CAN "LUV" CONQUER ALL?

Riding a three-race winning streak into the event, **Elloluv** (Gilded Time) will be the one to beat in the GI Las Virgenes at Santa Anita this afternoon, and there is

no reason to doubt her dominance will continue. The bay filly has already beaten three of her five rivals, getting the better of GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies runner-up **Composure** (Touch Gold) in the Dec. 14 GI Hollywood Starlet S. and beating **Watching You** (Coronado's Quest) and **Puxa**

Saco (Dehere) in the Jan. 20 GII Santa Ynez S. Trainer Craig Dollase is confident in his charge. "She's doing really well," he said. "She's proved that she fits nicely in this category. I'm looking forward to the showdown between her and Composure." Composure makes her first start since the Starlet, but she has been first or second in five of her six career starts, including a win in the GII Oak Leaf S. last fall, and she is the lone Triple Crown nominee in the field. **Favola** (GB) (Royal Applause {GB}) makes her U.S. and dirt debut in the Las Virgenes. She won two of her seven starts while under the care of trainer Luca Cumani in Britain. Last time out, she was seventh in a Newmarket handicap Oct. 3. "We bought her in October at Tattersalls," trainer Vladimir Cerin said. "I liked everything about her. She's been working well. I wanted to run her on the grass, but there really isn't a good spot and she's ready to run, so we're going to try her."

SHE'S GOT IT

Got Koko (Signal Tap) yesterday became only the third filly in it's 29-year history to sweep the La Canada series with her rallying win in the GII La Canada S. at Santa Anita. Taisez Vous was the first to complete the triple in 1978; Mitterand followed in 1985. But the crowd was not convinced Got Koko could get it done. The bay, who was 17-1 when she took the GI La Brea S. and 3-1 for her victory in the GII El Encino S., was no better than 2-1 second choice behind 9-10 **Sightseek** (Distant View) in the La Canada. She didn't let the lack of support get her down, however. Allowed to settle off the pace as Sightseek and **Bella Bellucci** (French Deputy) went at it on the front end, she closed relentlessly down the lane, getting her head in front in the waning yards before posting the 3/4-length score over the favorite. "She's amazing, incredible," jockey Alex Solis said. "I always thought she'd get there with that long stride she has. She knows where the wire is." Added trainer Bruce Headley, "It's quite a moment. This is not quite the Breeders' Cup, but it's pretty close. To set history at Santa Anita is really something special for my wife [Aase] and my family and my partners. We're all extremely happy." Game three-year-old Yell opened sire Anabaa's Group 1 Southern Hemisphere account by defeating a crack field here. Trainer John Hawkes did his best to play down the prospects of the homebred after he won the G3 C.S. Hayes S., then the G2 Carlyon S. at his last start on Jan. 23, but the gelding defied his low-key assertions to win his third straight with authority. Innovation Girl, sent out 2-1 favorite off a win in the G3 Debonair S., set the pace with Yell chasing and the rest of the field four lengths behind. Yell collared Innovation Girl in the home straight, then fought off a challenge from Caulfield Cup runner-up Fields Of Omagh. "When it got down to a fight, he really dug deep," said jockey Darren Gauci. Melbourne stable foreman Wayne Hawkes said his father was likely to continue along a weight-for-age path, targetting the Mar. 1 G1 Futurity. "He had a testing autumn last season...so we gave him a light spring and aimed him at the autumn and it looks as though it's paying off," he said. **Northerly (Aus)** (Serheed), having his first start since winning the G1 Cox Plate last October, finished fourth, just 1 1/2 lengths from the winner, and is scheduled to contest the St George S. in a fortnight and the A\$1.25 million Australian Cup Mar. 10.

