**CAN YOU HEAR THE DRUMS?**

A field of eight four-year-olds has been entered for the \$200,000 GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. this afternoon at Santa Anita, but they've all got something to prove. **Tizbud** (Cee's Tizzy) drew more than a few comparisons to full brother Tiznow--winner of this event in 2001--in breaking his maiden by six lengths Nov. 14; this will be his first start against winners. And then there's a pair of solid runners who have taken their game on the road. The stakes-winning **Pass Rush** (Crown Ambassador) is an Indiana-bred who nearly wired the field before finishing second in the Great State Challenge Classic at Lone Star Dec. 7. **Tracemark** (Conquistador Cielo), winner of the California Derby last April, has been the runner-up in both the GIII Lone Star Derby and the GIII Affirmed H., the latter to Came Home. **Century City (Ire)** (Danzig) and **Mananan McLir** (Royal Academy) are graded-stakes winners on grass, but neither has ever done more than train over the main track. Trainer Wally Dollase tried the turf-to-dirt maneuver with Helmsman in 1996 and was rewarded with a Strub success; he hopes Mananan McLir can do the same. "We got lucky with Helmsman," Dollase said. "He won the Strub and we're hoping we can do the same with Mananan McLir. That's everyone's objective with a four-year-old, to win the Strub. He's always worked well on the dirt, so we decided to give him a chance." The bay most recently ran second in the GI Hollywood Derby Dec. 1.

**INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR TO MM SESSION**

Buyers representing several countries, including Ireland, South Africa and Korea, among others, were active during yesterday's second session of the Magic Millions Yearling Sale in Australia. The afternoon's trade was highlighted by a bay colt by supersire Danehill who was knocked down for a session best A\$320,000 to the bid of Graeme Rogerson Bloodstock. The October 2 foal, consigned by Baramul Stud of Widden Valley, is out of the Listed stakes-winning Altrista (NZ) (Sir Tristram {Ire}), who was third in the G1 Wellington Cup during her racing days. The 10-year-old mare is from a solid female family, which also includes the stakes winners Capestad (NZ) (Kaaestad {NZ}) and Zalinda (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}). South Africa's World Wide Bloodstock was the successful bidder on hip 423, a striking black colt by Octagonal (NZ). From the consignment of Wattle Brae Stud, the half brother to black-type winner Catango (Aus) (Catrail) and out of the 100-percent producer Dancer's Choice (Aus) (Bletchingly {Aus}), was sold for A\$260,000. "David Ferraris, the leading trainer in South Africa, will train him for us," said Andy Williams, representing the buyer. "He's a real racy type. Overall, he's a lovely looker and I'm pleased to have purchased him." *Magic Millions Friday cont. p. 4*

**DOWN THE AISLE FILLY TOPS KEENELAND FINALE**

A filly from the first crop of Grade I winner Down the Aisle (Runaway Groom) topped yesterday's final session of the Keeneland January Horses of All Ages Sale in Lexington. The yearling, out of She's Ok (Tsunami Slew), was consigned by Spendthrift Farm LLC, agent, and was purchased for \$70,000 by Maria and William Blase. Stakes winner **Rosa's Delaware** (Septieme Ciel), selling as a broodmare or racing prospect was the next highest priced lot at \$60,000. The six-year-old mare, consigned by Glendalough, agent, was purchased by Richard Kaster. During the five-day auction, Keeneland sold 1,185 horses for a total of \$31,186,000 and an average of \$26,317. The median price was \$10,000. At last year's four-day sale, 1,134 horses sold for \$34,688,000. The sale average was \$37,060 and the median was \$12,750. The sale-topping broodmare was Belle Nuit (Dr. Carter). The 13-year-old mare, in foal to Unbridled's Song, was consigned by Taylor Made Sales, agent, and was purchased for \$475,000 by Louis Brooks Ranch Ltd. A son of Kentucky Derby winner Charismatic brought the top yearling price of \$400,000. Consigned by James Conway, agent, the colt was purchased by Tracy Farmer. Taylor Made Sales Agency was the auction's leading consignor with \$4,064,600 in sales. Blandford Bloodstock was the top buyer with purchases totaling \$976,300.

