**EVERYTHING TO GAIN**

Jockey Jerry Bailey started the New Year on a positive note, guiding Ken and Sarah Ramsey's **Nothing To Lose** (Sky Classic) to a relatively easy win in yesterday's GIII Tropical Park Derby at Calder. A maiden winner for trainer Chuck Simon over the Saratoga turf Aug. 31, the homebred was turned over to D. Wayne Lukas and promptly finished fourth in main-track starts Oct. 19 at Keeneland and Nov. 16 at Churchill. The bay tallied a 3/4-length victory over this turf course Dec. 14 and was sent off the favorite to add the year's first Derby. Checked in traffic on the first turn, the homebred raced between horses to the far turn, was angled out for the drive and drew clear in the final 70 yards. "That was simple," Bailey commented. **YOU'RE ONLY AS OLD AS YOU FEEL**

Newly turned nine-year-old **Kona Gold** (Java Gold) celebrated the New Year in style, charging up the Santa Anita rail to run down longshot **Radiata** (Whitney Tower) for a narrow victory in yesterday's GIII El Conejo H. The remarkable gelding has now won his last five seasonal debuts, each in graded-stakes company, a streak that began with a win over the late Big Jag in the 1999 renewal of this event. The veteran made just three starts in 2002, winning the GIII Los Angeles H., his only victory at eight, before finishing sixth in the GII Triple Bend BC H. in July and a solid fourth to likely sprint champ Orientate in the BC Sprint Oct. 26. Ridden along at the back of the pack early as Radiata dictated the pace, Kona Gold began to rally approaching the stretch, got through along the rail and proved best. "When you're down on the rail going 5 1/2 furlongs, you're always concerned," commented winning rider Alex Solis, who has ridden Kona Gold in every start except his career debut in 1998. "He showed a lot of class and was very game." The winner is possible for the GII Palos Verdes H. Jan. 26.

Sweettrickydancer ran her winning streak to four with an off-the-pace success. Second by half a length in an Oct. 7 maiden over this lawn, the dark bay took off the blinkers and graduated by 1 1/2 lengths 20 days later before adding a first-level allowance score Nov. 16. Wheeled back on fourteen days' rest, she made it three straight with a one-length success in the Hollywood Wildcat S. over course and distance and was the second choice in the wagering behind U K Trick (Tricky Creek, fourth). Reserved towards the back of the pack for the opening half mile, Sweettrickydancer made steady progress four wide on the final bend, challenged for the lead leaving the eighth pole and inched clear. "Today's race was a little easier on her than the last one," winning trainer Rodolfo Garcia explained. "She had four weeks [to prepare] for this and only two before the last one. I actually ran her more as a two-year-old than I would normally prefer, but it has worked out fine. Fortunately the races for her now at Gulfstream are spaced well." The winner could make her next start in the Gill Herecomesthebride S. across town Feb. 1.

Wilzada has done little wrong since debuting a winner last January at the Big A, winning seven of 10 prior to this one. A fast-closing third in the GIII Safely Kept S. at Pimlico Sept. 14, she followed that one with a 7 1/4-length romp in the Half Moon S. over a sloppy Meadowlands track Oct. 11, then asserted by a head to win a contentious allowance test over the main track at Aqueduct Nov. 11. Confronted with similar underfoot conditions that she faced in the Half Moon, Wilzada was quickest into stride after breaking from post nine and established a confident lead while Blinded by Love drafted in second. As that foe came with her challenge turning for home, the bay kicked clear and left little doubt of her class in the final panel. "I looked like a fool complaining about the weights," said winning conditioner Anthony Dutrow, whose charge was top-weighted at 119 pounds. "She was awesome today. I was very impressed with how easy she did it. A wet track, no doubt, moves her up. We might get some pressure to run her in the [GII \$200,000] Barbara Fritchie H. [at Laurel Feb. 15]."

The chestnut was forwardly placed from the start, came after pacesetter Kingsland in the stretch and dug in to secure the narrow victory.

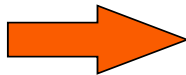
