AFFLUENT SUCCESS IN THE SANTA MONICA

She's got a ways to go to equal the 12 Grade/Group 1 victories of her granddam, but the versatile **Affluent** (Affirmed) is a third of the way there following yesterday's last-to-first upset of **Sightseek** (Distant View) in the GI Santa Monica H. at Santa Anita. The winner of the 2001 GI La Brea S. over course and distance, the Whitham homebred spent most of 2002 dealing with Azeri, finishing second to the Eclipse distaffer in a trio of Grade I events before earning a richly deserved one of her own, defeating Eclipse candidate Golden Apples (Ire) in the GI Ramona H. over the Del Mar turf July 27. The chestnut went off form at the end of the year, with fifth-place finishes in the GII WinStar Galaxy S. and the GI Matriarch S., but was back at perhaps her best game for her five-year-old bow. Allowed to settle towards the back of the pack beneath new rider Alex Solis, Affluent advanced smartly while racing off the rail on the far turn. She found room between horses in upper stretch, took a clear lead nearing the eighth pole and held off a resurgent Sightseek for the win. "She likes to take her time, that's her style," Solis commented. "She really is a super classy mare. I am so glad I am on her." The winner goes next in the GI Santa Maria H. Feb. 16.

A multiple graded-stakes winner at two, Smok'n Frolic had a less consistent sophomore season, that is, until the very end of the year. Seventh as the even-money favorite in the GII Davona Dale S. in February, the Dogwood Stable representative finished seventh in a Belmont turf sprint allowance July 12 and fourth in the grassy GIII Lake George S. at Saratoga July 29. Sixth in the Aug. 17 GI Alabama S. at the Spa, the grey was given additional time off, but made amends in her final start of the campaign, coming from just off the pace to win the GII Cotillion H. against fellow three-year-olds at Philly Park Oct. 5. Favored in just her second attempt against her elders, Smok'n Frolic raced in midpack early on as Cee's Elegance set an honest pace. Asked to pick it up along the inside approaching the quarter pole, she was angled out for the stretch drive, collared the front-runner leaving the furlong grounds and moved clear. "She's a grind-it-out type, but when I rode her the first time, she was a speed filly," said jockey Jerry Bailey, who broke her maiden and won the Flash S. aboard the filly. Adminniestrator came flying late to become the lone Cal-bred to win on Sunshine Millions Day. The grey had defeated state-breds in the Quicken Tree H. over a mile and a half last April, but had to wait seven more starts to make another trip to the winner's circle, when he captured an \$80,000 optional claimer going a mile over the Hollywood lawn Dec. 19. Adminniestrator was content to race near the back of the pack as Mayakovsky (Matty G) showed the way and was still ninth at the stretch call. Switched outside for running room by David Flores, the California-bred launched a strong run down the middle of the course and just caught Florida-bred Music's Storm near the wire. "Looking at the replay, the finish was closer than I thought," said Flores. "I was last early, but I knew if he ran the last eighth of a mile like he can, we'd get there." Winning trainer Paddy Gallagher had claimed Adminniestrator for \$50,000 in June of 2001. "He doesn't owe us anything now," said the conditioner. Stay Forever streaked through four consecutive victories last season, starting the skein with a Calder allowance score in July and ending it with a half-length tally in the Solo Haina S. on the Calder grass Nov. 2. The chestnut mare had not been out since running third against colts after a troubled trip in the Bonnie Heath Turf H. Nov. 16. "She came up with a foot abscess after the race and I wasn't sure I was going to have her ready for this race," trainer Marty Wolfson admitted. "The second choice to return to her winning ways, the Santa Cruz homebred was at the back of the pack after a bumpy beginning and was carried three wide around the far turn, but finished full of run to catch favored Cellars Shiraz late and draw clear. "I've ridden a lot of nice horses over the years, but today she proved she was the best Florida-bred grass filly or mare there is right now," jockey Jose Santos said. Captain Squire had raced at Santa Anita just once before, beating \$62,500 claimers by eight lengths just over a year ago. The bay went on the road after that start, winning the Feb. 2 Turf Paradise Derby in his next outing. Off the board in the Mar. 9 GIII El Camino Real Derby at Golden Gate, he improved to be third in the Apr. 13 California Derby at Bay Meadows. The Florida-bred followed a second in a turf allowance at Hollywood Park May 8 with an upset victory in the GII Lazaro S. Barrera S. on the Hollywood main track May 27, then headed east. In his last two starts of the season, he was second in the July 13 Carry Back S. at Calder and third in the Aug. 10 GIII West Virginia Derby at Mountaineer Park. "We decided it was probably a good idea to back off on him...so he was turned out for about 45 days," trainer Jeff Mullins said. "But he's done everything right since, so we decided this was a good spot to bring him back." Returning after the 5 1/2-month absence, Captain Squire chased hot fractions of :21.28 and :43.52, grabbed the lead from F J's Pace on the turn and pulled away late for a handy score. "To be honest with you, I had no idea they were going that fast," jockey Alex Solis said. "He's just the kind of horse that makes makes everything look easy. I don't think a horse could run any better than he did." The winner has been nominated to several stakes at Nad al Sheba on Dubai World Cup Day March 29. "Hopefully we'll get invited there," said Mullins.