**IRISH STAKES CALENDAR EXPANDS** Eight Irish stakes events have been upgraded and 14 new Listed races created following a meeting of the European Pattern Committee in Stockholm. Among the four Group 3 events to have been promoted to Group 2 status in 2003 is Leopardstown's 10-furlong Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial, which has been won by the last three Epsom and Irish Derby winners: Sindar (Ire), Galileo (Ire) and High Chaparral (Ire). Also set for Group 2 status are the mile Matron S., run at Leopardstown, as well as The Curragh's Juddmonte Beresford S. over a mile, and the six-furlong Anheuser Busch Railway S., won in the last two years by Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) and Hold That Tiger. Leopardstown's Ballysax S., which has also been contested by the last three Derby winners, has been upgraded to Group 3 from Listed status alongside the track's seven-furlong Brownstown S., which drops down from a mile. The Curragh's seven-furlong Athasi S. and Mooresbridge S., over 10 furlongs, will also carry group status for the first time this year. "HRI is delighted to have secured these eight pattern promotions which, coupled with the 14 new Listed races added this year, will see a significantly enhanced flat black type programme for Ireland for 2003," Jason Morris, director of racing for Horse Racing Ireland, said yesterday. "These measures are due recognition of the high quality of the Irish flat horse population and mean that Irish racegoers will be provided with even more opportunities to witness high-class, international competition during the 2003 flat season."

**Tates Creek**, a winner of four graded stakes last year, is seeking her third straight victory in her five-year-old bow. The chestnut mare tired to sixth in the 1 3/16-miles GI Beverly D. before winning the one-mile GIII Noble Damsel H. Sept. 21 and ended her 2002 campaign with a neck victory in the nine-furlong GI Las Palmas H. Nov. 3. Trainer Neil Drysdale will saddle both **Magic Mission** and **Double Cat** for the San Gorgonio. Magic Mission, group-placed in France, was third in the Las Palmas and is coming off a late-closing third-place effort in the Dec. 1 GI Matriarch. "Magic Mission is training very well," Drysdale said. "I'm very pleased with her." Double Cat won a Turf Paradise stakes before running fifth in the Dec. 21 GII Dahlia H. Of her chances, Drysdale said, "Double Cat, well, we'd be happy if she hits the board. She's going to be bred this year to A.P. Indy. She was compromised a little bit the other day by soft ground when she finished fifth in the Dahlia over a 'good' course at Hollywood."

After breaking his maiden for \$62,000 at Hollywood last June, **Pine for Java** was thrown into the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship where he tired to sixth. Winless in six starts since that effort, the chestnut colt was nosed out of a victory at this distance in a Dec. 19 \$80,000 optional claimer at Hollywood last time out. **Buddy Gil** stormed to a 7 1/2-length victory in the Nov. 24 Golden Bear S. over six furlongs, but faded to fifth after dueling for the early lead in the Gold Rush S. over a sloppy track Dec. 14. **Ozzie Cat**, a maiden winner at Keeneland in October, is coming off a third-place effort at this distance in a Dec. 28 Santa Anita allowance contest. After running fourth in the Oct. 19 Sunny Slope S., **Spensive** ventured north to take the Gold Rush S. by a head with jockey Julie Krone in the irons. Russell Baze gets the call today.

**A Magic Millions First...**

History was made at the Gold Coast yesterday when Korean interests bought their first-ever yearling at the sale. Lee Jong Won, a director of the Seoul Racehorse Owners Association and owner of SS Farm in Korea, seemed just a casual observer to the bidding on hip 279 when, with a single bid at A\$160,000, he became the owner of a bay colt from the first crop of six-year-old Catbird (Aus) (Danehill), the winner of the G1 Golden Slipper S. in his juvenile season. "In Korea there are about 2000 broodmares and only 24 stallions," explained Magic Millions International Director Don Hancock. "So they bought this colt as he has a lovely pedigree. He is from a Storm Bird mare." The Sept. 24 foal is out of Wild At Heart, a 3/4 sister to Italian 1000 Guineas winner Lonely Bird (Storm Bird) and a half to U.S. Grade II winner Hal's Pal (GB) (Caerleon). The Korean Thoroughbred Industry is in a period of solid growth, according to Hancock. "There is currently only one track in Korea, but a second will be opened at Busan in 2004," he said. Currently, racing on the island takes place Saturdays and Sundays and attracts huge crowds and betting turnover which rivals that of Hong Kong.