The ultra-consistent San Dare had been on the board in nine of her last 10 starts. The bay ended 2002 with a solid second-place finish at 23-1 in the Nov. 23 GIII Cardinal H. at Churchill Downs and came back to win the Jan. 5 GIII Honey Fox H. at Gulfstream as an 11-1 outsider. Stretching out off that 1 1/16-mile test, she was rated in 10th as longshot **Chez Cherie (Wolfhound)** set the early pace. The five-year-old swung five-wide around the final bend, swept past Tweedside at the sixteenth pole and opened it up late to win handily. "She's just getting better with every race and I don't know why," trainer Rick Hiles said. "I took over her training about a year ago and really didn't do that much with her. She did put on some weight and she blossomed for me. If everything goes all right, her next race will be the **Orchid H.** [GII, Mar. 23 at Gulfstream]." The 5-2 choice, **Uriah (Acatenango {Ger})** was caught in traffic on the turn, then closed some ground late to be fifth. **Click [here](#) for the [brisnet.com](#) chart.**

With new jockey Jerry Bailey in the saddle, Allamerican Bertie grabbed the lead soon after the start and cut out all the fractions before cruising home a handy winner. The bay had won two in a row under Pat Day, taking an optional claimer on the turf at Churchill Downs Nov. 7 and the GII Falls City H. on the Churchill main track Nov. 28, but faltered badly in her latest and finished 10th in the GIII Honey Fox H. on the grass at Gulfstream Jan. 5. Returning to the dirt in her second start of the campaign, the Klein homebred was bet down to even-money and rewarded her backers with the front-running triumph. "I thought she'd win, but I'm impressed she did it so comfortably," trainer Steve Flint said. "I talked to Jerry and he said that once she made the lead, she really relaxed and went on about her business." Added Bailey, "She was a little aggressive until she cleared [Small Promises] and made the lead, then she relaxed fine. I never hit her--I just shook the stick at her." The winner goes next in the GII Rampart H. at Gulfstream Park Mar. 1, a race that will have special significance for owners Bertram and Elaine Klein. "I especially want to win it for the owners...because Mar. 1 is their 50th anniversary and they're going to have about 150 people here for it," said Flint. Gygistar makes his first start since capping a five-race winning streak with a three-length victory in the Aug. 24 GI King's Bishop S. The chestnut gelding also included the GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup S. and the GII Dwyer S. in his skein. Six-for-seven lifetime, the four-year-old is a perfect two-for-two at Gulfstream Park. "I put him back in training in December," trainer Mark Hennig said. "He's been training excellently ever since." Hennig had hoped to have Edward Evans homebred back at the end of last season, but an injury in the stall resulted in more time on the shelf. "I was getting ready to run him in the Breeders' Cup Sprint," Hennig said. "A couple of days before the race, he ripped his [right front] hoof apart in his stall. We had to wait and let nature take its course after that."

MILLIONAIRE MYSTIC LADY FIFTH IN FINALE

Mystic Lady (Thunder Gulch--Diane Suzanne, by Compliance), off at 12-1 in yesterday's GIII Sabin H. at Gulfstream Park, was making her final career start in the race and ran evenly to be fifth. The five-year-old, who beat the boys in the 2001 GIII Jersey Derby at Monmouth Park, also captured the GII Cotillion H., GII Fantasy S., GIII Herecomesthebride S., GIII Honey Bee H. and three non-graded stakes. She was also graded-stakes placed eight times, earning black type at no less than 15 different tracks. She retires with 10 wins, eight seconds and a third from her 27 career starts for earnings of \$1,170,390. "She's been a nice filly," trainer Mark Hennig said. "She doesn't have to carry her track with her, as her record attests. She's won on both dirt and turf."

There will be a Stallion Access Sale, offering 2003 no-guarantee nominations to stallions such as Clever Trick, Danzig, Dynaformer, Kingmambo, Miswaki, Seeking The Gold, Tiznow and Unbridled's Song and shares in Abaginone, Deerhound, Distorted Humor and Fit To Fight, immediately following Monday's session.

**GULFSTREAM AMENDS 2004 DATES** Gulfstream Park has submitted an amended dates request for 2004, one which will not conflict with the Calder Race Course meeting. Originally, Gulfstream has applied to run from Dec. 26, 2003 through Apr. 25, 2004. Those dates would have put them in direct competition with Calder for eight days, as Calder's meet concludes Jan. 2, 2004. Gulfstream's new application mirrors the dates the track will run this year, requesting a 2004 season from Jan. 3 through Apr. 25. "We said all along that the dates we were applying for were a work in progress," said Gulfstream President Scott Savin. "We have until March 15 to change them again." Closing day this year at Gulfstream is Apr. 25, which also happens to be opening day at Calder, but, to avoid a conflict, Savin said his track would offer simulcasting only, while Calder President Ken Dunn said his track would run a live card.
