A full field of 13 has been drawn for Gulfstream Park's first step on the road to the Triple Crown, the GIII Holy Bull S. All eyes will be squarely focused on the

inside post position from where Sovereign Award and GIII Nashua S. winner **Added Edge** (Smart Strike) will begin his sophomore campaign. Owned by Barry Irwin's Team Valor Stable and Robert Wilson, the handsome chestnut puts his undefeated record on the line tomorrow afternoon as the likely favorite. Jockey Patrick Husbands, who has been riding very well at the

meet, has the call for trainer Mark Casse. Sure to attract his fair share of attention is Starlight Stable's **Bham** (Pulpit). The bay colt, conditioned by Todd Pletcher, proved that he belongs in the upper echelon of his generation with a runner-up finish behind Eclipse Award candidate Toccet in the GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct Nov. 30. The other undefeated colt in the race is **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) who will be stretching out to two turns and trying open company for the first time Saturday. The New York-bred is a dual stakes winner, including the one-mile Sleepy Hollow S. Oct. 19, but will have to overcome the outside post.

EL ENCINO S.-GII, \$150,000, 4yo, f, 1 1/16m

Bare Necessities (Silver Deputy), an eight-length winner of the GIII Indiana Breeders' Cup Oaks last Oct. 4, makes her return to the races in the middle leg of Santa Anita's La Canada series. Despite being unraced since her close runner-up finish in the GII Churchill Downs Distaff Nov. 9, her jockey is high on her chances this weekend. "After her last race, they sent her to the farm and she's been brought back with this race in mind," said Jose Valdivia Jr. "She's been training unbelievable and it seems like she's improving with each and every race, so I look forward to her running a very, very big race." In other race developments, Dec. 29 GI La Brea S. heroine **Got Koko** (Signal Tap) is on target following a solid five-furlong drill Tuesday at Santa Anita in 1:02, a move deemed "perfect" by her trainer Bruce Headley. **Bella Bellucci** (French Deputy) blew out a half mile in :51 at Hollywood Park for trainer Neil Drysdale. The grey was most recently fourth, beaten a little over four lengths, in the La Brea.

Orseno Run for Stronach Over:

Joe Orseno, who has trained the winners of over 2,000 races in a career that spans 25 years, has re-opened a public stable and retains just one horse for former main client Frank Stronach, the owner of Gulfstream Park. "We had a great run," Orseno told *Daily Racing Form*. "But my contract with Mr. Stronach is up and all I've got left for him is Krieger." That son of Lord At War (Arg) finished second for Orseno in the GII Appleton H. over the Gulfstream turf course Jan. 4. Orseno and Stronach teamed for some important victories over the past several years, including Red Bullet's Preakness win in 2000 and Breeders' Cup successes in the same year with champions Macho Uno and Perfect Sting. He also trained GISWs Collect the Cash and Golden Missile. Orseno said he has a string of 17 horses in Florida this winter for clients including Eugene and Laura Melnyk and Dogwood Stable.

KRC Approves Oaks Future Bet:

Given the overwhelming success of the Kentucky Derby Future Wager (KDFW), the Kentucky Racing Commission has approved a similar wager for the filly counterpart, the GI Kentucky Oaks. As opposed to the three different pools offered for the KDFW, there will be just one four-day wagering period for the Oaks, which will coincide with the final KDFW pool Apr. 3-6. "Racing fans have proven in growing numbers that they love the Kentucky Derby Future Wager and we're very pleased to offer them an exciting new product," said Jim Gates, acting general manager of Churchill Downs. Additionally, the dates for the 2003 KDFW have been set. Pool one will run Feb. 13-16 followed by a second wagering opportunity Mar. 13-16. Combined wagering on last year's Future Wager was in excess of \$1.5 million, more than double that of the amount wagered in its first year in 1999.

Turfway Cancels Thursday Card:

Turfway Park in Florence, Kentucky, cancelled its live racing card Thursday night due to heavy snowfall and cold temperatures in the Greater Cincinnati-Northern Kentucky area. The cancellation is the first since the beginning of the Winter-Spring meeting Jan. 1. Racing is scheduled to resume this evening with first post at 5:30 p.m.

Texas Champions Announced:

Never worse than second in seven starts as a juvenile, **Leo's Last Hurrah** (Leo Castelli) has been named Texas-bred horse of the year and champion two-year-old colt or gelding. The bay colt won five of those starts, three of those stakes events, including the Sam Houston Texan Juvenile S. Nov. 16. By virtue of her victory in Santa Anita's GI La Brea S. Dec. 29, **Got Koko** (Signal Tap) was the obvious choice for champion three-year-old filly honors. Her dam, **Baby North** (Northern Baby) was named broodmare of the year. Other divisional winners include **Parting** (Hay Halo, two-year-old filly); **Fitzroyal** (Desert Royalty, three-year-old colt/gelding); **Boots On Sunday** (Pine Bluff, older horse/gelding); and **Coastalota** (Dixieland Heat, older filly/mare).

"He's been wanting to do something and he went off nice and easy," the conditioner commented. "[Another] horse came up on him and [Sarava] just sprung away from him real quick. He enjoyed it." In other news from the Baffert stable, 2001 GII Strub S. winner **Wooden Phone** (Pick Up the Phone) went three furlongs in :36 4/5. The six-year-old gelding has not raced since defeating Euchre by a head in the GII San Pasqual H. in January 2002.

Baze Wins Another Murphy Award:

Northern California based jockey Russell Baze has been named the winner of the Isaac Murphy Award for the eighth consecutive year. The award is presented by the National Turf Writers Association to the jockey with the highest winning percentage (based on a minimum 500 mounts) during the year. Inaugurated in 1995, Baze is the only jockey to ever win the award. Last year, the veteran reinsman won with 431 of his 1,508 mounts for a strike rate of 28.6 percent, according to *Daily Racing Form* statistics. Baze has eclipsed the 400-win mark in 10 of the past 11 years and would likely have reached that level in 1999, but injury cost him part of the year. The Isaac Murphy Award is named in honor of the 19th century jockey who won with an astounding 44 percent of his career mounts.

WEST POINT WINS IN DUBAI

The U.S. based operation West Point Thoroughbreds had a winner Thursday night in Dubai when **Seattle Fitz (Arg)** (Fitzcarraldo {Arg}) landed the UAE 2000 Guineas Prep. The bay colt was the co-sale topper of the Pearls of Dubai International juvenile sale Oct. 12 when West Point signed his ticket for Dhs500,000. He captured his Nov. 28 debut by seven lengths, then disappointed when sixth in the Al Nakhlee S. Dec. 26. Never far from the front in this nine-horse affair, Seattle Fitz took over at the top of the stretch and came home 1 3/4 lengths clear of **Channel Four** (Gold Fever). He was one of three winners on the night for trainer Kieran McLaughlin, who indicated that the Argentine-bred sophomore would now target the UAE 2000 Guineas Feb. 13. "[He was] fantastic tonight," said McLaughlin. "I could not have been more pleased. This dude has a bright future."
