acting as a pacemaker. He may go the United States, he may stay with Michael and be campaigned in Europe, or he may stay with Michael and be a globetrotter. There are no firm plans."
