GOLDEN STRUB

He's back. Making his first start since October, **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) turned yesterday's GII Strub S. into a procession as he dominated his rivals by seven lengths. After a game win in the GI Travers S. in August, the dark bay didn't run again until the Breeders' Cup, finishing second to Volponi in the GI Classic Oct. 26 at Arlington Park. The Edmund Gann runner had been training brilliantly for his return to action and was sent off as the heavy favorite. Breaking from the outside, he had the rail and the lead heading into the first turn and was feeling fresh through three-quarters in 1:09.98. Jockey Jerry Bailey shook him up turning for home and the big colt responded, widening his advantage with every stride. "I thought he had improved, but you never know until you run them," said winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "It looks like he's on the right track now. I'm leaning towards the Dubai Cup [G1, Mar. 29], but who knows what's going to go on with the war [in the Middle East], so if that doesn't work out, maybe the Santa Anita H. [GI, Mar. 1]. The Dubai race would be our first option, because it's \$6 million, he's a very sound horse and he doesn't need any medication or anything." **Olmodavor** (A.P. Indy) got up to nip **Tracemark** (Conquistador Cielo) for second.

PERFECT TIME TO RETURN?

Congaree (Arazi) may be the headlining act of today's GII San Antonio H.--he has, after all, dominated the opposition in his last two starts--but the race also features the return of **Pleasantly Perfect** (Pleasant Colony).

The Diamond A colorbearer went through his conditions smoothly last summer before making his stakes debut in the GI Pacific Classic, where he finished fourth, beaten just 2 3/4 lengths. He followed that up with an impressive victory in the GII Goodwood BC H. Oct. 6, covering the mile and an eighth in 1:46 4/5. But there was to be no trip to the Breeders' Cup, since Illinois regulations about bleeders differ from those in California.

After a brief vacation, the five-year-old has been training strongly in recent weeks. "I think he's in fantastic shape," said trainer Richard Mandella. "I'm looking for a big race. He's grown up and he's a professional now and he can do whatever you ask him." Also in the San Antonio field is **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again), last year's Big 'Cap winner who closed out 2002 with a third in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The one-two finishers from the GIII Native Diver H., **Piensa Sonando (Chi)** (Gallantsky) and **Fleetstreet Dancer** (Smart Strike), along with **Cottage (Arg)** (Ibero {Arg}), complete the field.

Kafwain outclassed his rivals in this seven-furlong test, circling the field on the turn en route to an easy victory while covering the distance in 1:21. After winning the GIII Best Pal S. last August, the dark bay was second in the GII Del Mar Futurity, but rebounded to take the GII Norfolk S. Oct. 5, only to find stablemate Vindication too good for him in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 26. Kafwain made a similar move in the GI Hollywood Futurity, where he lost by a head to Toccet, but was disqualified to fourth after hampering a rival on the turn. The favorite let Sum Trick and Southern Image mix it up on the front end before coming after them on the turn. He hit the top of the stretch full of run and strode home impressively. "He reminds me of Silver Charm, training him," said winning trainer Bob Baffert. "He's a big, heavy horse and a beautiful moving horse. I think he's matured a lot." Baffert indicated that Kafwain may not run again until March.

Gal O Gal came through willingly along the rail to earn her first stakes victory, running her winning streak to four in a row. Fourth to 2-1 favorite Sweettrickydancer (Green Dancer) in a Calder allowance Nov. 16, she dropped in for a \$40,000 tag and won Dec. 6, then defeated Calder allowance foes Dec. 30. She made her first appearance at Gulfstream Jan. 22 against \$80,000 claimers and duly won by 3 1/2 lengths, an effort which made her the third choice in this field. Breaking from the hedge, the Florida-bred caboose the field through the opening six furlongs and began to advance on the inside. As they straightened away, Gal O Gal skimmed the hedge, collared Formal Miss inside the final furlong and reached out tenaciously for the wire.

"The rail was the only place there was room to get through," said winning rider Chris DeCarlo. "I knew I had enough horse, as long as I could get her head up in there. She's kind of a tiny filly, so it was easy to do." Winning trainer Vinnie Blengs said that Gal O Gal was "due for a rest." Sweettrickydancer's four-race winning streak was snapped. She looked to be in striking position on the turn, but faded to be eighth and last.

Off the board just once in five previous turf tries, Lindsay Jean made the most of her first graded-stakes attempt, easily accounting for the Brown Bess. Second by a head in the grassy Lady Morvich H. at the Bay Meadows fair meeting Aug. 17, the bay finished fifth in the Hillsborough H. over the Bay Meadows turf course Sept. 28 before returning to the main track to finish second in the Golden Poppy H. in San Mateo Oct. 27. The Florida-bred mare was last seen when runner-up to the talented Lacie Girl in the Star Ball H. over the Golden Gate main track Nov. 30 and was the fourth choice in her return to her preferred surface. Content to race in second behind a moderate early tempo, the Moss colorbearer challenged front-running Neon Queen (Petersburg) two wide at the 3/8-pole, kicked clear into the stretch and held sway. "She's probably the most honest horse I've ever ridden," commented winning rider Chad Schvaneveldt. "She gives you her best every time. She relaxed nicely and I didn't really ask her to run until the eighth pole."

Tiger May Sidestep Run for the Roses

G1 Grand Criterium winner and G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile third-place getter **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat) may, according to Britain's *Racing Post*, forego an attempt at this year's GI Kentucky Derby and instead have his early season campaign targeted at the G1 Epsom Derby in June. "After the Breeders' Cup Juvenile we were very hopeful Hold that Tiger would be a Kentucky Derby horse but, having thought about it, I think probably his goal will be Epsom," owner Michael Tabor commented. "We are leaning that way. Obviously you have to keep an open mind, but I would advise ante-post punters to hold fire on backing Hold That Tiger for Kentucky." Tabor, who campaigned 1995 Kentucky Derby winner Thunder Gulch, also spoke about the recent purchase of Churchill Downs possible **Lion Tamer** (Will's Way). The sophomore is set to remain with current trainer Todd Pletcher. "I spoke to Todd about the horse and he likes him very much," Tabor added. "Up to a mile he's very talented, and the question is whether [or not] he will stay the Kentucky Derby trip."

Domestic Dispute Works

Trainer Bob Baffert's **Domestic Dispute** (Unbridled's Song) put himself squarely into the Derby picture with a sharp three-length score in the GII Santa Catalina S. Jan. 18. Stretching his legs under exercise rider Dana Barnes yesterday, the chestnut worked a half mile in 47.80.

Most Feared Sidelined

Most Feared (Commanchero), who finished 10th of 11 as the favorite in last weekend's GIII Lecomte S. at the Fair Grounds, will be sidelined for about 60 days after a stress fracture of his left front leg was discovered. "It's a bad thing because it means he's going to be on hold for a while," trainer Ronny Werner told *Daily Racing Form*. "But it could have been a lot worse." The winner of the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity last September, the Tom Durant homebred was sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and was making his first start since a third-place finish in the GIII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 30.
