Atswhatimtalknbout (A.P. Indy) punched his ticket for the Road to the Roses with a determined effort to defeat **During** (Cherokee Run) in a Santa Anita allowance yesterday afternoon. "We're getting such a late start on the Derby trail that every race means a lot," said winning trainer Ron Ellis. "We need to see a step forward out of him every time he runs. He took that step forward today and he's coming along like we want him to." A handful in the post parade, the handsome bay moved into contention on the far turn and outslugged a game **During**, winning by 3/4-length and galloping out strongly. "His style will really fit a mile and a quarter or a mile and an eighth

in some of the longer races," Ellis added. "The Santa Anita Derby [GI, Apr. 5] is the plan right now. We've been getting him used to Santa Anita, so we don't want to take him any place else."

Magic Weisner Returns to the Laurel Worktab:

Magic Weisner (Ameri Valay), out of action since being diagnosed with West Nile virus last September, returned to the track yesterday for his first official work, covering three furlongs in :39 3/5 Laurel Park for his owner, breeder and trainer Nancy Alberts. "It was just a little breeze. He has to build himself back up," the conditioner commented. "He's very happy about himself. He just wants to train. He did it all on his own and it was a very useful breeze." Second to War Emblem in the GI Preakness S. and the GI Haskell H. last season, the Maryland-bred was scratched on the eve of last September's GIII Pennsylvania Derby after spiking a fever. He later displayed signs of neurological problems, including instability and some swelling of the brain and was diagnosed with West Nile, normally transmitted by the bite of an infected mosquito. "All the doctors have been saying that he should recover 100 percent," Alberts continued. "I certainly don't have any doubts that he will. He's a tough hombre." Although the trainer admits that she is "eyeballing a couple of things" for Magic Weisner's return to the races, she indicated that she would wait and see how he trains over the next month before making any decisions.

Invisible Ink Joins Rising Hill Stallion Roster:

Peachtree Stables' Kentucky Derby runner-up **Invisible Ink** (Thunder Gulch--Conquistress, by Conquistador Cielo), who retired last fall, will stand his initial season for \$3,500 at James and Sheila DiMare's Rising Hill Farm near Ocala, Florida. "We had been looking to syndicate him, but I wasn't happy with any of the proposals," Peachtree President John Fort told *The Blood-Horse*. "They weren't as appealing as the opportunity to stand him myself." The five-year-old, who also finished third in the GI Florida Derby at three, scored in four of his 14 lifetime starts for earnings of \$465,088. Although starting later in the season than usual, Fort assures that Invisible Ink will have plenty of opportunity in 2003. "He's going to be bred to a lot of mares and it only takes a little success to get a stallion on his way," Fort added. "He already has a recognizable name and breeders are aware of his talent as a racehorse."

Delaware Park Releases Stakes Schedule:

Officials at Delaware Park have released their 2003 stakes schedule, encompassing 30 added-money events with total purse distribution of nearly \$4.1 million. The program is headlined by the July 20 Delaware H., up-graded from Grade III to Grade II level this year and carrying a purse of \$750,000, up from \$600,000 in 2002. The same day features the \$250,000 GIII Kent Breeders' Cup and the \$100,000 Light Hearted H. The Festival weekend kicks off with the running of the GIII Delaware Oaks July 19, which has seen its purse doubled to \$500,000 for this year's renewal. Other highlights include the quarter-million GIII Leonard Richards S. for three-year-olds June 7; the GIII Endine S. for older filly and mare sprinters Sept. 6; and the NATC Futurity and Sorority Aug. 30, open to horses who have gone through the ring at a two-year-old sale and each worth an estimated \$300,000. Delaware Park will conduct live racing on a Saturday through Tuesday schedule beginning Apr. 26 through Nov. 9.

Northview Reschedules Open House:

The President's Day storm which shut down much of the Mid-Atlantic region has forced Northview Stallion Station in Chesapeake City, Maryland, to reschedule their Open House and Stallion Showing to Sunday, Mar. 2. Turfway Park was forced to cancel its sixth straight card yesterday due to uneven thawing of the track. 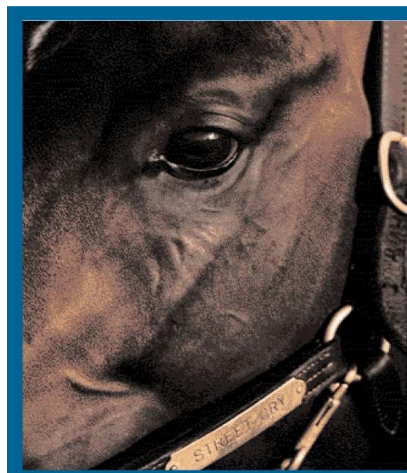

Danuta began her career with a runner-up finish at Saratoga last August and graduated from the maiden ranks in her second start, racing one mile at Belmont Sept. 15. Making her first start since then, the filly jumped out to the early lead and was never threatened in an easy victory. Godolphin's promising Loving Kindness (Seattle Slew), winner of the G3 Prix de Cabourg and third behind Elusive City in the G1 Prix Morny, finished only fifth yesterday, beaten over 16 lengths. "We will have a good look at the filly tomorrow," said Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford. "Quite clearly things weren't right today. She is a beautifully bred filly and worth a lot as a broodmare and hopefully we'll get her back into winning form." Danuta will likely head to the UAE 1000 Guineas Mar. 13 and possibly the UAE Oaks Apr. 4. "She is a very nice filly," Crisford said of the winner. "We are delighted, she had good form last summer in America and she has brought that here." Crisford added the filly would likely return to the United States this year.

GENERAL NEDIYM COLT TOPS AT ADELAIDE

A colt by General Nediym (Aus), selling as [lot 285](#), topped yesterday's second session of the Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale with a final bid of A\$205,000. The chestnut was consigned by Wistow-based breeders John and Pat Glenney and he will be prepared in Hong Kong by Australian expatriate John Moore, his brother Gary Moore confirmed. "I was on the phone to John during the bidding and he was keen to buy him," Moore said. "He was the best colt in the sale; very athletic and I'm very keen on his sire, who's made a great start at stud." The colt was knocked down to Magic Millions as agent. Dual Group 1-winning sire General Nediym is relocating from Queensland to Hunter Valley boutique farm Ballydoyle this season with his current two-year-olds attracting attention. The session topper is the first foal of the winning Perugino mare Petagina (Aus). During two days, Magic Millions sold 240 yearlings for an aggregate of A\$8,049,500. Magic Millions chief David Chester said the reduced size of the catalogue was the reason for lesser figures than 2002 and fewer horses were offered because Magic Millions held private weanling dispersal sales for Lindsay Park and Gawler Park Stud in South Australia last year. "The top of the market was as strong as any other sale in Australasia this year," Chester said. SA Thoroughbred Breeders Association President Lynden Burns blamed a shortage of top-quality yearlings to satisfy buyers and he said SA breeders would offer greater support for the sale in 2004. A further 159 yearlings will be offered in the Summer Session Friday at 11a.m. at the Morphettville sale complex.
