**QUEEN OF CALDER MEETS MY BOSTON GAL**

Today's GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream will feature unbeaten **My Boston Gal** (Boston Harbor) making her three-year-old debut against **Ivanavinalot** (West Acre), who travels crosstown from her Calder base. A Triple Crown nominee, My Boston Gal rattled off three im-

pressive victories in her two-year-old campaign, which culminated with a sharp score in the GII Golden Rod S. Nov. 30. Ivanvinalot has lived up to her name over at Calder, winning five of her six starts over that surface by a combined 41 1/4 lengths. The Florida-bred travelled to the Golden State for her most recent outing and ran a game second to MGSW Atlantic Ocean in the

Sunshine Millions Oaks at Santa Anita Jan. 25. This accomplished duo will meet four fillies making their stakes debuts, including an regally bred pair of local allowance winners in **Perfect Story** (Tale of the Cat) and **Yell** (A.P. Indy). Perfect Story, a \$975,000 Keeneland November weanling purchase, is a half-sister to Horse of the Year Point Given who smoothly handled the transition to two turns in a two-length victory Feb. 5, her second success at this meeting. Yell, a game winner going a mile and 70 yards Jan. 16, will shoot to become the fourth graded-stakes winner for her dam Wild Applause (Northern Dancer).

**HALLANDALE HOLIDAY**

Last year's Florida Derby hero **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) continued his love affair with Gulfstream Park by coming from off the pace to win the GI Donn H. yesterday afternoon. The Ohio-bred colt was unable to run down the free-running Booklet in both the GI Fountain of Youth S. and the GIII Holy Bull S. early last year, but turned the tables on that colt with his Florida Derby victory last March, then added the GI Blue Grass S. to his laurels. Freshened up following a fourth to Congaree in the GI Cigar Mile Nov. 30, Harlan's Holiday made a winning return in a tough allowance Feb. 2, an effort which earned him a 111 Beyer Speed Figure and 2-1 favoritism. Breaking from the outside, he was able to secure a good spot as **Keats** (Hennessy) did his stuff up front, then came rolling three wide on the far turn and grabbed the lead en route to a convincing victory. "He has been training so well here at Gulfstream and, obviously, he loves this racetrack," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "The only question I had going into the race was the post position and the fact he had run just 20 days ago. He answered both those questions." Pletcher indicated that the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 29 would be considered for his charge's next start.

Rangy filly Rodean unwound a withering finishing burst to eclipse her higher-profile stablemate and race favorite Halibery to capture this rich event over a rain-soaked track. Rodean's status for this race was somewhat doubtful after suffering a jarred knee when running third to Halibery in the Blue Diamond Preview S. Jan. 27, but trainer Mick Price persisted with the filly and was rewarded for his decision. The favorite bounded nicely away from the stalls and sprinted clear as the eventual winner raced in eighth through the early stages. Halibery still held a two-length advantage with 200 meters to run, but by then Rodean was in full gear on the outside and closed determinedly for the win. Kusi outfinished Halibery for second money. The winning conditioner indicated that both the winner and third-place finisher would receive some time away from the races. Rodean is the fifth individual Group 1 winner and third juvenile Group 1 winner for her sire.

The four-year-old filly had previously won over heavy going and despite winning two of her last three appearances on firm ground, she skimmed the surface where others, such as last year's G1 Blue Diamond S. hero Bel Esprit (Aus) (Royal Academy) struggled. River Dove bided her time and loomed late, outsprinting her rivals to the line to register the narrow victory. She is the third G1 winner for her sire.

