

BIG 'CAP NO WALKOVER FOR FAVE

Yes, he seems to have found career-best form and, yes, he is deserving of odds-on favoritism, but **Congaree** (Arazi) has some questions to answer as he spots significant weight to some serious horses, including four other Grade/Group 1 winners, in this afternoon's \$1 million GI Santa Anita H. The Stonerside

homebred will tote high weight of 124 pounds as he goes in search of his fourth consecutive victory and will be trying to give trainer Bob Baffert second Big 'Cap victory in four years following on the success of General Challenge in 2000. "He's a bigger, stronger horse than he was last year," the silver-haired trainer said. He also seems to be getting wiser as he gets older. "He's relaxing in his races and he's a very smart horse. [Jerry] Bailey feels he can put him anywhere in a race," he added.

Trainer Richard Mandella, who has won this event twice and swept the top three positions in 1997, sends out two top-notch runners. **Kudos** (Kris S.) parlayed a third-place finish behind **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again) a year ago into a smashing success in the GI Oaklawn H., but was sidelined off that effort and returned with a solid runner-up finish to the favorite in the GII San Pasqual H. Jan. 4. The elder Mandella's other bullet is **Pleasantly Perfect** (Pleasant Colony), winner of the GII Goodwood BC H. last October. Excluded from the Breeders' Cup Classic essentially on a technicality, the bay was third to Congaree in the Feb. 2 GII San Antonio H. and figures to improve off that effort. "He's a great big horse that carries a lot of weight," the conditioner said. "He got a lot out of his race in the San Antonio and I expect him to move forward." **Sligo Bay (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), hero of the GI Hollywood Turf Cup last November, is making his main-track debut this afternoon, while **Trompolino (Chi)**, who bested **Piensa Sonando (Chi)** (Gallantsky) to win the 2001 G1 Chilean St Leger, is a son of 1994 Big 'Cap victor Stuka. The latter took the GIII Native Diver H. at Hollywood Park last December.

A MAGNIFICENT MILER

Seven-year-old **Good Journey** (Nureyev), making just the 16th start of a very successful career, returns to action this afternoon as the strong favorite in the GII Frank E. Kilroe Mile H. at Santa Anita. It is the beginning of a stretch which will mark the final three starts of his career, as he will enter stud in Australia at this beginning of the Southern Hemisphere breeding season this July. The half brother to MGISP Aldebaran (Mr. Prospector), who runs in tomorrow's GI San Carlos H., was nearly untouchable a year ago, winning four of his five starts, including the GI Atto Mile. His only "blemish" was a third-place finish to Domedriver (Ire) in the Breeders' Cup Mile, but the chestnut rebounded to win the GII Citation H. for the second year in a row Nov. 30. Recent rains have left the Santa Anita turf course less than firm, something that trainer Wally Dollase does not mind. "I don't know if it will hurt anyone else, but it sure won't hurt me," the conditioner told *Daily Racing Form*. The chief protagonist this afternoon could be **Redattore (Brz)** (Roi Normand), who got away with slow fractions and flew home to take a Feb. 8 money allowance by 5 1/2 lengths in 1:34 4/5, earning a Beyer of 108. With more speed signed on today, look for an off-the-pace try from the eight-year-old. **Decarchy** (Distant View) won this event a year ago at 8-1, but is winless in four subsequent trips to the post, including a fourth to **Alyzig** (Danzig) in the Exceller H. over course and distance Jan. 25.

He represents trainer Bob Baffert's third string behind Kafwain and Domestic Dispute, and that's No Bull, but **Rojo Toro** just may be talented enough to add his name to the list of his barn's Triple Crown hopefuls. He has won his two career trips to the post last year by a combined 12 3/4 lengths and capped a very solid worktab with a mile in 1:39 Feb. 22. Owned by Hal Earnhardt III, the Florida-bred gets the services of jockey Jerry Bailey for his two-turn debut. **Sum Trick** gave a good account of himself in the GII San Vicente S. Feb. 1, dueling through fast early fractions before finishing a well-beaten, but clear second to Kafwain. He looms a threat if he can see out the distance. **Our Bobby V.** set a strong pace in the GII Santa Catalina S. Jan. 18, but was unable to withstand the late charge of Domestic Dispute. Still he finished well ahead of the well-regarded Scrimshaw and can factor from the rail. "We'll be up there on the pace," trainer Bill Spawr guaranteed. "They'll be putting pressure on him, but from the inside, we'll be in a good spot."

Seven Barbadian entries meet a solid group of five overseas entrants in this highlight of the Caribbean racing season. The home team is headed by five-year-old mare **Talkaboutlucky** and **Feet on Flames**, who have consistently locked horns and have proven themselves to be at the top of the Class A division on Barbados. Eugene and Laura Melnyk, who maintain a residence on the island, will be represented by a three-horse entry, including **Waltzin Storm**, last year's Gold Cup runner-up **Warleigh** and **Zoning**, who finished third and fourth and seventh, respectively, in a Jan. 29 turf allowance at Gulfstream Park. Making his Barbados debut is American import **Thady Quill**, second to Val Royal in the GII Oak Tree Breeders' Cup Mile in 2001 and most recently fourth in the Turf Paradise Breeders' Cup in Phoenix Feb. 1. Formerly trained by Bobby Frankel, the six-year-old makes his first start for trainer W.C. Marshall, who won this race last year with Blast of Storm. Turf Paradise will serve as the wagering and simulcasting hub for the race. It will be carded as their fourth race to be run at approximately 2:40 p.m. MST (4:40 p.m. EST) and will also be carried live on TVG.

