KEENELAND JANUARY OPENS TODAY

Keeneland's 2003 January Horses of All Ages Sale begins its five-day run today in Lexington with bidding beginning daily at 10 a.m. The 1,907 horses catalogued for the auction includes 913 broodmares, 232 broodmare prospects, 492 yearlings, 130 racing or broodmare prospects, seven racing or stallion prospects, 11 stallion prospects, 116 racing prospects, six stallions and one stallion share. Broodmares on offer are in foal to such sires as Coronado's Quest, Cozzene, Dixieland Band, Forestry, Forest Wildcat, Fusaichi Pegasus, Giant's Causeway, Gulch, Hennessy, Monarchos, Out of Place, Pulpit, Silver Deputy, Tiznow, Unbridled's Song, Saint Ballado and War Chant. Stallions represented by yearlings in the catalog include Coronado's Quest, Deputy Minister, El Prado (Ire), Exploit, Forestry, Grand Slam, Our Emblem, Quiet American, Rahy, Tale of the Cat, Thunder Gulch and Unbridled's Song. Among the stallions with their first yearlings this year are juvenile champion Anees (Unbridled), MGISW Behrens (Pleasant Colony), Chester House (Mr. Prospector), Chief Seattle (Seattle Slew), Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector), Golden Missile (A.P. Indy), High Yield (Storm Cat), Impeachment (Deputy Minister), Belmont S. winner Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo), More than Ready (Southern Halo), Precise End (End Sweep), Royal Anthem (Theatrical {Ire}), GISW Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy), The Deputy (Ire) (Petardia), Vicar (Wild Again) and Breeders' Cup Mile winner War Chant (Danzig). During the 2002 January sale, gross sales totaled \$34,688,000 for 936 horses. The average price was \$37,059.

OCEAN RUNS DEEP IN SANTA YSABEL

With trainer Bob Baffert angling for the weekend double, having taken the GII San Pasqual H. on Saturday with his newly rejuvenated Congaree, the three-year-old filly **Atlantic Ocean** (Stormy Atlantic) lived up to her end of the agreement by overtaking **Sea Jewel** (Sea Hero) in the final panel and storming home to win the GIII Santa Ysabel S. yesterday at Santa Anita. The pricey \$1.9 million BESMAR two-year-old purchase, who took the Kentucky Cup Juvenile Fillies S. at Turfway in mid-September, had some questioning her ability after putting forth non-competitive off-the-board efforts in the GII Alcibiades S. Oct. 4 and the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies S. Oct. 26 before regaining some composure with a third-place finish in the Moccasin S. at Hollywood Nov. 16. Switched to the lawn in her next, the filly sparkled in a front-running score when annexing the GIII Miesque S. Nov. 29 and continued to gain off that performance. **Cont. p. 2**

San Dare, who captured the Kentucky Cup Ladies Turf in September, was coming off a runner-up finish in the Nov. 23 GIII Cardinal H. over a yielding Churchill Downs turf course. The 11-1 outsider was last of the 10-horse field in the early going, but forged into contention with a five-wide move turning for home. She closed stoutly in the middle of the track and battled head to head with Calista in the final strides to eke out a narrow victory. "She settled in real nice and I kept her in the clear," said winning rider Mark Guidry. "She runs hard every time, so turning for home I thought we had it. She dug in when she had to." Winning trainer Rick Hiles added, "We were afraid there might be a slow pace and when I saw the opening half-mile in :50.1, I was worried. But Mark told me this morning the turf course was a little soft and it should benefit our horse. The plan was to make one big move and it worked out just right. My mare isn't afraid to make a run at anyone." Hiles said San Dare would likely make her next start in the Feb. 8 GIII The Very One H.

