ALDEBARAN (FINALLY) WINS

Aldebaran (Mr. Prospector) had made a name for himself as a professional groomer, with 11 runner-up finishes in 17 starts and second-place finishes in last year's GI Met Mile, GI Forego H., GI Vosburgh and GI Cigar Mile, but the bay made amends yesterday with an impressive come-from-behind five-length victory in the GI San Carlos H. at Santa Anita. Off since last fall's Cigar Mile, Aldebaran was content to settle well off the pace as a four-horse struggle for the lead ensued. He loomed a threatening presence with a five-wide move at the top of the stretch, took charge at midstretch and pulled clear to the wire. "This horse has been unlucky a little bit," admitted winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "I just told [jockey] Jose [Valdivia, Jr.] to take his time. I liked it when all four of them were going up there head and head." Valdivia added, "I never was worried he was going to get beat. As soon as I took him outside, he took off." MINESHAFT EXPLOSIVE IN BIG EASY

Mineshaft (A.P. Indy) had a three-race win streak interrupted when he was a late-closing second in the 1 1/16-mile Gill Whirlaway H., but the four-year-old had an extra half-furlong of the long Fair Grounds stretch to work with yesterday and he stormed home an easy 3 1/2-length winner of the GII New Orleans H. "I knew I wanted to be closer than last time because last time I was trying to teach him a lot," said winning rider Robby Albarado. "I had him in a place I wanted, which was a lot closer to the lead and he did everything right from there." Mineshaft, third in the G3 Prix Daphnis last July, was a nose best in the Jan. 19 Diplomat Way before his late rush in the Whirlaway. Yesterday, the colt collared front-running **Bonapaw** (Sabona) before the quarter-pole and sputtered clear from there. Amonita, winner of the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac as a two-year-old, won a Saratoga allowance contest in her North American debut. She was second in the GIII Noble Damsel at Belmont last fall before winning the Snazzle Dazzle H. at Calder in December, but tired to finish sixth when stretched out to 1 1/16 miles in the Jan. 5 GIII Honey Fox H. last time out. Steadied on the first turn, the dark bay mare came from just off the pace to take the lead in midstretch and was drawing clear late. "She was just cruising outside that other horse and did her thing when asked," trainer Christophe Clement said of the winner. "She is a very good horse. I will have to talk to the owner tonight. I don't know whether we will run her one more time or send her straight to Kentucky to be bred to Kingmambo." Winning jockey Jean-Luc Samyn added, "Mr. Clement told me she might not want to go as far as a mile and an eighth and to ease her along. But we had a nice soft pace to sit behind and she took off when I asked her to." Calista (GB) (Caerleon), the 3-2 favorite, chased the pacesetters but lacked a late kick and finished third. PLANS FOR SKY MESA UP IN THE AIR

Trainer John Ward still doesn't know when or where **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit) will make his three-year-old bow. "There are so many scenarios that could play out," Ward said yesterday. "I'd like to run him twice before running him in the Kentucky Derby. If I run him going seven furlongs that would put speed into him and then he may tire going a mile and an eighth. So I'd rather get a race into him going around two turns first then the mile and an eighth and that would lead to the mile and a quarter." Sky Mesa is undefeated in three starts, including victories in the G1 Hopeful S. and GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity. He missed the Breeders' Cup Juvenile with a minor ankle injury and has recently missed over a week of training with a bruised heel. "Right now I'm playing it day-to-day on getting him back to the track," Ward commented.

Senor Swinger (El Prado {Ire}), unbeaten in two lifetime starts, worked six furlongs in 1:11 4/5 at Gulfstream Park yesterday. "I was very pleased with the workout," trainer Mickey Goldfine said. "He seemed to be well within himself and I thought it was a very good work. He came out of it in great shape and he's right on track for the [Mar. 15 GI] Florida Derby." ... **Whywhywhy** (Mr. Greeley), aiming for the Mar. 15 GIII Swale S., worked six furlongs yesterday at Gulfstream in 1:17 3/5...Working towards the Mar. 9 GII Louisiana Derby, **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) worked six furlongs at Palm Meadows in 1:13 2/5 yesterday. The multiple stakes winner was most recently fifth in the GIII Holy Bull S.

LAST CALL FOR JIM AND TONIC International Group 1 globetrotter **Jim and Tonic (Fr)** (Double Bed {Fr}--Jimka {Fr}, by Jim French) has been retired after sustaining a training injury. Trainer Francois Doumen explained to *Racing Post*, "I was preparing Jim and Tonic for the Singapore Airlines International Cup, but he was not entirely sound after a recent gallop, and I prefer to retire him rather than see him hurt himself in a race, which would be a sad end for such a wonderful horse. He will become a hack and retire to the Haras d'Ecouves in Normandy, where he was born. I have spoken to his owner, John Martin, and he thanked me profusely for all the international exploits that we enjoyed with the horse. I first realised that he was something really special when he was second to Seeking The Pearl in the 1998 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville and both horses were inside the previous course record." Jim And Tonic won eight group races and scored a total of 13 wins from 39 starts and earned in excess of £3 million.
