CAN 'POLLY STAY ON A ROLL?'

Today's GIII Monrovia H. at Santa Anita will feature **Rolly Polly (Ire)** (Mukaddamah), who puts her unbeaten record over the Arcadia turf on the line. The four-year-old captured the GIII Las Cienegas H. back in April and added a last-jump win in the GIII Sen. Ken Maddy H. Oct. 12. Following that victory, the Irish-bred bay carried her form cross-town to Hollywood Park and secured the Safely Kept H. going 5 1/2 furlongs Nov. 17. A win by Rolly Polly in the Monrovia could lift trainer Bobby Frankel to a new earnings record, if stablemate Sumitas (Ger) does his part in the day's fifth race, a \$70,000 allowance. With \$17,739,940 in earnings for the year, Frankel is \$102,418 shy of the D. Wayne Lukas benchmark of \$17,842,358, set in 1988.

I have no idea how much Robert S. Evans paid when he bought Sunyata privately around five years ago, but chances are that this daughter of Proud Truth wasn't expensive. Sunyata had cost only \$38,000 as a yearling in 1990; she had failed to make it to the races; and her first two foals, a gelded son of Majestic Light and a filly by Clever Trick, hadn't made much of an impact in 1997, although the gelding was a winner.

So what was this mare's attraction to a man who has campaigned Grade I winners? I suspect her appeal stemmed from the fact that Sunyata was carrying a foal by Roberto's fast son Red Ransom, coupled with her being a member of the very successful family descending from Soaring, a daughter of Swaps.

Soaring's main claim to fame nowadays is probably that she is the second dam of Ballade, who visited Halo to produce a remarkable trio of high-class winners in Glorious Song, Devil's Bag and Saint Ballado. Halo, of course, shared the same sire, Hail to Reason, as Roberto. Glorious Song has raised the family's profile even higher by becoming the dam of Rahy, a very successful stallion, and Singspiel, an international star on the racetrack who has an eye-catching record with his first runners.

Towards the end of her broodmare career Soaring became a regular visitor to members of the Ribot male line and she hit the jackpot with Mehmet, her 1978 colt by His Majesty. A late developer who was equally at home on dirt and turf, Mehmet collected over \$650,000 as a four-year-old, when his wins included the GI Monmouth H. on dirt and two GII races on turf, where the opposition included the legendary John Henry.

In the circumstances, it was hardly surprising that Mehmet's half-sister Far Beyond, a minor winner by Nijinsky, spent most of her broodmare career visiting Ribot-line stallions. Among her 15 foals were two by His Majesty, one by His Majesty's brother Graustark, five by Graustark's son Key to the Mint, three by Graustark's son Proud Truth and one by Tom Rolfe.

The incentive to stick with this stratagem came from Far Beyond's first two foals, the stakes-placed Battle Creek Girl, a daughter of His Majesty, and Wings of Grace, a GIII-winning daughter of Key to the Mint.

Battle Creek Girl has enjoyed tremendous success as a broodmare, with the likes of Wavering Girl, Tricky Creek, Parade Ground, Speed Dialer and Parade Leader among her six stakes winners. Perhaps her greatest achievement, though, was to produce a Kingmambo colt at the age of 22 which sold for \$5,300,000 as a yearling.

Wings of Grace has also excelled as a producer. A visit to Roberto resulted in that very good turf filly Plenty of Grace (GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational S.) and she later did even better with Roberto's son Kris S., producing the champion turf female Soaring Softly (GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf).

Of course these are just a couple of the major winners produced by the Roberto-Ribot cross, exploited so successfully by the Darby Dan team. Among the others are the champion turf performers Sunshine Forever and Ryafan, plus such runners as Memories of Silver, Brian's Time and Dynaformer.

No wonder Robert Evans has largely pursued this Hail to Reason route with Sunyata, sending her to Saint Ballado in 1998 and 2000 and to Red Ransom in 1999. The first Saint Ballado mating produced a colt which sold to John C. Oxley for \$850,000.

Sunyata's Red Ransom colt has been placed at two in Japan this year and will come into his own as he matures and the distances lengthen, judging by the record of his sister New Economy. She has shown her appreciation of a test of stamina this year with stakes wins over 1 3/8 and 1 1/2 miles, with her victory in the GII La Prevoyante H. making her the 22nd graded-stakes winner by Red Ransom.

Inevitably, several of her predecessors also represent the Roberto-Ribot cross, good examples being the GII E.P. Taylor S. winner Wandering Star (dam by His Majesty), this year's GII Arlington Classic winner Mr. Mellon (second dam by Graustark), Crystal Symphony (second dam by Tom Rolfe) and the good European colt Ekraar (second dam by Hoist the Flag).

The 2002 season hasn't been one of Red Ransom's best, supplying just three graded-stakes victories, but I am hopeful that 2003 is going to be more rewarding for the Vinery resident. He had several above-average juvenile winners to his credit in Europe, including the Group-placed fillies Cassis and Casual Look, and his 2003 juveniles should reflect the excellent results enjoyed by Red Ransom's stock in 1999, when Perfect Sting led a team of six graded winners.

European import Strawberry Blonde had a clear class advantage over this field, but needed every bit of courage and grit she could muster to take her first stakes success in the U.S. A Listed winner in France, she was transferred from trainer Eric Libaud to Christophe Clement upon arriving stateside in early autumn and promptly won a non-winners of three allowance test at Belmont Oct. 6. Faced with a yielding Aqueduct turf in her next, Strawberry Blonde was the runner-up to the classy Babae (Chi) in the GIII Athenia H. before finishing a head second to Wander Mom in the GIII My Charmer H. over Calder's lawn Dec. 7. The attractive grey was bet down to prohibitive odds here, but had to work hard for the victory. With Libretto turning for home under a full head of steam, Strawberry Blonde came after her quickly and needed every inch of the stretch to secure the narrow score.

NEWSPAPER CLAIMS THREATEN NEW SCANDAL

Officials at the Jockey Club are to look into claims made by a Sunday newspaper that jockey Gavin Faulkner is willing to sell tips for a share of the profit made on his information. Faulkner, who forms part of the team of Godolphin's conditioner David Loder in Newmarket, was alleged to have told a reporter from *The News of the World* that he could sell the inside information on stables he was involved with. Despite the absence of detail or evidence of individual tips in the report, the jockey's alleged claim that races are 'fixed' everyday may add further damage to the industry's reputation following the high-profile Graham Bradley case. He is also alleged to have offered to sell a horse that would be trained under a false licence. "*The News of the World* have offered to make available their information and we would be interested to see any evidence they have put together at first hand," John Maxse, the Jockey Club's public relations director told *PA Sport*. "As part of our investigation we will be interviewing Gavin Faulkner to hear his account of events."


