RECORD 446 NOMINATED TO TRIPLE CROWN

Led by undefeated two-year-old champion **Vindication** (Seattle Slew), a record total of 446 three-year-olds have been nominated to the Visa Triple Crown and the \$5-million Triple Crown Challenge. Godolphin has nominated 19 of its sophomore team, including group winner **Dublin (Ire)** (Carson City) and graded-stakes placed **Anasheed** (A.P. Indy). Todd Pletcher led all trainers with 28 nominated from his barn, including undefeated **Indy Dancer** (A.P. Indy). Five fillies were among the nominees, but, as expected, champion **Storm Flag Flying** (Storm Cat) was not on the list. Distaffers **Composure** (Touch Gold) and **Santa Catarina** (Unbridled) were both nominated by conditioner Bob Baffert, who has 17 three-year-olds on the list. In addition to Vindication and the aforementioned fillies, his draft includes graded-stakes winner **Domestic Dispute** (Unbridled's Song) and **Kafwain** (Cherokee Run). Lane's End stallion **A.P. Indy** leads all sires of nominees with 16; he is followed closely by Overbrook's **Storm Cat** with 15. Among the leaders of young stallions who are represented by their first three-year-olds; Touch Gold (10), **Gentlemen (Arg)** (8), Tale of the Cat (8) and **Elusive Quality** (7). Early nominations at \$600 closed Jan. 18; the deadline for late nominations (\$6,000) is Mar. 29. For a complete list of [nominees](#), go to www.kentuckyderby.com.

SPRINTERS SQUARE OFF IN HONG KONG

Hong Kong's top sprinters will face off in today's G1 Bauhinia Sprint Trophy at Sha Tin, including last season's Champion Sprinter **Charming City (Aus)** (Chief's Crown). The winner of this race last year, Charming City was a disappointing fifth over 1000 meters at Sha Tin Dec. 15, but trainer David Hayes is undeterred. "He has always run his best races when put up close to the lead or right on the pace," said Hayes. "We didn't let him do that last time and he seemed to lose interest, that is something we won't be doing again." *(Preview cont. p2)*

CONGAREE CRUISES IN SAN ANTONIO

Sent off the piping 1-5 choice in yesterday's GII San Antonio H. at Santa Anita to win his third straight start, **Congaree** (Arazi) did not disappoint his supporters as he bagged a 2 1/4-length victory over GI Big 'Cap hero **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again) and GII Goodwood H. victor **Pleasantly Perfect** (Pleasant Colony). Traditionally a frontrunner, the five-year-old pushed his game to a new level after adopting a new tracking style for his two most recent starts; a 5 1/2-length score in the GI Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct Nov. 30 and a six-length romp in the GII San Pasqual H. Jan. 4. Content to flank early leader **Fleetstreetdancer** (Smart Strike) by a half-length through six furlongs, the winner of last summer's GI Swaps S. took command heading into the final furlong and drew clear to win comfortably. According to trainer Bob Baffert, the chestnut will make his next start in either the G1 Dubai World Cup (Nad al Sheba Mar. 29) or the GI Santa Anita H. (Mar. 1). Among Charming City's chief rivals is trainer Ivan Allan's Firebolt (Ire), who covered a half mile in 44.9 yesterday in his final gallop before the race. Also a threat, probable race favorite All Thrills Too (Aus), who won the G1 Hong Kong International Sprint Dec. 15, appears poised to make it four in a row. According to rider Gerald Mosse, who was aboard for the colt's final preparatory move Thursday, "All seems well with him and we are looking for another good run from him."

House Party took advantage of a hot pace to come running late and earned her first stakes success. After breaking her maiden Nov. 8, the grey filly surprised a few people when she ran second at 20-1 to the highly regarded Randaroo in the GIII Valley Stream S. Nov. 24 at Aqueduct. She hit the gate next out in the Dame Mysterieuse S. Jan. 5 at Gulfstream and couldn't get closer than third. Allowed to trail the short field through fractions of :21.47 and :44.64, House Party uncorked a sustained run on the turn and had to work hard to get by a game Chimichurri. "I was surprised she was so far back early because she's got a lot of speed, especially in the morning," said winning trainer Allen Jerkens. "But maybe it was best with the fractions being so fast. If she stays sound, then the Forward Gal [GIII, 7f, Mar. 14] would be a good spot. I really like winning this race for the owners because they also bred her."

Returning to the scene of his impressive GI Florida Derby victory, Harlan's Holiday made a winning four-year-old debut in defeating a salty allowance field. Last year, the colt added the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. to his tally before two unplaced efforts in the classics. Following a fourth in the GI Preakness S., the Ohio-bred was transferred from Ken McPeck's barn to Todd Pletcher, for whom he won the GIII Pennsylvania Derby and was third in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. He was then ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 26 and ended 2002 with a fourth-place finish in the GI Cigar Mile Nov. 30. The odds-on choice to return a winner, Harlan's Holiday was content to track the leaders from fourth, moved up to tackle Mr. John at the top of the stretch and pulled away in the final sixteenth.

Ha Pa Da Tops Midlantic Sales:

The winning mare Ha Pa Da (Wekiva Springs) attracted an offer of \$35,000 from Barbara J. Belotti to top Sunday's Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Winter Mixed Sale in Timonium, Maryland. In foal to Allen's Prospect, the five-year-old grey is out of stakes winner Toots La Mae (Danzig Connection), a half-sister to Fortunate Prospect. The second highest price at the sale was \$27,000 for hip 87, a yearling colt by El Prado (Ire) out of the stakes-winning mare Queen Suite (Bates Motel). Consigned by Bill Reightler as agent, the grey colt was purchased by Los Vaqueros. Figures were down significantly from last year, with 107 head grossing \$474,000, compared to 2002, when 123 horses sold for \$900,700. The average declined from \$7,323 to \$4,434, while the median dipped from \$4,200 to \$3,000.
