YOU AND WHO ELSE

You (You and I) and **Habibti** (Tabasco Cat) will renew their rivalry this afternoon in the GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita, their first meeting since they ran fourth and third, respectively, in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 3. The two fillies had met in five consecutive starts, with Habibti getting the better of You by a head in the GI Hollywood Starlet. You rebounded to defeat her nemesis in both the GI Las Virgenes and the GI Santa Anita Oaks over the winter and then travelled East, where she annexed the GI Acorn S. and the GI Test S. She has been out of action since Oct. 6, when she ran second to Take Charge Lady in the GI Overbrook Spinster at Keeneland. The dark bay blew out three-eighths in :38 at Hollywood Thursday morning. Habibti hasn't visited the winner's circle since last year's Starlet score, but the chestnut displayed her powerful late kick when second in the Corona H. at Hollywood Dec. 8. The speedy **Bella Bellucci** (French Deputy) won her lone start at Santa Anita back in March, but she has been off since running third as the 7-5 favorite in the GI Gazelle H. Sept. 7. Trying the big girls for the first time is **Lacie Girl** (Editor's Note), an unbeaten Northern California-based filly. Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer decided to point for Santa Anita after Lacie Girl took the Star Ball H. Nov. 30 at Golden Gate. "I would think we'd fit well in the La Canada series at Santa Anita, and I think she'll especially like the seven furlongs in the first leg," said the conditioner. The La Brea lost a potential superstar when the Bobby Frankel-trained **Sightseek** (Distant View) came down with a fever. She posted a half-mile breeze in :46.60 yesterday at Hollywood Park. The Juddmonte homebred has captured the GIII Raven Run S. and the GII Top Flight H. in succession for four wins in five starts. **La Brea field, p2**

STAYING THE COURSE

There is no question that **Stay Forever** (Stack) loves Calder--she has five wins from seven starts over the turf course--but the five-year-old has never raced beyond nine furlongs and will be tested by the 1 1/2 miles of the GII La Prevoyante H. this afternoon as well as a bevy of talented shippers. After a 19-month hiatus, Stay Forever rattled off four consecutive victories on the Calder lawn before trying the boys in the Bonnie Heath Turf H. Nov. 16, when she ran third, beaten a length, to GSW Miesque's Approval. Her pedigree indicates that today's added distance shouldn't be a problem. Trainer Christophe Clement already has a quartet of La Prevoyante victories and sends out a contentious pair in **Julie Jalouse** (Kris S.) and **Mot Juste (GB)** (Mtoto {GB}). The former took Gulfstream's GII Orchid H. in her U.S. bow last March and most recently went to Hollywood for the Waya H., running third Nov. 28. Mot Juste moved to Clement's shedrow after running third for Kiaran McLaughlin in the GI Flower Bowl H. In her first start for her new conditioner, the four-year-old held the lead late before getting caught by **Uriah (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}) in the GII Long Island H. Nov. 16 at Aqueduct.

WEATHER WOES CONTINUE The Christmas Day storm, which forced both Aqueduct and Philadelphia Park to cancel their live racing cards Thursday, continued to affect racing at both East Coast tracks Friday. Philadelphia cancelled its live card again after the track was deemed unfit for racing following the rain, sleet and snow received over the holidays. Aqueduct's ninth race was cancelled due to thawing track conditions. There was also a 37-minute delay because of a stalled tractor between the day's sixth and seventh races. "We had to closely monitor and work the track the last several days and today's tractor breakdown further complicated the situation," said Terry Meyocks, president and COO of the New York Racing Association. "We accelerated post times prior to the tractor breakdown in an attempt to finish the race day at 4 p.m., but that was negated by the long delay. The thawing conditions worsened later in the day and resulted in the cancellation of the final race." Both tracks are expected to have live racing Saturday.

TOUT CHARMANT RETIRED (AGAIN) Millionaire **Tout Charmant** (Slewvescent--Charm a Gendarme, by Batonnier), who returned to racing after failing to get in foal to Storm Cat earlier this year, has been retired once again following her dead-heat win in the GII Dahlia H. last Saturday. Now six, she has been rebooked to the Overbrook stallion. "She's more valuable as a broodmare and getting her in foal to Storm Cat," trainer Ron McAnally told *Daily Racing Form*. "She retires sound. She was among the top mares I've ever had, especially on the grass. She had to be one of the best I've ever trained." Winner of the GI Del Mar Oaks at three, the bay added a victory in the GI Matriarch at four and captured the GII San Gorgonio H. to kick off her 2002 campaign. The Stonerside colorbearer heads to stud with a record of 29-9-9-1 and earnings of \$1,781,877.
