## MICHAEL TABOR BUYS LION TAMER

Notable Thoroughbred owner Michael Tabor has purchased Peachtree Stable's three-year-old **Lion Tamer** (Will's Way) for an undisclosed amount. The chestnut broke his Sept. 28 maiden impressively at Belmont Park in 1:08 3/5 before destroying an allowance field by seven lengths at Gulfstream Park Jan. 4. "We think he's a lovely horse," Peachtree President John Fort told the *Blood-Horse*. "But I'm in the horse business, and Peachtree's

commitment to its partners is not only to win races but to make a profit, and this was an enormous profit. This was like winning a Grade I race for us." The \$180,000 Fasig-Tipton July yearling purchase will remain in the barn of trainer Todd Pletcher.

## CHINA VISIT TO INDIA

Group winner **China Visit** (Red Ransom--Furajet, by The Minstrel) has been retired from racing and will stand his first season at Usha Stud Farm near New Delhi, India, according to *European Bloodstock News*. A stud fee has not been announced. The five-year-old Godolphin flagbearer won the UAE Derby during his sophomore year before finishing sixth behind Fusaichi Pegasus in the G1 Kentucky Derby. Victorious in the G2 Prix du Rond-Point at Longchamp in 2001, the horse, bred by Gainsborough Farm concluded his season with a second-place finish in the G1 Prix de la Foret and a third in the G1-HK Hong Kong Mile. In his only start last term, China Visit ran a well-beaten seventh in the G2 Godolphin Mile at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23. China Visit retires with four wins from 14 starts and earnings of \$742,960.

Estimraar won four straight at Nad Al Sheba before being passed late by Curule (Go for Gin) in a Jan. 2 conditions event. Yesterday, the Dhs130,000 Dubai Horses in Training Sale purchase stalked the early leaders, took the lead with 300 meters to run and drew off to the wire. "We always thought early on in the season that he would make a Maktoum challenge horse," jockey Wayne Smith said of the winner. "Mazin [al Kurdi] has done a super job, he is a very good trainer. He pays a lot of attention to his horses and his results this season have shown what a good trainer he is." Estimraar will now likely aim for the Mar. 29 Godolphin Mile. Curule suffered the worst defeat of his career with his last-place finish. After the race, stewards immediately ordered a veterinary inspection of the horse.

**Added Edge Out With Knee Injury**

Canadian champion juvenile **Added Edge** (Smart Strike), last as the 9-5 chalk in Saturday's GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream, came out of the race with an injury to his left front knee and will be sidelined for the next four to six months, reports the *Thoroughbred Times*. The sophomore colt was undefeated in four starts leading into the Holy Bull, including the GIII Nashua S. at Aqueduct last fall. "He had been training better than ever, and there was no indication that he was going to come up short," said trainer Mark Casse. "He didn't seem too bad the first days coming out of the race, but then the third day, he was hurt. So, at least we know why he finished where he did." The colt has four wins from five career starts with earnings of \$250,328.

"He was kicking the back of the stall when the gates opened, so we got left [behind]," explained O'Neill. "Basically, it cost him a couple of lengths. We've added blinkers and he's been training really well since."

Trainer C. Beau Greely is pointing turf specialist **Sligo Bay** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) to the GI San Antonio H. Feb. 2 for a possible meeting with **Congaree** (Arazi) and **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again). The nine-furlong test will be the five-year-old's main track debut.

**DEEP FREEZE FOR RACING** Turfway Park in Florence, Kentucky; Penn National in Grantville, Pennsylvania; and West Virginia's Charles Town cancelled yesterday's live racing cards due to sub-freezing temperatures. Racing is expected to resume at all three tracks today. Also plagued by frigid temperatures, Oaklawn Park in Hot Springs, Arkansas, scheduled to kick off its 2003 meeting today, has cancelled this weekend's live racing program. "Our track crew did everything they could to hold the track," said General Manager Eric Jackson. "But, with the wind chill down below 0 degrees, the track pushed our equipment out of the ground at around 3:30 a.m. We worked various types of harrows on the ground until 5:30 a.m., but all we were getting were clods that contained a lot of water, which meant that they were going to freeze up under the circumstances." Live racing will begin at Oaklawn Jan. 31, with the Dixie Belle S. scheduled for opening day and the Mountain Valley S. for Feb. 2.

**Tampa Bay Downs Raises Purses:**

Tampa Bay Downs will raise overnight purses by six percent, effective Jan. 30. The increase comes in the wake of a 22-percent gain in simulcast wagering on Tampa Bay's outgoing signal. "The increase reflects the overall popularity of our signal," the track's General Manager Peter Berube said yesterday. "Fans across the country enjoy our large fields, turf racing and the overall quality of our racing product." Handle on Tampa's outgoing signal is averaging \$2.2 million per day to date versus \$1.8 million per day over the same period last year. The increase will boost overnight purses by \$5,000 a day to \$100,500, up from the previous \$95,000 per day.