Sent off at odds of 5-1 in the Sept. 15 GI Futurity S. over a mile, the dark bay was a forward factor for the opening half mile before commencing a steady retreat which landed him a distant fourth at the wire. Unraced since that effort, the Florida-bred was the second choice to Cal-bred Excessivepleasure. *(Cont. next column)*

The favorite showed his customary early speed, but jockey Pat Valenzuela chose to race in the two path and jockey Edgar Prado aboard Valid Video seized upon that opportunity and went up along the inside to challenge the front-runner at the three-eighths pole. The tandem were virtually inseparable the rest of the way, with Valid Video getting the better of his rival in the final strides. "I was a little worried about the seven furlongs because that's a tough distance to win coming off a layoff," commented winning trainer Dennis Manning. "He's bred to be a sprinter, but I think he'll get two turns eventually. Now is not the time to try it though. She tried the turf for the first time in the GIII Miesque S. Nov. 29 and won that one-mile test, then handled the switch back to the main track and captured the GIII Santa Ysabel S. Jan. 5. Graded-stakes winner Humorous Lady jumped out to set a hot pace, with Florida invader Ivanvinalot chasing after her as Atlantic Ocean settled well back in eighth. Jockey David Flores took his filly to the outside approaching the turn and had her in a challenging position at the top of the stretch. Ivanvinalot fought back on the inside, but Atlantic Ocean was under a full head of steam and forged ahead under a hand ride. "We tried a lot of different things with her (early) looking for what was best for her," explained winning trainer Bob Baffert. "When she was young she was so big and awkward--like a big puppy and hadn't fully grown into herself--so it was harder to find what kind of races were best for her. But she's really come around and turned into a special filly. She's such a big-striding filly and longer distances are probably best for her, but this was a good spot so we tried it. 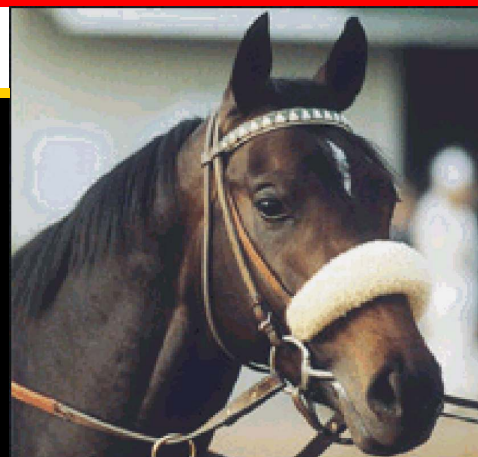
