FRANKEL ON HISTORY'S DOORSTEP

With trainer Bobby Frankel within \$160,000 of the single season earnings record, a victory in this afternoon's GII San Gabriel H. can go a long way in helping him achieve the milestone. One of a trio of Frankel trainees in this event, **Decarchy** (Distant View) suffered a terrible trip in the GII Citation H. at Hollywood Nov. 30, where he was boxed in and forced to steady repeatedly before finishing fourth, beaten 1 1/2 lengths. The Citation was the first start off a seven-month layoff for Decarchy, one of California's top turf milers. He is unbeaten in three starts over the Santa Anita lawn, including a win in the GII Frank E. Kilroe H. last March, and gets a jockey change to Jerry Bailey. Third in the Citation, **White Heart (GB)** (Green Desert) was also returning from a lengthy layoff that day. He had captured the 2001 GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic and was a solid fourth to Beat Hollow (GB) and With Anticipation in this year's renewal. The Rodney Dangerfield of the Southern Californian turf circuit, **Grammarian** (Definite Article {GB}) won the GII Sunset H. at Hollywood earlier this year at 29-1 and nearly wired the field in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup Nov. 23 at odds of 14-1. He will face pressure up front this time from **David Copperfield** (Halo).

Perseverance paid off for Man From Wicklow, as the five-year-old recorded the first stakes victory of his career and first win of any kind since last summer in yesterday's W.L. McKnight H. Second in the faster division of the Cape Henlopen H. at Delaware Park July 21, the Florida-bred was fourth, beaten two lengths to With Anticipation, in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational at Saratoga Aug. 10. The dark bay returned to be third to the Augustin colorbearer in the GI Man O' War S. at Belmont Sept. 7, but was most recently a troubled third in the GII Sky Classic H. at Woodbine Oct. 27. The Florida-bred was forced to steady off heels on the first turn before settling in and among horses for the middle portion of the race. Asked for his best turning for home, he weaved his way between horses and rallied to be up in the waning strides. "He's been such an unlucky horse," said winning owner and trainer Rick Violette Jr. "He should have galloped in Canada. He got shut off and turned sideways, pinned on the fence. He almost got dropped in the Sword Dancer and only got beat two lengths." The winner will likely be pointed for the GI Gulfstream Breeders' Cup H. (11 furlongs, Feb. 16) and the GII Pan American H. The winner of the 11-furlong Robert G. Dick Breeders' Cup at Delaware Park this past July, New Economy was fourth over a yielding turf in the GIII Glens Falls H. at Saratoga the following month, but faltered to be fifth as the favorite in the Rosenberger Memorial H. at Delaware Sept. 7 before earning a two-month break. The bay resurfaced with an eighth-place finish in Aqueduct's GIII Athenia H. Nov. 9 and was coming into this test off a fifth-place finish, beaten just a length, in this track's GIII My Charmer H. Dec. 7. The "Shel" Evans homebred filly bobbed at the break and was taken in hand by jockey Rosemary Homeister Jr. before settling in midpack for the run up the backstretch. She advanced four deep approaching the quarter pole, hit the front nearing the eighth pole and edged away to her first graded-stakes success. "I rode the filly last time and she ran a superb race," the winning rider commented. "The only thing was that it was too short for her. So when we saw this mile and a half, I knew the distance would fit her perfectly." David Rock, assistant to trainer Graham Motion, indicated that the four-year-old would be pointed to the longer distance races at Gulfstream, which include the 11-panel GIII The Very One H. If it's the Gallant Fox, it must be Coyote Lakes, who continued his domination over this event with a thoroughly convincing victory. The eight-year-old gelding actually won the event twice in 2002, as the 2001 renewal was postponed until just after the New Year, and made light work of this field. The Arizona-bred returned from a six-month freshening to record a 2 1/4-length victory over \$75,000 claimers going a flat mile over the Aqueduct main track Sept. 28. The chestnut was going well during the latter stages of the GIII Stuyvesant H. Nov. 5 before settling for sixth, but was coming into this three-peat attempt off a two-length victory in a 10-furlong starter allowance tilt over the inner track Dec. 8. Well rated in fifth while riding the rails throughout the first circuit, he commenced a steady advance approaching the far turn, angled three wide in upper stretch and overtook front-running Fisher Pond under a drive. "He's just an amazing horse," winning trainer Bruce Levine commented. "This was hard to do, but enjoyable. He trains like a two-year-old. Fourth in the GII Super Derby, the bay colt returned home to run third in the GIII Calder Derby on the grass Oct. 12 and followed that up with a second in the C.G. Rose Classic H. Nov. 16, splitting the seven-year-old pair of Best of the Rest and Dancing Guy. The Florida-bred was allowed to settle into stride several lengths back in seventh and began to pick up the pace heading into the far turn.
