THE ROCK RULES THE CLASSIFICATIONS

Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) (Danehill) was yesterday named the highweight when the 26th International Classifications were announced at Portman Square in London Wednesday. Rated on 128 pounds for completing his record-breaking sequence of seven consecutive Group 1 victories in 2002, the Aidan O'Brien-trained colt finished one pound ahead of the top-rated older horse, Godolphin's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero **Marienbard (Ire)** (Caerleon). "As far as ratings this year are concerned, it was a disappointing year," British Horseracing Board Senior Handicapper Nigel Gray commented. "Although the horse making the headlines was Rock of Gibraltar, Marienbard is a fine advertisement for keeping horses in training. It was a year in which there weren't many three-year-olds that captured the imagination."

Arc Winner Continues Godolphin's Streak...

Godolphin collected their fourth consecutive older-horse title with Marienbard, who at 127 pounds is the lowest-rated middle-distance champion since the ratings began and superior only to 1991's joint champion older horses Epervier Bleu (GB) and Priolo. But that is not to take anything away from a successful five-year-old season for Marienbard. The dark bay strung together victories in the G1 WGZ Bank Deutschland Preis at Dusseldorf in July and the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden Sept. 1 prior to his 3/4-length success over three-year-olds **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) and **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the Longchamp centerpiece. The latter two were rated the co-second highest rated sophomores on the Classifications behind 'The Rock.' Sulamani's campaign was highlighted by his upset 1 1/2-length victory over **Act One (GB)** (In the Wings {GB}), while Michael Tabor's High Chaparral won four consecutive starts last season, capped by his back-to-back wins in the G1 Vodafone Derby and the June 30 G1 Irish Derby. "It has been a modest year, but we have been spoilt by the likes of Daylami, Dubai Millennium and Sinndar in recent years," said Irish handicapper Garry O'Gorman. "There are years like this such as in 1992, 1993 and 1994 when only one horse was rated above 130 in each of those years." *Full list, p3*

Other Divisional Winners...

Heading the juvenile ratings was the John Gosden-trained **Oasis Dream (GB)** (Green Desert), who broke Newmarket's course record in winning the G1 Middle Park S. Despite topping the juvenile division, Oasis Dream's final rating beats only 1992's champion Grand Lodge, although the Pascal Bary-trained **Six Perfections (Fr)** (Celtic Swing {GB}) achieved a highly respectable rating of 121 pounds, one pound below last year's champion juvenile filly Queen's Logic (Ire). **Orientate** (Mt. Livermore) headed the sprinting division on 124 pounds and **Vinnie Roe (Ire)** (Definite Article {GB}) the stayers' list on 119 pounds. In general, the Classifications point to a scarcity of brilliance in 2002, with nothing breaking the 130 mark for the first time since ratings began. **Azeri** (Jade Hunter), who is in line for U.S. Horse of the Year honors, was named the best older filly at 125 pounds.

ELUSIVE CITY DQ CONFIRMED *Elusive City* (Elusive Quality) has had his first two career victories wiped from the record books after it was confirmed by the Jockey Club's Disciplinary Committee that post-race tests were found to contain the banned substance omeprazole. The colt was disqualified from a maiden race win at Lingfield July 17 and the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood July 30, but will remain the victor of the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 25. The earnings of the two British races, £47,023, will have an impact on the sire list for 2002 U.S. leading freshman sire as Elusive Quality was in a tight title race with Distorted Humor. Trainer Gerard Butler was fined a total of £1,200 after being found in breach of Rule 51. The Blewbury conditioner's **Inchberry (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}) was also disqualified from victory at Hamilton Aug. 20 for the same offence.

ALPHA STATUS FOR OMEGA CODE Offers are rolling in for **Omega Code** (Elusive Quality), impressive winner of the GIII San Miguel S. last Sunday. The Florida-bred colt covered the six furlongs in 1:08.65. "There's a possibility of a sale," said trainer Wesley Ward. "We're entertaining a bunch of offers and we'll kind of go from there. It's a bunch of different interests, so we're just trying to see which way it goes." Ward indicated that it was a seven-figure offer. The three-year-old will be among the preliminary entries for the \$250,000 Sunshine Millions Dash next weekend at Gulfstream Park. "I nominated him to the race," said Ward. "He ran fast and got a two on the Ragozin Sheets, [so] by all means he should be 'bouncing,' but right now he's bouncing around the barn. I have to look at all my options.

SUNSHINE MILLIONS UPDATE *Mayakovsky* (Matty G), winner of his turf debut last week, is "95 percent sure" to go in the \$1 million Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Park next Saturday, according to trainer Patrick Biancone. "I'm going to pre-enter him in both races [Classic and the \$500,000 Turf at Santa Anita]," said the conditioner. "I would wait a little bit to decide. What is the big deal?" Meanwhile, trainer Craig Lewis has decided on the \$750,000 Distaff at Santa Anita for **Nicole's Pursuit** (Flying Continental) instead of the \$350,000 F/M Turf at Gulfstream. "We've had a change of plans," said Lewis. "I've weighed both races and the filly is probably almost as good on the dirt, and one race is for \$350,000, which is obviously a nice number, but \$750,000 has a better ring to it, and I won't have to ship." Working towards a start in the \$250,000 Sprint at Santa Anita was **Debonair Joe** (Ole), who scored at boxcar odds in both the GI Malibu S. and the GIII Vernon O. Underwood H. The four-year-old went a half in :47 with Julie Krone aboard. "He wasn't tired or anything," said trainer Juan Pablo Silva. "He came out very happy."

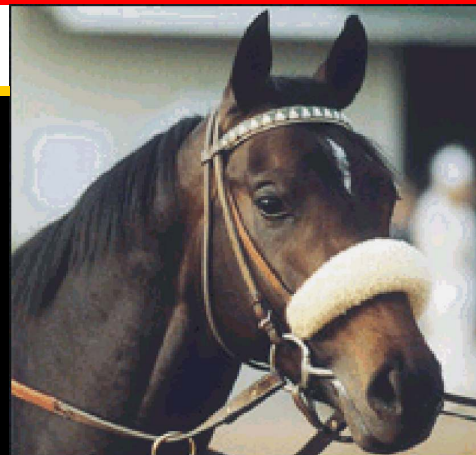

Unraced since that effort and adding Lasix for this, the gelding stalked favored Castle Gandolfo, as that one set tepid early fractions. Switched out for the drive, the Irish-bred split horses at midstretch and again inside the final sixteenth, outfinishing Duke of Green for the win.

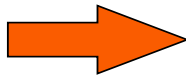