Can you feel the heat? Xtra Heat became the leading distaffer by number of career stakes wins--25--with this victory under miserable conditions. Fittingly, the score came at her home base of Laurel. The bay changed hands for \$1.5 million following her sixth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 26. In her first start for her new connections, she ran second to Dat You Miz Blue in the Garland of Roses H. Dec. 14 while giving the winner 11 pounds, but she rebounded smartly with a front-running success in the What a Summer S. Jan. 18 at Laurel. The crowd questioned whether the five-year-old would be at her best while giving away from six to 13 pounds to her rivals over a sloppy track as she opened at 9-2 in the betting. Her odds came down, however, and she was even-money as they loaded into the gate. Carson Hollow was away smartly, but Xtra Heat came after her, took charge on the turn and maintained a safe margin under the wire. "She deserves this record," said winning trainer John Salzman. "You look at her and [realize] she is truly amazing." In recording the 25th stakes victory of her career, Xtra Heat moves into a tie for third with Stymie and Little Bold John on the all-time list. The legendary John Henry is the leader with 30.

Claimed for \$85,000 out of a 3 1/4-length victory at Belmont last Sept. 25, My Cousin Matt returned an immediate dividend on that investment with a 5 1/2-length allowance score in the Belmont mud Oct. 14. Caught at the wire of Calder's Jack Dudley Sprint H. for state-breds Nov. 16, the dark bay dusted the Great State Challenge Sprint field by seven lengths Dec. 7, but was last seen when a disappointing sixth at odds of 7-2 in the Dec. 26 GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita. The third choice in his four-year-old bow, the Richard Englander colorbearer settled in a good position behind favored D'wildcat (Forest Wildcat), who set the early pace ahead of fellow California invader Disturbingthepeace and 2001 General George winner Peeping Tom. My Cousin Matt, always travelling smartly, was given his cue four wide into the stretch, hit the front at the furlong marker and drew clear under a drive. "He really exploded on the turn and it was over after that," said winning rider Ramon Dominguez. The General George could be start of a big year for My Cousin Matt. "Rick Englander, who owns him, thinks he's the best sprinter in the country," commented winning trainer Scott Lake. "I think he has a little to prove yet, but this moves him in the right direction."

Trainer Bob Hess opted not to go up against Affluent and Sightseek in the GI Santa Monica H. Jan. 25 and waited for this spot. Allowed to sit just off the scorching (:21.25, :43.81) pace, Spring Meadow moved up to take charge in midstretch, but got a little leg weary late and found the wire just in time. "I think this is a good distance for her," said Hess. "We needed to get the Grade III out of the way. Now we can go for the big purses and whatnot down the line. But we needed to get a graded win in her record books."

He was the second choice to MGSW Crafty Shaw, but prevailed under patient handling by rider Luis Quinonez. Second down the backstretch, he lost ground on the far turn, then came on again in the final furlong to post a clear victory. "He will stay here," stated winning trainer Noel Hickey. "He really likes this track and has shown he belongs with these kind of horses." Colorful Tour will likely make his next appearance in the GIII Razorback H. Mar. 16 before shooting for the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 5. As for Crafty Shaw, trainer Pete Vestal said, "He beat himself as much as anything."

**MARIE KRANTZ DIES AT 67** Marie G. Krantz, a prominent leader in Louisiana Thoroughbred racing and chairman of the board of Fair Grounds for the last 13 years, passed away early Saturday after a long illness. She was 67. Krantz, whose career began in 1958 working in the front office of the "old" Jefferson Downs, was the only employee retained after that track was destroyed by Hurricane Betsy in 1965. She was named construction manager of the "new" Jefferson Downs and earned the title of general manager a year after the track reopened in 1971. After purchasing controlling interest in Fair Grounds in 1990--and subsequently being named chairman of the board--Krantz oversaw the rebuilding of Fair Grounds after a 1993 fire. Her son, Bryan, is currently president and general manager of Fair Grounds. Marie Krantz will be inducted posthumously in Fair Grounds' Racing Hall of Fame Mar. 8, the same night she is to be awarded the first-ever Marie G. Krantz Fair Grounds' Lifetime Achievement Award in honor of her substantial contribution to the racing industry in Louisiana. A viewing will take place at Lake Lawn Metairie Funeral Home, 5100 Pontchartrain Blvd., in New Orleans Tuesday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
