

SECOND "CHOICE" COMES OUT ON TOP

Trainer Jimmy Jerkens saddled 2-1 favorite **Wrangler** (Carson City) in yesterday's GIII Gravesend H. at Aqueduct, but it was his second runner, **Multiple Choice** (Mt. Livermore), who carried the day for the stable. The

chestnut had made his last five starts against graded-stakes company, running third behind Orientate in the GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. and the GI Forego H. at Saratoga, then finishing off the board in the Sept. 21 GI Vosburgh S. and the Oct. 6 GII Forest Hills H. at Belmont. But, facing

softer rivals last time, Multiple Choice romped to a 7 1/4-length victory as a 15-1 outsider in the Oct. 26 GIII Sport Page H. at the Big A. Off at 9-2 in the Gravesend, the four-year-old rated off a solid pace set by **Sing Me Back Home** (Homebuilder), then outfinished the frontrunner to take it by 3/4 of a length. "Multiple Choice has been real consistent and he runs hard all the time," said Jerkens, adding, "I still think he's getting better." GRAMMARIAN GETS IT RIGHT IN ARCADIA

Let go at 9-1 despite a strong second-place showing in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup last time out, **Grammarian** (Definite Article {GB}) grabbed the lead after a half and held off all challengers to take the GII San Gabriel H. at Santa Anita yesterday afternoon. The Pacific Heritage Farm homebred had captured the GII Sunset H. at Hollywood in July, but did not as fare after traveling east, finishing off the board in the Aug. 10 GI Sword Dancer H., the Sept. 21 GIII Kentucky Cup H. and the Oct. 6 GI Shadwell Turf Mile. He showed marked improvement in his final start before returning to the West Coast, winning a Churchill Downs allowance at the San Gabriel distance Nov. 3. Off at 14-1 in the 1 1/2-mile Turf Cup, he led all the way to deep stretch, giving way only grudgingly to get the runner-up spot, but was overlooked by the bettors in this shorter affair. The 18-year-old has proven his value as a sire with progeny such as juvenile Group 1 winner Seattle Rhyme and Classic winners Dance The Day Away (NZ) and Pike Place Dancer. Seattle Dancer is also well represented in Germany with the Classic-winning fillies Que Belle and Rose Of Zollern (Ire). Also adding to the German stallion roles, the recently founded Gestut Elite has leased **Paris House (GB)** (Petong {GB}--Foudroyer {GB}, by Artaius) for the coming breeding season. The 14-year-old won the G2 Flying Childers S. and was runner-up to Sheikh Albadou (GB) in the G1 Nunthorpe S. the same year. At four he captured the G2 Temple S. and G3 Palace House S. Paris House's leading progeny are the Group 1 winner Tobruk (NZ), G3 Molecomb S. winner Misty Eyed (Ire) and stakes winners Southern House (Ire), After Me (NZ) and Silver Quick (Ire). While the nomination fee for Seattle Dancer has yet to be announced, Paris House's fee has been set at €2,000.

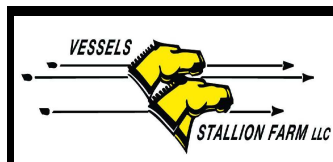
