**BIG MATCH-UP IN THE BIG EASY**

Two early favorites for the Kentucky Derby match strides in New Orleans this weekend as California invader **Kafwain** (Cherokee Run) and local favorite **Badge of Silver** (Silver Deputy) headline Sunday's GII Louisiana Derby at Fair Grounds. From the barn of trainer Bob

Baffert, Kafwain was second in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and is coming off an impressive score in the GII San Vicente S. He will break from post position five Sunday and was installed the 7-5 morning-line favorite. "The post is good, I've actually been lucky with number five," Baffert said. "When it is all said and

done, I think you'll see this come out as the toughest [Kentucky] Derby prep. It's great to have two colts of this caliber face off right now. It's going to be a great race; I'm looking forward to it." Badge of Silver, exiting an 10-length victory in the Feb. 16 GIII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds, is the race's 3-2 second choice. "He's ready to go," trainer Ronny Werner said. "This will be a good test and I expect the road will get tougher." Werner, who has never had a Triple Crown starter, added, "[Baffert] is already where I want to be. He has had some great success over the years and you have to respect anything he brings over to run." Baffert himself isn't downplaying the upcoming confrontation. "If one of these horses win, [he] should be the Kentucky Derby favorite for now," Baffert said of Kafwain and Badge of Silver. The last six Louisiana Derby winners have all come out of the Risen Star. In addition to Badge of Silver other graduates of this year's renewal of the local prep race include **Defrere's Vixen** (Defrere), **Lone Star Sky** (Conquistador Cielo) and **Prince Alphie** (Alphabet Soup).

**WORLD CUP OUT OF WORLD SERIES** The \$6-million G1 Dubai World Cup, which will be run Mar. 29, has pulled out of the World Series Racing Championship. Created in 1999, the 14-race event was first run under the banner of Emirates Airlines, but it has lacked a sponsor since 2001. The World Series committee expressed gratitude for HH Sheikh Mohammed's contribution to the early development of the World Series. The Dubai World Cup would have kicked off the 2003 Series, but now the opening event will be the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup in Hong Kong Apr. 27.

**Composure**, second in last year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, was the established star when she was upset by a 30-1 unknown **Elloluv** in the 1 1/16-miles GI Hollywood Starlet last December. The Bob Baffert trainee was in the barn when Elloluv won the seven-furlong GII Santa Ynez in January, but she got her revenge when the two met up again in the Feb. 9 GI Las Virgenes. After stumbling at the start, Composure was forced to alter course in upper stretch, but relentlessly closed on the pacesetter Elloluv to best that filly by a neck in the one-mile contest. Elloluv was giving Composure two pounds that day and trainer Craig Dollase hopes today's even weights will make the difference. "The way it's playing out now, we'll probably see ourselves landing on the lead again," Dollase said of Elloluv. "But we have equal weights this time and that might have made a difference last time."

**Atlantic Ocean** takes a three-race win streak into her Fair Grounds bow. The \$1.9-million two-year-old purchase won the GIII Miesque over the Hollywood turf last November and returned to the main track to take the Jan. 5 GIII Santa Ysabel before adding the Jan. 25 Sunshine Millions Oaks last time out. The unbeaten **Lady Tak** began the year with a five-length victory in the Jan. 4 Thelma S. and added the Jan. 26 Tiffany Lass S. last time out. **Belle of Perintown**, winner of the Pocahontas S. at Churchill last November, was eighth in the Tiffany Lass before a dominating eight-length triumph over track and distance in the Feb. 15 GII Silverbulletday. "She can win it if she runs back the way she did in the Silverbulletday," commented trainer Eddie Kenneally. "It's certainly a lot to ask of her to run back to that race. Lady Tak is the one to fear based on her record and the fact that she has trained over this track and I think that gives her the advantage over us and Atlantic Ocean."

A \$50,000 claim for Team Shuman/Gill last summer, **Native Heir** was equipped with blinkers four starts back and seems to have turned the corner. In two outings at the current meet, the bay was second in a tough money-allowance test Jan. 22 and led every step of the way to record a 4 1/2-length victory in the GIII Deputy Minister H. Feb. 9. He'll be difficult to collar as the likely controlling speed. **Tour Of The Cat** defeated subsequent GII General George H. winner My Cousin Matt in the Jack Dudley Sprint H. at Calder Nov. 16 and was most recently second to **Burning Roma** in the Tampa Bay Breeders' Cup S. on the turf Feb. 15. He has a pair of second-place finishes in two tries at this afternoon's seven-furlong distance.

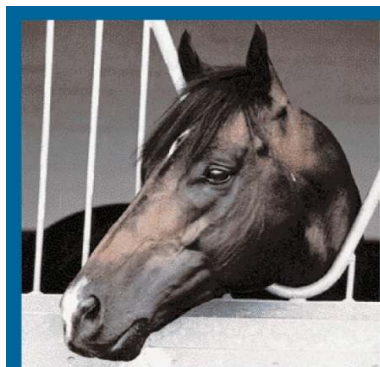

Despite the absence of G1 Arc de Triomphe runner-up Sulamani, Godolphin sends out a formidable trio led by **Essence of Dubai**. Winner of last year's G2 UAE Derby over course and distance, the son of champion Epitome makes his first start since winning the GII Super Derby last Sept. 21. **Grandera**, a multiple Group 1 winner on the turf, gets his first main-track test this evening to see where he fits on the Dubai World Cup program three weeks from today. The globetrotting five-year old, third in the G1 Cox Plate last October, was a disappointing seventh in the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 15. **Grundlefoot**, a graded-stakes winner in the U.S. last season, is two for three since being sold to Saudi Arabian interests last summer.

Come See You continued a brilliant streak for trainer Ivan Allan, circling five wide into the stretch before holding on for a narrow victory in the G3 Singapore Classic at Kranji last night. Ninth, but beaten just over three lengths in the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 15, the five-year-old celebrated the New Year with a half-length success in the G3-HK January Cup Jan. 8 and was coming into this off an eighth-place result in the G3-HK Centenary Vase in Hong Kong Feb. 3. Making his first career start around left-handed turns, Come See You, trained in Europe by Michael Jarvis prior to being exported, raced well in hand for jockey Weichong Marwing, but did not take the final bend very well. Once straightened, he hit the front at the 200-meter mark and just held on. "I'm very happy to win for Hong Kong," said the victorious conditioner, who has saddled a pair of Group 1 winners in his homeland in recent weeks. "It was very exciting and Marwing rode a great race. He timed his run to perfection."

**HRI OUTLINES FIVE-YEAR PLAN**

Horse Racing Ireland delivered their five-year plan to the Dublin Government on Thursday, highlighting the need to develop Ireland's racecourses as its central strategy. That drive will include the creation of the country's first all-weather track as HRI bid to "examine, refine and market the entire racing product with a customer focus," according to chairman Denis Brosnan. Other plans include the need to change the fixture list to attract greater attendances, a commercial rate for media rights and data licensing, a new Irish Racing Channel and the controversial move of increasing the charge on turnover for on-course bookmakers. Brosnan also outlined a controversial strategy of capping the number of foals produced in Ireland. Referring to the plan's statement that "the annual foal population cannot be allowed to exceed the level reached in 2002," Brosnan said, "The rapid growth of the breeding industry in recent years is both a testament to success and a challenge for the future. We outline strategies to encourage moderation in the production of foals and to protect the quality of Irish Thoroughbreds."
