Looking to make it two in a row, the dark bay settled just off the early pace, swept past the leaders in the stretch and pulled away to give owner/trainer Rick Violette Jr. his first Grade I win. "We had a great trip," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "He broke well and he didn't get shuffled back, which really helped. We could have gone on at any time." ANOTHER STARRER ON THE WALK OF FAME

Already a multiple graded-stakes winner of nearly three-quarters of a million dollars, **Starrer** (Dynaformer) joined the elite yesterday with a runaway win in the GI Santa Maria H. at Santa Anita. The dark bay mare ended 2002 with a successful title defense in the GII Bayakoa H. at Hollywood Park Dec. 15 and was the even-money favorite to make it two in a row in her 2003 debut. She dragged jockey Pat Valenzuela up to join the frontrunners on the first turn, was under a stout hold to sit just off them down the backstretch, then went after the lead from the inside on the final bend and sprinted clear late. "I was very lucky to keep her calm in the first part because she was very keen to go on," Valenzuela said. "So I brought her back a couple of lengths off the pace and at that point I knew I could put her anywhere I wanted. At the quarter pole I threw a cross and she went on, just like that." Plans for the winner have not yet been mapped out. **You** (You and I), the second choice in the race, tried to come between horses at the top of the lane, but could not match strides with the winner and had to settle for second. Never out of the top three in his eight career starts, Self Flit added blinkers and successfully negotiated the jump to stakes competition with a narrow victory. A one-length winner over 1400 meters Oct. 1, the bay finished second in a Class 1 handicap Nov. 30 and was second last time behind Bowman's Crossing in a similar event Jan. 19. The favorite threw his head at the start and may have hit the gate, costing him valuable position as he raced in heavy traffic at the tail of the field. Meanwhile, jockey Eddie Lai aboard Self Flit broke cleanly from the inside and saved all the ground just in behind the pace from fifth. Turning for home, Self Flit was guided off the fence and hit the front with a furlong to run. Bowman's Crossing, on hold from the 600- to the 400-meter mark finally got clear sailing in upper stretch, but just failed to find the line. The win was a meaningful one for trainer Ivan Allan, who owned the winner's sire (by Alzao), a dual Listed stakes winner in England for Henry Cecil. He also trained a half sister who was stakes placed in Hong Kong. Asked whether he thinks Self Flit can stay the 2000 meters of the Mar. 23 G1 Hong Kong Derby, the conditioner replied, "I think so. There is plenty of stamina on both sides of the pedigree and he does things right in his races."

Badge Of Silver ran away and hid from his rivals in his first two starts and he handled his first foray into stakes company just as impressively, dispatching with this field with ease. The dark bay debuted at Keeneland last April, cruising to a nine-length victory, then disappeared. He returned to take a Fair Grounds allowance by seven lengths Jan. 23, but was making his two-turn debut this time. Second for the opening half, the newest Triple Crown contender put a head in front after six furlongs and bid adieu to his 11 foes, galloping away to an explosive score. "He broke so good today and I just got him to settle," winning jockey Robby Albarado said. "He relaxed for me and I felt I had a lot of horse from start to finish. He was crying to run the whole race. You have to think, since he finished so strong, that he should get a little added distance." Added owner Ken Ramsey, "We are elated. This horse has all the potential in the world. Hopefully this turns out to be a [Kentucky] Derby horse. His performance today was awesome. Ronny [Werner] and his team did a terrific job." The Bobby Frankel train keeps a rollin' and with another strong contender here, it looks like the next stop will be a familiar one for the Hall of Fame trainer: the winner's circle. With **Sea of Showers** scratched, the bullet left in Frankel's gun is **Final Destination**. Winner of the G1 New Zealand 1000 Guineas and the G1 Bayer Classic in consecutive starts in 2001, the five-year-old mare made her first start in the States a victorious one, galloping along through easy fractions before asserting in the final stages against Hollywood allowance rivals Dec. 11. The main danger appears to be **Embassy Belle**, who followed three straight wins against handicap company in Ireland with a rallying second-place finish in her U.S. debut, a 6 1/2-furlong allowance at Santa Anita Jan. 29. The bay should appreciate the extra ground here with Gary Stevens in the saddle for the first time. **Sentimental Value**, third in an off-the-turf allowance test in her latest Dec. 18, returns to the turf for the first time since a convincing two-length victory in the Harold C. Ramser Sr. H. over this same course Oct. 14.

Kafwain Headed To Fair Grounds?

GII San Vicente S. winner **Kafwain** (Cherokee Run) will likely make his next start in the Mar. 9 GII Louisiana Derby, trainer Bob Baffert told *The Blood-Horse*. "It's a \$750,000 race and it'll be just as tough as the one out here [Mar. 1 GII San Rafael S.], which is half the money," Baffert said. "Plus, he's a good shipper." Kafwain worked at Santa Anita yesterday, going five furlongs in a bullet :59 3/5 over a track labeled "good."

Florida Derby Shaping Up

The first four finishers from Saturday's GI Fountain Of Youth S. are all considering the Mar. 15 GI Florida Derby. **Trust N Luck** (Montbrook) came back from his handy score in good order and is definite for the event. "He came out of the race in super shape," trainer Ralph Ziadie said. "Our plan all along was to run him in the Florida Derby and that hasn't changed...then we'll see about the Kentucky Derby."

Longshot runner-up **Supah Blitz** (Mecke) is also a possible for the nine-furlong test. "I'd like to take a shot at the Florida Derby, because I think the farther they go the better my horse likes it," trainer Manny Tortora said. "But I'll wait and take a look at the field."

Midway Cat (Sir Cat), third, and **Offlee Wild** (Wild Again), fourth, are also potential Florida Derby candidates, but trainer Patrick Biancone said yesterday that **Whywhywhy** (Mr. Greeley), who tired to be fifth, will be sprinting in the future. "He just couldn't stay," Biancone said. "We'll have to take another trail with him now. We'll point for the Swale S. [GIII, Mar. 15, seven furlongs]. There are a lot of seven-furlong stakes around and that might be his best distance."

Ten Cents A Shine (Devil His Due), a disappointing sixth as the slight choice in the Fountain Of Youth, had an excuse for his effort. "We scoped him after the race and he has a bad lung infection," trainer Ken McPeck said. "I still think the Florida Derby is a possibility, but we'll have to see what happens between now and then."

LAUREL STAKES MOVED TO SATURDAY The GII General George H. and GII Barbara Fritchie H., which had been scheduled for today's card at Laurel Park, have been moved to this Saturday's program. The John B. Campbell S. has been rescheduled for Sunday's card. The three stakes will be re-drawn, with entries for Saturday to be taken Tuesday. Racing was called off at Laurel yesterday and today due to the winter storm that dumped more than a foot of snow along the East Coast. Racing was also cancelled at Aqueduct after the first race yesterday, and Monday's card has been scrapped as well. The Rare Treat S., set for yesterday, has been moved to Wednesday. Philadelphia Park, Charles Town and Turfway Park also canceled live racing yesterday.
