**AVANZADO FROM START TO FINISH**

**Avanzado (Arg)** (Luhuk), multiple Group 1 placed in his native Argentina, started his North American campaign out with three straight victories, including a 3/4-length victory in the GII Forest Hills H. at Belmont last October, but the honeymoon ended with a seventh-place effort over a sloppy track in the GI DeFrancis Memorial Dash in November and a sixth-place effort in the Jan. 1 El Conejo H. The six-year-old got back on track yesterday with a confident wire-to-wire victory in the GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita. "He was screwing around his last couple of races and [trainer Doug O'Neill] and I discussed trying blinkers," explained winning rider Tyler Baze. "The way he broke today, obviously the blinkers worked. He broke on top and never stopped." Champion **Kona Gold** (Java Gold) made a run at the leader in upper stretch, but flattened out and finished last in the six-horse field. **Toccet Improving**

**Toccet** (Awesome Again) is showing marked improvement from the injury which threatened to knock him off the Kentucky Derby trail, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The multiple Grade I winner had been sidelined by what veterinarians termed remodeling of the ankles. "The horse is perfect right now and [trainer] John [Scanlan] is optimistic," owner Dan Borislow told *Blood-Horse*. "We'll put a rider on his back in the second week of February, then give him a week with the rider on and see how he's doing. If everything looks fine, we'll resume training and shoot for the Private Terms S. at Laurel on Mar. 29. If he comes out of the race in good shape, we'll send him to New York for the [Apr. 12 GI] Wood Memorial, then the Kentucky Derby."

**MAYAKOVSKY INJURED IN SUNSHINE TURF**  
Graded stakes winner **Mayakovsky** (Matty G) will miss two to three weeks of training after suffering several deep cuts to the hock and tendon area on his right hind leg while running 11th in Saturday's Barretts/CTBA Sunshine Millions Turf S. at Santa Anita. "If [the injury] was another half an inch left or right, it would have cut his tendon," said trainer Patrick Biancone. "He's lucky to be alive. He's quite a well-blooded horse and he should recover well, but we need to be careful about infection, things like that."

**January 26, 1950...**Citation's 16-race win streak came to an end in the La Sorpresa Handicap at Santa Anita. Despite giving 16 pounds to the winner, Mische, Citation, carrying 130 pounds, lost only by a neck.

**January 27, 1973...**Penny Chenery accepted the Eclipse Award for Horse of the Year on behalf of Secretariat, who was also voted champion two-year-old of 1972.

**January 28, 1928...**Kentucky Derby winner Black Gold broke down during the running of the Salome Purse at Fair Grounds and was buried in the track's infield.

**January 29, 1960...**Future Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Carry Back finished 10<sup>th</sup> in his first start ever, a three-furlong race for two-year-old maiden runners at Hialeah. Sired by Saggy, the only horse to defeat Citation during his three-year-old season, out of an undistinguished mare named Joppy, Carry Back became a popular runner and was dubbed, "the people's horse."

Cyber Secret broke her maiden by 1 3/4-lengths second time out at Belmont Sept. 6 before being eased in her next try in the slop in the Gil Astarita S. at Belmont Oct. 13. A three-length winner in her most recent, a \$47,000 six-furlong allowance test over this track Nov. 9, the bay was backed down to 8-5 favoritism to take her route debut. Quick off the blocks, the filly held a slight advantage through three quarters, drew away when asked at the top of the stretch and held on in game fashion for the victory. "Being on the inside, you have to take advantage of your position," commented winning rider Jean-Luc Samyn. "Mr. [Tony] Dutrow told me that if she broke well and showed her speed, to take advantage of it." Winning owner Sanford Goldfarb added, "She might have gotten a little tired; she wasn't exactly exploding through the lane. I think her best distance will be seven furlongs or a mile.