Atlantic Ocean Takes Santa Ysabel cont. from p. 1

Away well under jockey David Flores, Atlantic Ocean took back a bit on the turn and let **Harbor Blues** (Petionville) and Sea Jewel battle it out up the backstretch. As the former began to tire rounding the far turn, Atlantic Ocean angled out to join Sea Jewel, then wore down that rival under brisk urging to earn her first graded victory on dirt. "We expected her to win, and she won, so what more can you ask for?" said Baffert from the winner's circle, who was pleased to see his charge perform well over the main track. "There's more money [to be won] on the dirt [as opposed to grass races], so we're really excited about it." Baffert indicated Atlantic Ocean might be pointed towards the Mar. 8 GI Santa Anita Oaks, where she'll likely face stablemate Composure. Click [here](#) for the brisnet.com chart.

THIS MONTH IN HISTORY...

January 5, 1980...Spectacular Bid began his undefeated four-year-old season, winning the Malibu S. by five lengths at Santa Anita; the gray colt finished his 1980 campaign with a perfect nine-for-nine record.

January 11, 1950...Five-year-old Citation returned after more than a year off to win an allowance race at Santa Anita. Sidelined after taking his 15th straight race, the Tanforan H. December 11, 1948, he claimed his 16th in a row at odds of 3-20 by a length and a half.

January 13, 1978...Seattle Slew, in training for his four-year-old seasonal debut at Hialeah, first displayed symptoms of the deadly virus Colitis X. The colt was sidelined until May 14, when he won an allowance race at Aqueeduct Racetrack as the 1-10 favorite.

Gulfstream Seeks Extra Days in '03-04:

After years of battling over racing dates with Hialeah, Gulfstream Park is taking on a new foe. Calder. Today is the last day for filing racing dates with the state for the 2003-2004 season. Gulfstream has applied for Dec. 26, 2003 through April 25, 2004--eight more days than its currently running 2003 meeting. The eight days are significant because they overlap with the final eight days of Calder's meeting. Calder applied for May 22 through Jan. 2, 2004--the same dates it has run the last two years. "We wanted to mirror the dates of Santa Anita as closely as possible," said Gulfstream president Scott Savin. Santa Anita, the Southern California track owned by Gulfstream's parent company Magna Entertainment, Inc., runs Dec. 26 through April 20. "We have until March 31 to tweak the dates," said Savin. "We did that last year with our current dates and we could go back and fine tune these." Hialeah President John Brunetti said, "I'm surprised. I was talking to Doug [Donn, the chairman of Gulfstream]. He said he's finally starting to figure [Frank] Stronach, [chairman of Magna] out. I still can't figure him out." Brunetti's Hialeah got caught in a squeeze two years ago when Calder and Gulfstream applied for overlapping dates, effectively causing Hialeah to shut down for the 2001 and 2002 season. Brunetti said he applied for Jan. 3 through April 25, 2004. "I want to be able to benefit from slots if they let them come into the state. We're the oldest track in Florida and we deserve to be a part of the mix." Calder president Ken Dunn said, "I'm disappointed. Gulfstream and Magna appear to be trying to change a pretty cooperative effort between the two tracks [Calder and Gulfstream] to effect legislative and racing changes in South Florida. It's probably pretty foolish. It makes it hard to work with them after they send a shot across our bow."

Switched over to the barn of trainer Bruce Levine, the filly ran third in a six-furlong test at Aqueduct Nov. 9, but found the competition too tough and finished seventh in her most recent start, the Gill Valley Stream S. over that same track and distance Nov. 24. Sent off the third-longest shot on the board for new trainer Joseph Catanese, the dark bay took command soon after the start, extended her advantage to two lengths at the top of the stretch and remained tough in the run to the wire to hold off Something Silver.

Rebounding from a special weight contest in which she ran a zero Beyer figure, Lizzy Cool added blinkers and romped wire-to-wire over trip and track versus \$75,000 maiden claimers Dec. 18, but was dismissed here as the longest shot on the board in her first test against winners. Sent to the fore under jockey Chuck Lopez, the chestnut filly was allowed to run loose on the lead through relaxed fractions of :23 and :46 2/5 before being challenged by the favored Reign of Tara (Beau Genius). Refusing to relent, however, Lizzy Cool kept that foe at bay to register her first stakes win. "When they said 'Go,' she got up and left," Lopez said. "There isn't much else to say. We got the lead and she dug in." Next up for the filly could be the \$75,000 Dearly Precious S. Feb. 15.
