AN OFFLEE CLOSE FINISH

Dismissed at 27-1 in his stakes debut, **Offlee Wild** (Wild Again) prevailed in a ding-dong battle with **Powerful Touch** (Touch Gold) to win the GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream Saturday afternoon. The \$325,000

Keeneland September yearling broke his maiden by five lengths in his second start at Churchill Oct. 27 and followed up with a second in an allowance under the Twin Spires Nov. 17. He had been training impressively at Gulfstream in recent weeks, posting a bullet five-eighths in :59

over a sloppy track Tuesday, but with no two-turn experience to his credit, was let go at long odds in this big field. Jockey Mark Guidry had the colt ready at the start and sent him up to stalk **Bham** (Boston Harbor) and **Powerful Touch** through three-quarters in 1:11.43. Moving three wide at the top of the stretch, Offlee Wild hooked up with a game **Powerful Touch** and turned it into a real horse race, getting the nod at the wire. "I tried getting him to swap leads one time, but he wouldn't do it, so I stopped trying," Guidry explained. "We had the wire coming up and I didn't want to fool with that any more, so he did it on his own." It was the second Holy Bull win for trainer Tom Smith, who took the 1999 renewal with **Grits'n Hard Toast**. "Holy cow, we won the Holy Bull!" quipped the conditioner. "I think he will go a lot farther than he did today. He's the best horse I've ever trained. I imagine the Fountain of Youth [GI, 8.5f, Feb. 15] will be next." Offlee Wild was produced by a half-sister to **Dynaformer** and is from the family of Kentucky Derby hero **Monarchos**. The year didn't start nearly as well for **Added Edge** (Smart Strike), Canada's champion two-year-old, who had been previously unbeaten. The 9-5 favorite looked to have a prime position on the rail just behind the leaders, but began to back up on the far turn and wound up last. *Chart, p2*

NO DISPUTING THE WINNER

Gary Garber's homebred **Domestic Dispute** (Unbridled's Song) stamped himself as a Classics contender with a smooth success in the GII Santa Catalina S. yesterday at Santa Anita. The rangy chestnut, a winner second time out at Del Mar Sept. 7, finished ninth to Soto when stretched out for the first time in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 30. With that effort under his belt, he crossed the line third in the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 21 before moving up to second upon the DQ of stablemate **Kafwain**. **Domestic Dispute** breezed a bullet six furlongs in 1:11 3/5 in preparation for his three-year-old bow and looked sharp from the start, stalking the pace set by **Our Bobby V.** (Majesterian). The long-striding colt moved to the lead as they straightened away in the stretch and opened up over the honest pacesetter, with highly regarded **Scrimshaw** (Gulch) settling for third. "I don't know [what's next for him]," said winning trainer Bob Baffert, "but I don't think he can run until March now [GII San Rafael S., Mar. 1 or the GII San Felipe S., Mar. 16], because California has a weird schedule [for three-year-olds]."

Snake Mountain continued his ascent towards a possible date with the divisional heavies with yet another facile victory in graded-stakes company. The impeccably bred five-year-old won seven of his 10 trips to the post last season and closed the year with three consecutive wins, taking a Belmont classified allowance by 2 1/2 lengths Oct. 4, the Nov. 5 GIII Stuyvesant H. (over subsequent GIII Hal's Hope H. winner Windsor Castle) and most recently the GIII Queens County H. Dec. 7. Sent off at odds-on as part of an entry with Voodoo (Petionville), Snake Mountain rode the rails early as his stablemate set the early pace, advanced strongly around the far turn and pulled clear as much the best. The winner will stay in New York for the time being, according to his trainer. "I'd rather not send him to Florida," said Jimmy Jerkens. "I'd rather see him stay here and follow the four seasons. He could run back in the Stymie H. [Aqueduct, Mar. 8]. Maybe we would think about going to Oaklawn," he added, referring to the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 5.

A stakes winner in France, **Glia** caught a muddy track in her U.S. bow Oct. 14, but won the Pebbles H. that day over GISW Nonsuch Bay. The bay went back to the turf next out and just missed in Churchill's GII Mrs. Revere S. Nov. 16 over a yielding course. Off since then, she posted a bullet six-furlongs in 1:12 2/5 Jan. 12 in preparation for her return. **Got Koko** surprised the GI La Brea S. field at 17-1 Dec. 28, but she had previously beaten **Bare Necessities** in the Torrey Pines S. at Del Mar Sept. 8. The latter went on to romp by eight lengths in the GIII Indiana Breeders' Cup Oaks and closed out her three-year-old campaign when second by a neck in the GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. Nov. 9.

BETTER TALK NOW (c, 4, Talkin Man--Bendita, by Baldski), sixth in the GIII Saranac H. over the Saratoga turf this past summer, rebounded to win back-to-back turf allowances at Delaware Oct. 1 and at Aqueduct Nov. 2. Sent to the Fair Grounds for one final crack at sophomores, the bay was favored at 6-5 in the Dec. 27 Woodchopper H., but was empty in the drive and finished eighth. The 5-2 second choice settled in a good spot behind a moderate early pace, rallied up three wide into the stretch, collared front-running Handsome George (Ide) and held on to best Good Boy Sam (Technology) by a neck. Lifetime Record: 11-4-2-0, \$120,085.

THEFULL CIRCLE (c, 4, Unbridled's Song--Highland Vixen {MSW, \$171,103}, by Highland Ruckus), a \$33,000 KEESEP yearling and a \$100,000 FTMJUL two-year-old, came flying to win the Princeton S. at the Meadowlands Oct. 4 and followed that up with a second in an allowance over a yielding Aqueduct turf course Nov. 2. The grey had a rough trip when seventh in Calder's Pete Axthelm H. Dec. 21, but was made the 9-5 favorite this time. Bobbling at the start, the bettors' choice was allowed to settle near the back of the pack before unleashing a strong late run to score by two lengths. Lifetime Record: SW, 15-4-3-4, \$162,260. PINCH HITTER (c, 4, Rubiano--Lady of Iron, by Polish Navy) won at first asking in May of his two-year-old season, but disappeared from the radar following a fourth in the Gill Tremont S. a month later and didn't race again until the following May. The bay colt struggled in allowance company at three, but showed improvement in his latest Jan. 4 at Gulfstream when he ran fourth, beaten just 1 3/4 lengths. Unhurried early, the 3-2 chalk angled outside at the top of the stretch and drove past Looking Around (Crafty Prospector) to win by 1 1/2 lengths. Pinch Hitter was a \$22,000 KEENOV weanling and a \$75,000 KEESEP yearling. Lifetime Record: 7-2-0-1, \$63,658. O-Gatsas Thoroughbreds. B-Gaye C C Stable Inc (KY). T-John P Terranova II.

4th-GPX, \$32,000, Msw, 3yo, 1 1/8m, 1:51 3/5, ft. MT. VAUGHAN (c, 3, Mt. Livermore--Nine Flags, by Forty Niner) was fifth in his only previous try at two turns in the Churchill slop Nov. 15 before cutting back to six furlongs to finish third in a Louisville maiden eight days later. The \$95,000 FTFEB two-year-old purchase finished second in his South Florida bow at Calder Dec. 21 and was the 5-1 third choice stretching back out in distance. The attractive chestnut colt outsprinted his eight rivals to the front, set the pace along the inside and charged clear in the stretch to best a rallying Shop Hill (Red Ransom) by 4 1/4 lengths. The 5-2 chalk in his second start, the gray pressed the pace while three wide, forged to the front at the sixteenth pole and edged away to win by a length over 3-1 Confidential Sport (Confide).
