### SUNDAY SILENCE COLT TOPS MM SATURDAY

A celebratory mood prevailed at the Magic Millions Yearling Sale following last night's robust third round. The session was topped by Lot 455, a Sunday Silence colt out of Engraver (Miner's Mark) that was purchased by Vinery principal Dr. Tom Simon for A\$900,000. Consigned by Strawberry Hill Stud, the bay is from the family of Secretariat and Sir Gaylord. His second dam is Heavenly Match, who produced Grade I winner Personal Business and graded-stakes winner In Conference.

Simon snared the top lot as a potential stallion prospect, either for Vinery's Hunter Valley facility or possibly Vinery Kentucky. "He must race successful and prove himself here and then we will see," he said. Pre-sale predictions were measured, with most hoping that Magic Millions would maintain its 2002 average of A\$82,205--a drop of 4.3 percent on 2001. But a solid middle market for precocious yearlings and the presence of purchasers from Hong Kong, Japan, Korea and South Africa has ensured a strong sale. Yearlings by freshman sires including Fasliyev, Xaar (GB) and Redoute's Choice (Aus) are proving especially popular. "It does look as if we are going to do a bit better [than 2002]," said Magic Millions co-proprietor Gerry Harvey, who owns 50 percent of the Gold Coast sale company. "I think that is pretty good considering the lousy state of the share market. That would have taken some of the shine off them, with the amount of money they have lost--I know what I have lost on the share market." Harvey, who in addition to owning the sales company also consigns through his Stud Baramul, was an active buyer at the sale as well, with Adrian Nicoll purchasing fillies for syndicates that will also involve individuals including John Magnier, Robert Sangster, David Hayes and Rob Ferguson. "I asked Adrian to pick out the best 15 to 20 fillies in the sale and buy them and we will form syndicates with four in each one," Harvey said. "I won't have anything to do with it to keep it above board." The Magic Millions sale continues today. The fifth and final session will be held Tuesday. (*Stats, top lots, p4*)

### PASSING THE TEST

His only previous stakes victory was against fellow Indiana-breds, but Michael Tabor's **Pass Rush** (Crown Ambassador) proved his class yesterday, rallying wide into the stretch for a convincing win in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita. The runner-up in the Iowa Derby at Prairie Meadows and in the Round Table S. at Arlington, the chestnut was sixth in the GIII West Virginia Derby and the GIII Indiana Derby before taking the Benjamin Harrison S. for state-breds Oct. 26. Second to Najran in a tough Churchill allowance test Nov. 9, he was most recently a pacesetting second in the Great State Challenge Classic in Texas Dec. 7. Shipped to the West Coast to face fellow four-year-olds, Pass Rush was well respected by the Santa Anita faithful and did not disappoint. Pass Rush was a forward factor, bid four wide into and around the turn, took a short lead into the stretch and pulled clear. "I'll tell you, considering he drew outside and there was a little bit of speed inside of us, he ran very well," said winning rider Corey Nakatani. "Hopefully I've got a Strub mount." The winner is under consideration for that \$400,000 event Feb. 1. Tates Creek, winning for the fifth time in her last six efforts, will get a break following an easier-than-it-looked victory in the GII San Gorgonio H. The winner of a Belmont allowance July 6, the Juddmonte homebred returned three weeks later to decision the solid Voodoo Dancer by a nose in the GII Diana H. at Saratoga. Last of six in the 9 1/2-furlong GI Beverly D. Aug. 17, the chestnut dropped back to a mile to take the GIII Noble Damsel H. at Belmont Sept. 21 and was making her first start since taking the GII Las Palmas H. over track and trip Nov. 3. Double Cat, making the final start of her career, took control early and set a soft pace, flanked every step of the way by Tates Creek. The latter began to turn up the heat entering the far turn, took a short lead leaving the midstretch marker and covered the final eighth of a mile in :11.04 to safely account for her stablemate. "I told Patrick [jockey Valenzuela] that he probably wouldn't be that far off the lead," commented winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "She broke well, so he had nothing to do but be dragged right up there for the lead. It was a perfect trip for her. Tates Creek will get a rest. Hopefully, I can get a Grade I with her next summer at Hollywood Park."

Zonk had won two of her three previous tries over the Big A inner track, including last year's Affectionately, and she successfully defended her title with an impressive effort. The chestnut followed her 2002 score in this event with a second in the GIII Rare Treat H., then added an inner-track allowance victory Mar. 10. She never got untracked in her next start, however, finishing last, 33 lengths behind winner With Ability, in the Mar. 29 GIII Next Move H. on the Aqueduct main track. Sidelined after that outing, the Fox Hill Farm colorbearer returned to be second in a Laurel allowance Nov. 2 and ended the campaign with another runner-up finish in the Nov. 29 GII Top Flight H. The crowd's choice to repeat, she tracked the wicked pace set by Pocus Hocus (Quiet American), dashed past the frontrunner as they raced around the far turn and opened up on the field to win handily. "She didn't break real sharp and Persky (Candy Stripes) kind of hung her out there a little bit, but she recovered nicely," trainer John Servis said. "I thought [jockey C.C. Lopez] might have moved a little too soon at first, but you could see that as soon as she got to running, she was just galloping along. I think she is better now than ever. She ran awesome today." Lopez added, "She destroyed them." Zonk could cut back in distance for the seven-furlong GII Barbara Fritchie H. at Laurel Park Feb. 15. Windsor Castle earned his lone win of 2002 in a Saratoga allowance test Sept. 2 and ran creditably in his next two, getting third in the Oct. 4 GII Meadowlands Cup, where he finished just behind subsequent GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero Volponi, and second in the Nov. 5 GIII Stuyvesant H. Sixth in the Nov. 30 GI Cigar Mile to end the season, he bounced back in his first appearance of the new year. Outrun early as first Hail the Chief (Be My Chief) and then Najran took them along, the five-year-old came flying from the outside in the stretch to catch Najran in the final sixteenth before drawing clear. "He lost about 10 days of training because he popped a quarter crack and I almost didn't run him," winning trainer Frank Alexander admitted, but added, "He's a light horse, but I thought we'd take a shot at it. He was a good horse today and [jockey Eibar Coa rode a hell of a race." According to Coa, the race went exactly according to plan. "I knew there was a lot of speed in there, so I wanted to go slow the first part of it," he said. "When I asked him...he really responded for me." Alexander has not yet decided if he will run Windsor Castle back in the GI Donn H. Feb. 22. "I'll take a look at it and we'll play it by ear," he said. Hero's Tribute (Sea Hero), the slight 2-1 favorite, settled just off the early leaders, was checked in traffic and lacked a late response after he got clear, finishing fourth. Standard Setter set strong fractions and dug in gamely in the drive to become the first stakes winner for his sire. The chestnut broke his maiden by nine for a \$25,000 tag last May before finishing second in the Malcom Anderson S. and the Alameda County Futurity. Rested off that July 5 effort, he returned to be third in a Dec. 20 starter allowance and was making his two-turn bow in this spot. Hustled away from the gate, Standard Setter got the half mile in :45 2/5, saw his lead dwindle to a length as favored Ozzie Cat bridged the gap, but the frontrunner repulsed that bid leaving the eighth pole and held gamely. Pine For Java closed well from last to complete the trifecta.
