GOSSAMER TO FLY NO MORE

Classic heroine **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells--Brocade {GB}, by Habitat), originally thought to be staying in training for 2003, has instead been retired to stud. Out of the Group 1-winning Brocade, the bay filly is a full sister to champion miler Barathea (Ire). She remained undefeated in three juvenile outings, including the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot, and was the beaten favorite when unplaced in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket last May. She made amends in the Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh later that month, but failed to build on that performance when last in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot in June. Her final two starts proved highly respectable: she was third to Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) and Banks Hill (GB) in the G1 Prix du Moulin before running fifth in the G1 Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. She heads to the paddocks with four wins in eight career starts and earnings of \$480,560. "Gossamer has been retired to her owner's Eydon Hall Farm in Northamptonshire, where she is to become a mummy," trainer Luca Cumani told *Racing Post*. "She has been a good filly to have around and was very unlucky not to have her ground on occasions. She preferred easy going, but it was pleasing to see her run well on good ground when third in the Moulin and fifth at the Breeders' Cup." Breeding plans have not yet been finalized.

A MALIBU SHOCKER

While his more-established rivals were making a name for themselves in and around the spring classics, **Debonair Joe** (Ole') was on the shelf after a full juvenile campaign in which he took a Hollywood state-bred stake and little else. When he returned to the races in August, the bay gelding was less-than-inspiring in three efforts at Del Mar before being claimed for \$12,500 from a fifth-place effort at Fairplex in September. With a Santa Anita claimer and a Golden Gate optional claimer to his credit since then, Debonair Joe was dismissed at 52-1 in the Dec. 7 GIII Vernon Underwood and came charging late to score by half-length. Jumping up to Grade I company, the rags-to-riches story was given little regard by the bettors in yesterday's GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita, but, well back early, he forged to the front late for a narrow victory. "It was a lucky claim," admitted winning trainer Juan Pablo Silva. "The horse has been improving and improving. He had problems, we took care of it and we're lucky." **Sunday Break (Jpn)** (Forty Niner), the 5-2 favorite, faded to last in the 11-horse field. Trainer Neil Drysdale speculated his charge may not have liked being forced to run on the rail. "[Kent Desormeaux] wanted to get him off the rail, but it didn't work out. We'll see how he comes back," Drysdale commented. Although last weekend saw the running of the GI Hollywood Futurity, that event wasn't the richest event of the weekend, or even the richest juvenile event. That honor went to Delta Downs which followed up the first running of the \$250,000 Delta Downs Princess S. (won by Tale of the Cat's daughter My Trusty Cat), on Friday, with the inaugural \$500,000 Delta Jackpot S.

There was one link between the GI Hollywood Futurity and the Delta Jackpot, as both were captured by grandsons of Deputy Minister, the GI Hollywood Futurity going to Toccet (covered previously in the column), a son of first season sire Awesome Again, and the Delta Jackpot to the Dehere colt, Outta Here.

Outta Here is the 12th stakes winner of the year for his sire, who according to *The Blood-Horse* ranks second only to El Prado (Ire) by 2002 earnings. Should Dehere finish in that position, it will be the second time he has been runner-up for a sires championship, as he also finished second to the record-breaking End Sweep in the race to be Leading First Crop Sire of 1998.

Even though Dehere was represented by 28 starters, against 49 for End Sweep, at the time, the fact that he didn't capture the title was seen as something of a disappointment. A son of Deputy Minister out of a mare by "broodmare sire of sires" Secretariat, Dehere earned honors as champion two-year-old after winning five of seven starts, including the GIII Sanford S., GII Saratoga Special S., GI Hopeful S. and GI Champagne S. Dehere started only twice at three, but one of those starts resulted in a GII Fountain of Youth S. victory over a field which included subsequent GI Kentucky Derby winner Go For Gin and eventual Horse of the Year Holy Bull. *Cont. p. 4*

Given his combination of pedigree and performance, Dehere was expected to rise rapidly to the top of a stallion intake which also included the previously mentioned End Sweep and Holy Bull, Miner's Mark, Sea Hero, Brocco, Harlan, Twining, Boundary, Tactical Advantage and Montbrook. Dehere actually would have come extremely close to stealing the title, but for a pair of defeats totaling less than a half a length, suffered by his first crop stakes winning juveniles Arrested Dreams and Millions. Arrested Dreams was near perfect in her first season, her sole defeat in five starts coming when she was beaten inches in the GI Matron S. Millions captured three of five starts at two, including the GIII Laurel Futurity, but in the GII Remsen S., energy used chasing the early pace of Doneraile Court cost him in the last few strides when he was caught by Comeonmom, going down by a neck. Dehere's second crop would eventually turn out to be a very good one, but it lacked a two-year-old star, and by the end of 1999 he was on his way to the J.B.B.A. Shizunai Stallion Station, and he now shuttles between there and Arrowfield Stud in Australia.