Flores Chooses San Felipe Ride

Jockey David Flores has elected to ride B. Wayne Hughes' **Atswhatimtalknbout** (A.P. Indy) in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 16, passing on the opportunity to pilot GII Santa Catalina S. winner **Domestic Dispute** (Unbridled's Song). Bob Baffert, trainer of Domestic Dispute, has tabbed Jerry Bailey to assume the mount on that Gary Garber colorbearer. The decision speaks volumes on the potential of Atswhatimtalknbout, a \$900,000 FTFEB two-year-old purchase who has won two of his three starts to date. The imposing dark bay strode home impressively to win a Feb. 20 allowance at Santa Anita, earning a Beyer Speed Figure of 104 in the process. By comparison, for his win in the Santa Catalina, Domestic Dispute was given a 103 Beyer. Despite recent rains, trainer Ron Ellis says the colt has not missed a beat. "I'm going to try to get a couple of works into him before the [San Felipe] and see what happens. Our plan is to run in the San Felipe and the [GI] Santa Anita Derby [Apr. 5] and go from there."

Brancusi To Try Stakes Company

Brancusi (Deputy Commander) worked a solid six furlongs in 1:11 4/5 yesterday morning at Santa Anita, the second fastest of 23 works at the distance. Owned by Michael Tabor, the dark bay colt registered an impressive five-length maiden victory Feb. 15 and is slated to make his next start in stakes competition, according to trainer Patrick Biancone. "He worked very well this morning and I think it's time to take the next step," the conditioner said. "We are looking at the race in San Francisco next week [GIII El Camino Real Derby at Golden Gate Mar. 8] or the race here the following week [GII San Felipe S. at Santa Anita Mar. 16]. He seems to be improving so we think he deserves a chance." A \$100,000 Keeneland November weanling purchase, Brancusi was pinhooked for \$375,000 at the 2001 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga yearling sale.

Champali Heads Battaglia Memorial

Once-beaten **Champali** (Glitterman) goes postward as the 8-5 morning-line favorite in this afternoon's John Battaglia Memorial S. at Turfway Park, the main local prep for the GII Lane's End S. Mar. 22. Trained by Greg Foley, the bay was an 8-1 winner of the GIII Iroquois S. at Churchill Downs last November before finishing off the board in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. four weeks later. In two starts this season, he has won the Turfway Prevue S. and most recently the one-mile WEBN S. Feb. 1. He should be tested today by New York invader **Grey Comet** (Distinctive Pro). A three-time stakes winner, the Empire-bred comes in off a runner-up finish in the Feb. 8 Whirlaway S. at Aqueduct.

Peace Rules To Skip San Rafael; La Derby Next

Trainer Bobby Frankel has decided to scratch GIII Generous S. winner **Peace Rules** (Jules) from this afternoon's GII San Rafael S. at Santa Anita in favor of the GII Louisiana Derby at Fair Grounds Mar. 9. "There's a lot of speed in [the San Rafael] and I think it would come up a little short for this horse. It's a glorified sprint," the conditioner told *Thoroughbred Times*. The San Rafael is run at one mile while the Louisiana Derby is contested at a mile and a sixteenth. "Plus the Louisiana Derby is a \$750,000 race." Peace Rules is scheduled to leave California by plane on or around March 6.

GYGISTAR TO FACE XTRA HEAT **Gygistar** (Prospectors Music), winner of last year's GI King's Bishop S., will ship to Dubai and take on **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat) in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 29, *Thoroughbred Times* reports. The four-year-old, forced to miss the Breeders' Cup Sprint with a bruised hoof, returned earlier this month to be fifth in the GIII Deputy Minister H. at Gulfstream Park. GII General George winner **My Cousin Matt** (Matty G) is also reported to be under consideration for the 1200-meter race.

LEGISLATIVE REORGANIZATION AT NTRA

As a result of new federal campaign law provisions, the NTRA has reorganized its political and legislative fund-raising activities into two distinct operations: the NTRA Legislative Action Campaign and the NTRA Political Action Committee (PAC). The NTRA Legislative Action Campaign is the newly named continuation of the 1/4% program currently in place to fund lobbying and related legislative activities on behalf of the Thoroughbred industry. Under this program, buyers, sellers, consignors and sales companies voluntarily contribute one-quarter of one percent of the price of Thoroughbreds sold at public auction to the NTRA's legislative fund. In 2002, the 1/4% program raised more than \$2 million. While funds raised in this manner no longer may be used for national political party contributions, proceeds from the Legislative Action Campaign will be used to pay for educational seminars and events relating to the Congressional Horse Caucus; contributions at the state level to state political parties (in states where such contributions are still allowed); an annual contribution to the American Horse Council; horseracing lobbyists in Washington; as well as several studies and surveys on topics such as problem gambling and economic impact studies. The NTRA will complement the efforts of its Legislative Action Campaign with new emphasis on increasing the size of the NTRA PAC. "Hard-money" funds raised in this fashion (from individuals, with a limit of \$5,000 per person) may then be contributed by the PAC directly to candidates or political parties at the federal level (or in states prohibiting the use of corporate contributions or soft money"). "Like other industries with whom we compete for legislators' time and attention, we need both lobbying resources—made possible by the Legislative Action Campaign—and the ability to make political contributions to candidates who support our industry, which an expanded NTRA PAC enables." said NTRA Commissioner Tim Smith.