**TWO ITEM LIMIT RETIRED** **Two Item Limit** (Twining--Spa Warning, by Caveat) has been retired from racing and will begin her broodmare career at Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky. The five-year-old mare captured the 2000 GII Demoiselle S. and GIII Tempted S., as well as the 2001 renewals of the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. and GIII Comely S. Also in 2001, she was second in the GI Gazelle H., GI Las Virgenes and third in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff and GI Alabama. Last year, Two Item Limit was third in the GI Ogden Phipps H. "She was a very, very special filly to be associated with," said owner Joseph Graffeo. "She won her career debut in May of her two-year-old year and thrilled us with graded stakes performances at Santa Anita, Belmont, Saratoga, Aqueduct, Delaware and Pimlico all the way through to the very end of her four-year-old year." From 28 outings, Two Item Limit was on the board in 15 races with seven victories and earnings of \$1,060,584. Breeding plans for 2003 have not been determined.

**PRADO NAMED '03 WOOLF AWARD WINNER** Jockey Edgar Prado has been named the winner of the 2003 George Woolf Memorial Jockey Award. The 37-year-old Peruvian will receive the award in a winner's circle ceremony at a date to be determined later in the Santa Anita meet. Prado is the 54th winner of the award which honors the memory of one of the greatest Thoroughbred jockeys in history and is awarded annually to riders whose careers and personal character reflect positively on themselves and on the sport of Thoroughbred racing. "It's amazing," Prado said of the award. "I've achieved a lot of things and winning this award kind of caps it. I want to thank the jockeys for voting and the owners and trainers for giving me the opportunities to ride." Prado, who began his riding career in Peru, dominated the Maryland circuit in the 1990s. He moved his tack to New York in 1999. Last year, his mounts earned over \$18 million. Previous winners of the George Woolf Award include Bill Shoemaker, Eddie Arcaro, Laffit Pincay, Angel Cordero, Chris McCarron, Pat Day, Jerry Bailey, Kent Desormeaux, Gary Stevens and Russell Baze.

**MAGNA LAUNCHES HORSERACING TV** Magna Entertainment, which owns and operates 13 racetracks in the U.S., has launched HorseRacing TV, a new 24-hour cable television network that will provide live coverage of Thoroughbred, harness and Quarter Horse racing from more than 70 tracks in North America. HRTV will offer exclusive coverage from the Magna tracks, including Gulfstream Park and Santa Anita. The network will broadcast live racing 15 hours a day, with replays and educational segments related to the sport completing their programming. Wagering will be available on all HRTV racing through XpressBet, Magna's account wagering system. The station will be a free basic service for cable operators, and Magna will guarantee per-subscriber carriage fees to operators in the 34 states where XpressBet accepts wagers; where the company owns, operates or manages tracks; and wherever they deem horse racing coverage to be strategically important. HRTV has been launched in San Diego on Time Warner Cable and in Western Pennsylvania.

**KEATS (h, 5, Hennessy--Alaska Queen, by Time for a Change)** had won two of his three previous starts here at Gulfstream and showcased his front-running style again with this victory. Winner of the GII Coolmore Lexington S. at three, the dark bay had an abbreviated campaign at four, when he was sidelined following a third in the GII New Orleans H. last March. He made it back to the races Nov. 26, running sixth in a Churchill allowance, and was made the 8-5 chalk in his 2003 bow. Breaking alertly, he quickly opened a clear lead and sped his way around the oval to win by two lengths while missing the track record by just three ticks. The National Thoroughbred Racing Association's Wagering Technology Working Group met Thursday by teleconference. During the meeting, the group discussed the wagering review sub-committee's work to date and recommended that the results of its detailed review of consolation tickets in connection with the Breeders' Cup Ultra Pick Six be shared with the Illinois Racing Board. In addition, the group considered additional security enhancement steps under review by the TRA 20/20 Committee and agreed that these items should be added to the scope of the Working Group's work. The Working Group reviewed and endorsed the recommendation of Giuliani Partners for a series of interim public reports on findings and recommendations of the system security studies now underway. A schedule for these reports will be developed in the near future. "Overall, speaking for the Working Group, we are pleased with the progress of the various initiatives now underway," said NTRA Commissioner Tim Smith. "Improvements in wagering security have been made already and more will be implemented in the coming weeks and months. Industry cooperation and support for the NTRA Wagering Integrity Alliance continues to be strong."

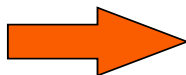
