**UNFLAPPABLE COMPOSURE**

**Composure** (Touch Gold) overcame a stumble at the break and a lack of running room in the stretch to gamely win yesterday's GI Las Virgenes S. at Santa Anita. The filly's adventures began right at the start of the one-mile contest. "She gave away three lengths at the break by stumbling like that, but [trainer] Bob [Baffert] told me she does that sometimes," commented winning rider Jerry Bailey. After the break, Bailey allowed the filly, runner-up in last year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile and GI Hollywood Starlet, to settle off the pace set by Starlet victoress **Elloluv** (Gilded Time). The pair tried to sneak inside of Elloluv turning for home, but the hole closed, forcing Composure to move to the outside at midstretch. She closed relentlessly from there and just bested Elloluv by a neck in the final strides. "[Bailey] just put her right down on the inside and so I just had a lot of confidence," Baffert said. "He knew what he was doing and he knew he had a lot of horse. That other filly [Elloluv] is a quick filly and, going a mile, I knew she was going to have an edge on us." **BALTO STAR CHARGES TO WHIRLAWAY WIN**

**Balto Star** (Glitterman) had failed to find the winner's circle after a graded stakes race in over a year, despite several close calls, but rectified that yesterday with a 2 1/2-length victory in the GIII Whirlaway H. at Fair Grounds. The versatile gelding, second over the Belmont turf in the GI Man o' War last September, was coming off a dull eighth-place effort in the Jan. 4 GII Appleton H. He settled off the pace yesterday, as the veteran **Bonapaw** (Sabona) opened a clear advantage on the field. As Bonapaw gave way in the stretch, Balto Star sprang into action and quickly asserted command en route to a confident score. "He did a great job," Michael McCarthy, saddling Balto Star for trainer Todd Pletcher, said of the winner. "We wanted to rate him today and I know Todd was disappointed with his last race on the turf at Gulfstream Park. This was a good spot for him and he did a great job." **Mineshaft** (A.P. While eight runners took off to the outside fence for the 1000-meter sprint down Flemington's expansive straight, Choisir (Aus) was the lone ranger on the inside fence. The gamble paid off, however, and the G1 Caulfield Guineas place getter finally added a Group One trophy to his cache, clocking a speedy :56.6 over the trip. "I made a conviction I was going to go to the inside. I said to the boys at the barriers, 'I'm going in there,' and they were having a bit of a chuckle because they were going out. So it looks like I've had the last laugh," winning rider Glen Boss said. "Choisir should have won a lot more races, but lost them because he wasn't mentally mature," he added. "He should have won the Golden Slipper and even the Caulfield Guineas, but threw them away due to immaturity. Now he's a real racehorse. And a real good one." Spinning Hill (Aus), chasing successive Lightning S. wins, emerged from the pack on the other side to snare second ahead of Azevedo (Aus), while 5-2 favorite Rubitano (Aus) (Rubiton {Aus}) was fourth after crossing from his barrier to the outside rail. "I thought Rubitano would go with him, but oh, he's a special horse this one and he's improved so much mentally in the last six months that I thought he was still up to it," said trainer Paul Perry. Choisir will target the G1 Oakleigh Plate on Feb. 22 and the Newmarket at Flemington on Mar. 8.

Native Heir, winless since being claimed for \$50,000 by Gulfstream Park's leading owner/trainer team of Michael Gill and Mark Shuman at Delaware Park last September, streaked home in track-record equaling time. The five-year-old bay, narrowly beaten in a Jan. 22 six-furlong Gulfstream allowance last time, jumped out to the early lead and was never threatened, increasing his advantage down the lane to win by 4 1/2 lengths. "It was easy--a wire-to-wire run," said winning rider Cornelio Velazquez. "The trainer told me to put him on the lead. They changed the blinkers--used an open blinker today--and that made all the difference. From the half-mile pole the rest of the way, I never had to ask him." Of the decision to claim Native Heir, Shuman explained, "This horse used to be a stakes horse and that's why we claimed him off [trainer Anthony] Dutrow for \$50,000 last year. Dutrow took a shot and lost him to us." Shuman added that the Mar. 8 GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Sprint would be next up for Native Heir. Gygistar (Prospector's Music), unraced since winning the G1 King's Bishop last August, was sent off the 4-5 favorite, but tired to fifth after chasing the early pace. **San Felipe Possible for Baffert Duo:**

Trainer Bob Baffert said the Mar. 16 GII San Felipe S. at 1 1/16 miles could be next for both GII San Vicente S. winner **Kafwain** (Cherokee Run) and GII Santa Catalina winner **Domestic Dispute** (Unbridled's Song). "I wish they would run the [Mar. 1 GII] San Rafael at 1 1/16 miles [instead of one mile]," Baffert commented. "It would be good, not only for my three-year-olds, but for all of them. A mile is ridiculous. That distance is just for last-chance sprinters to try two turns." Baffert added, "Domestic Dispute will definitely run here [in the San Felipe] and Kafwain, probably too. It depends what's going on at the time."

Baffert said that **Bull Market** (Holy Bull), runner-up in last year's GII Norfolk, and GII Del Mar Futurity winner **Icecoldbeeratreds** (In Excess {Ire}), two three-year-olds with Triple Crown aspirations, are back in training after being sidelined by injuries.

**CHARISMATIC FILLY TOPS MIXED SALE** A yearling filly by Kentucky Derby winner Charismatic topped yesterday's opening session of the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale in Lexington. The chestnut, consigned by James Herbener, Jr., agent, was purchased by Stoneway Farm for \$64,000. Out of Whitesburg Express (Whitesburg), the filly is a half sister to graded stakes winner Highland Gold (Slew o' Gold). The sale, expanded from last year's one-session auction, continues today at 10 a.m. and is immediately followed by the Stallion Access Sale tonight.

While still a wee laddie to the likes of Kona Gold, six-year-old Peeping Tom has been battling on for quite some time, though signs of his decline seemed evident when he was a well-beaten sixth against \$50,000 claimers at Belmont last June. **INGLIS PREMIER SALE STARTS TODAY** The fast-expanding Inglis Premier Yearling Sale kicks off at the company's Oaklands complex in Melbourne Monday with 470 horses catalogued over the first two days and a further 110 in a third session scheduled for Thursday. The Premier sale, boosted by the A\$500,000 Premier S. for sales graduates and the A\$1 million Heroic S. for Inglis graduates, has also gained strength because of the fact that many yearlings are qualified for Victoria's lucrative SuperVOBIS breeders' incentive scheme. The venue boasted an 83.5-percent clearance rate, and averaged A\$36,850 for 3,112 sold at a gross of A\$11,460,500 last year--the only Australian sale to record an average increase in 2002. The modest average at Premier belies the fact the sale, overlooked by many high-profile purchasers until recently, has had more than its share of stakes-winning graduates, with 18 such horses in 2001-2002 including dual Group 1 winner Rubitano (Aus) (Rubiton {Aus}) and Caulfield Cup place-getter Fields of Omagh (Aus) (Rubiton {Aus}). "We had 1200 horses nominated for the sale and I genuinely believe this is our best catalogue to date," said Inglis Melbourne Director Peter Heagney. "Having so many nominated meant we were fairly selected and we've assembled a nice lot of horses both on pedigree and conformation."
