RAMSEYS A DOUBLE DERBY THREAT?

Ken and Sarah Ramsey already have Badge of Silver on the Triple Crown trail and now, with major turf stakes well down the road, **Nothing To Lose** (Sky Classic) may get his chance. The homebred colt successfully followed up his win in the Jan. 1 GIII Tropical Park Derby, enduring a tough trip to earn a narrow victory over **White Cat** (Mountain Cat) in yesterday's GIII Palm Beach S. at Gulfstream, remaining undefeated in four tries over the lawn. "I was very fortunate to save as much ground on the first turn, because on the second turn I wasn't so fortunate and things began to get a little rough," commented winning rider Jerry Bailey. "He got bounced around pretty good in there. He's pretty tough." So, with nothing to lose, connections are inclined to take a stab back on the main track. "We're looking at the [Mar. 22 GII] Lane's End S. at Turfway for his next start," assistant trainer Mike Maker confirmed.

DONN MAY BE NO HOLIDAY FOR HARLAN

Undefeated in three tries at today's nine-furlong distance and already a Grade I winner over this surface, **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) is strictly the one to beat when 11 older horses go postward in this afternoon's GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park. The blaze-faced bay finished a solid third in his first try against his elders in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, but was ninth in the Breeders' Cup Classic and fourth in the GI Cigar Mile H. to end his sophomore campaign. Returned to his favorite track, the Ohio-bred was a 1 3/4-length allowance winner Feb. 2, defeating several of today's foes, including **Bonus Pack** (Colonial Affair), **Mr. John** (Golden Gear) and **Request For Parole** (Judge T C), but must overcome the outside post. "I thought he ran very well [in his allowance win] and I thought he ran well in the Jockey Club Gold Cup, because he was stuck down on the inside in both races," trainer Todd Pletcher commented. "I think he'll run well in the Donn." **Hero's Tribute** (Sea Hero) comes into the race off a troubled fourth-place effort behind **Windsor Castle** (Lord Carson) and **Saint Verre** (Saint Ballado) in the GIII Hal's Hope H. Jan. 11. His jockey expects an improved performance today. "He could've been right there," Edgar Prado told *Daily Racing Form*. "Hopefully we'll get a cleaner trip this time. He's not the kind of horse that has that quick acceleration." **Blue Burner** (French Deputy), second to the favorite in last year's GI Florida Derby, defeated **Puzzlement** (Pine Bluff) by a head in a Jan. 25 allowance, but needs a break-out performance to factor.

To make the case for **My Cousin Matt** involves forgiving his latest effort, when he shipped to the left coast to finish a lackluster sixth in the Dec. 26 GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita. His two efforts prior to that one were nothing short of spectacular, finishing a tough-luck second in Calder's Jack Dudley Sprint H. Nov. 16 before reporting home a seven-length winner of the Great State Challenge Sprint at Sam Houston Dec. 7. Those two races earned him Beyer Speed Figures of 109 and 110, respectively, which would put him right on the wire here. **Disturbingthepeace** should go favored off his West Coast form from last year, which included a six-race winning streak, capped by a trio of Grade II wins. Seventh in the Breeders' Cup Sprint last October, the Cal-bred was third in his seasonal bow in the Jan. 26 GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita.

Atswhatimtalknbout (A.P. Indy) will make his next start in stakes company, trainer Ron Ellis said yesterday. "I think we're going in the San Felipe," the conditioner commented, one day after the colt's allowance victory at Santa Anita. "Timing wise it's very good. We'll see what he can do. It will be a little step up for him, but we'll see if he's good enough." The \$900,000 Fasig-Tipton February purchase came from off the pace to win by 3/4 of a length, an effort which pleased his trainer. "This race will help him a lot," Ellis continued. "He had to fight it out a little bit and it was a decent time (1:41.89 for the 1 1/16 miles)." The winner's final mark was faster than each of the last four runnings of the San Felipe S., won in reverse order by Medaglia d'Oro, Point Given, Fusaichi Pegasus and Prime Timber. "Things are going well," said trainer John Scanlan, who conditions Toccet for owner Dan Borislow. He could make his return to the races in the Mar. 29 Private Terms S. at Laurel.

Outta Here Skips Palm Beach, Eyes UAE Derby

Outta Here (Dehere), the winner of his most recent start in the \$500,000 Delta Jackpot S. at Delta Downs, was forced to miss yesterday's Gill Palm Beach S. at Gulfstream Park and will now just train up to the G2 UAE Derby on the Dubai World Cup undercard Mar. 29. "He missed some training, so we had to skip the race," trainer and co-owner Bill Currin told *Thoroughbred Times*. "He'll be ready to go to Dubai. He's had his inoculations and we're going to fly there from Los Angeles [around] March 15."
