### SETTING HER SIGHTS ON A GRADE I

Unbeaten in four starts on dirt, **Sightseek** (Distant View) will be tough to deny in the year's first Grade I event, the Santa Monica H. this afternoon at Santa Anita. The Juddmonte homebred has displayed a sharp closing kick in her last two starts, rallying to take the GII Top Flight H. Nov. 29 and the GIII Raven Run S. Oct. 9. Forced to miss the GI La Brea S. with a fever, the chestnut has since worked a bullet, going three-quarters in 1:12 2/5. But it will certainly be no walkover for her: among her rivals is the versatile **Affluent** (Affirmed), who spent most of 2002 chasing Azeri before notching a victory over Golden Apples (Ire) in the GI Ramona H. She hasn't run since finishing a close fifth in the GI Matriarch S. Dec. 1. The five-year-old does have a victory over course and distance to her credit, landing the GI La Brea S. at the end of her three-year-old season. But both Affluent and Sightseek will need to catch **Reine des Neiges** (Smart Strike), who earned a Beyer Speed Figure of 100 in romping by seven lengths in a 6 1/2-furlong maiden last May at Hollywood. Sidelined following a third in a two-turn allowance in June, she has been training strongly for her return to action.

### SUNSHINE STATE

The flagship event of the inaugural Sunshine Millions will be the \$1 million Ocala Breeders Sales Classic, which will be broadcast live from Gulfstream Park on NBC Saturday afternoon. A full field of 12 has been entered for the nine-furlong race, including multiple graded-stakes winner **The Judge Sez Who** (Judge T C). The well-traveled Florida-bred defeated his elders, including **Best of the Rest** (Skip Trial), in the GIII Fred W. Hooper H. at Gulfstream Dec. 28 and could be coming into his own this season. **Continental Red** (Flying Continental) tops the California runners in this race. The chestnut captured the GII San Luis Rey H. going 12 panels on the turf last spring and finished up the year with a victory in the Great State Challenge Classic at Sam Houston Dec. 7. He defeated the promising Pass Rush that day and should get a great trip from the rail. The sun may be setting on **Sir Bear** (Sir Leon)'s career, but the dark bay may still have a trick or two up his sleeve at age 10: he is a Grade I winner over this surface and has bankrolled over \$2.5 million.

**BAFFERT REPLACING SMITH WITH BAILEY**

Jockey Jerry Bailey will replace Mike Smith aboard probable champion **Vindication** (Seattle Slew) as well as **Composure** (Touch Gold), according to *The Blood-Horse*. Smith was aboard for each start of Vindication's undefeated two-year-old campaign, which culminated in a 2 3/4-length victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile in October. He also piloted Composure when she won the GI Oak Leaf S. as well as her runner-up efforts in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and the GI Hollywood Starlet S. "Vindication was supposed to be Jerry's mount last year, but he wasn't able to come ride him." Baffert told *The Blood-Horse*. "I've won a lot of big races with Jerry. This is a pressure situation, and Jerry has come through in big pressure situations before. I spoke to Mike about it before he heard it from someone else. I told him I feel bad, but it's strictly a business decision. Mike is a class act and he understood the situation, knowing he could eventually get back on the horse if Jerry doesn't like him. This is strictly my decision. I'm going by my experience and my instincts. I've got a lot of jinxes to break with this horse, and I just decided to give Jerry another opportunity to ride him." Bailey will be at Santa Anita today to ride Sightseek for Bobby Frankel in the GI Santa Monica H.

**HOLLYWOOD UNVEILS STAKES SCHEDULE**

Highlighted by a pair of \$750,000 races, a \$9.35-million stakes schedule has been announced for the 2003 Spring/Summer Meet (Apr. 23-July 20) at Hollywood Park. The \$750,000 GI Hollywood Gold Cup, which will be held July 13, will no longer have an early bird nomination. Last summer, Hollywood introduced the American Oaks and this year has boosted the purse to \$750,000 for the July 5 10-furlong race featuring three-year-old fillies. Another big purse increase was announced for the Jim Murray H., which will be \$400,000 this year as compared to the previous running at the \$75,000 level. "Along with the Triple Crown races, this gives nine of the 13 weekends at the Spring/Summer Meet a major event," racing secretary Martin Panza said. "We were very happy with the way the inaugural American Oaks was received and we will continue to build on that foundation. We believe the three-stake programs work and we hope to establish another big day anchored by the Jim Murray Memorial Handicap." **WAR EMBLEM LAWSUIT SETTLED** Russell Reineman and The Thoroughbred Corporation have reached an out-of-court settlement regarding a \$1-million bonus earned by the colt for combining a victory in the GI Illinois Derby with a win in a Triple Crown race. According to *Thoroughbred Times*, the settlement will give The Thoroughbred Corp. \$685,000, while Reineman will receive \$315,000. Reineman, a Chicago industrialist, was the colt's sole owner when he won the Illinois Derby and sold a 90 percent interest in War Emblem to The Thoroughbred Corp. shortly thereafter. "I'm satisfied with the settlement," Reineman told *Thoroughbred Times*. "With it going to court, you get into court costs and attorney's fees, so it was best to just come to an agreement and get it over with."

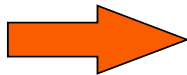