Like many exported stallions, Dehere has truly flourished since being sent to Japan, and he now has 31 Northern Hemisphere stakes winners from his first five crops, including this year's Grade I winning filly, Take Charge Lady, millionaire Graeme Hall, and graded-stakes winners Millencolin, Here's Zealous, Shooter and Finality. Outta Here is one of four 2002 juvenile stakes winners sired by Dehere. His offspring also excelled in Australia, where he is represented by G1 Golden Slipper winner and champion two-year-old Belle du Jour, multiple Group 1 winner Defier, as well as other graded scorers Red Hannigan, Lady Dehere, The Man, Captain Test and Able Choice.

A \$37,000 Keeneland September Yearling, Outta Here is the second foal of his dam, the unraced Forty Niner mare Just Out. His second dam, Doubles Match (by Danzig), was only a minor winner and has yet to produce a runner of note, but the family explodes under Outta Here's third dam, Fabuleux Jane. A group winner in France and also third in the G1 Prix de Diane (French Oaks) and G1 Prix Vermeille, Fabuleux Jane is dam of the GI Early Times Turf Classic winner Joyeux Danseur and listed scorer Fabuleux Dancer, and of Doubles Partner, a graded-stakes winner, who is the granddam of the recent G1 Japan Cup Dirt victor Eagle Café. Another daughter of Fabuleux Jane, the group placed Danseur Fabuleux, is dam of both Arazi, champion two-year-old in America and Europe and spectacular hero of the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, and of Group 1 winner Noverre, the highweighted three-year-old miler in England last year.

Out of foundation mare Native Partner, Fabuleux Jane is herself half-sister to English and French champion sprinter, Ajdal, GI Fantasy S. heroine Flying Partner and English two-year-old Group 1 winner Formidable. Among the other notable descendants of Native Partner are Grade I winner Link River, Japanese stars Dance Partner and Dance in the Dark, and graded-stakes winners Hero's Love, Sterling Pound, Exchange Rate and Stelvio.

The cross which produced Outta Here, that of Dehere over a Mr. Prospector-line mare is one which has benefited Dehere more than Deputy Minister himself, or any of his other stallion sons. To date, there are at least eight stakes winners by Dehere out of mares descending in male line from Mr. Prospector, and they include Take Charge Lady, his only U.S. Grade I winner to date, and three other graded stakes winners. Both Outta Here and another 2002 stakes winner, Descapate, are out of mares by Forty Niner, and since both Dehere and Forty Niner are now in Japan, it will be interesting to see if that cross continues to flourish there.

TACTICAL ADVANTAGE DIES Tactical Advantage (Forty Niner--Twitchet, by Roberto) was euthanized yesterday after suffering from a neurologic disorder. The 12-year-old stallion had been at the University of Florida Large Animal Clinic under the care of Dr. Robert MacKay since his return from Argentina in the fall. Tactical Advantage, winner of the 1992 GII Saratoga Special, had been standing at Marablu Farm in Ocala, Florida. He is the sire of graded stakes winners Forty One Carats, Prime Directive and Crowned Dancer. With five crops to race and career progeny earnings at \$10,288,888, Tactical Advantage has sired 10 stakes winners. "I'm devastated," said Doug Henderson, owner of Marablu Farm. "The loss of Tactical Advantage is a major disappointment to all of us. He was a friend and will be greatly missed."

STORM CANCELS RACING A winter storm Wednesday forced the cancellation of racing at Aqueduct and Philadelphia Park yesterday. "When you get an inch of rain, an inch of sleet and six inches of snow, some of that is going to get into the track, no matter how tight it is packed," said track superintendent Jerry Porcelli. "We'll harrow the track, then float and squeeze it later." Yesterday's featured GIII Gravesend has been rescheduled for Sunday at Aqueduct with the race open to original nominees. The race will be redrawn Friday. Both Aqueduct and Philadelphia are expected to resume live racing today.
