**NEW YORK STATE OF MIND**

After making his first four starts in the Big Apple, **New York Hero** (Partner's Hero) travelled to Kentucky for his stakes debut and took the Blue Grass by storm, fighting his way to a neck victory over **Eugene's Third Son** (Indian Charlie) in the GII Lane's End S. at Turfway Park yesterday afternoon. "He is powerful and good-looking...like a New York hero ought to be," trainer Jennifer Pedersen said. The dark bay had tried two turns for the first time in his most recent outing, finishing second by a half length in an Aqueduct allowance test Feb. 27. Adding blinkers in his first try vs. stakes foes, he shadowed **Saintly Look** (Saint Ballado) for six furlongs, drove to the front at the top of the lane and dug down deep to hold off the runner-up. "This horse has a beautiful long stride," winning jockey Norberto Arroyo Jr. told *The Blood-Horse*. "Once he gets going, he won't give up. **ROUVRES BIDS FOR FIVE IN A ROW**

Worse than second just once in his nine-race career, **Rouvres (Fr)** (Anabaa) will go after a fifth consecutive win in today's GII Explosive Bid H. at Fair Grounds. The dark bay ended his overseas stint last spring, taking the G3 Prix de Guiche at Longchamp in May and the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly last June. He made his U.S. debut following an 8 1/2-month layoff and kept the streak alive with a Gulfstream allowance score Feb. 17. The field for the Explosive Bid softened significantly when Redattore (Brz) was forced to miss the race with a fever, but Rouvres will still have to work to add to his skein. **Mystery Giver** (Dynaformer) could do no better than 13th in this race last year, but he was beaten only 5 3/4 lengths by Sarafan and appears to have improved since. The five-year-old ended 2002 with a second-place finish in the Dec. 7 NTRA Great State Challenge Turf at Sam Houston and came back Feb. 7 to successfully defend his title in the Fair Grounds Breeders' Cup H. "He's bigger, he's stronger and mentally he knows what's required of him now," trainer Richard Scherer told the *Daily Racing Form*. "I think he's got the game figured out."

Jack and Bob Ingham's mighty Crown Lodge, a four-state operation headed by trainer John Hawkes, continued its unprecedented domination of Australian racing yesterday, snaring the G1 Australia S. at Moonee Valley with Yell and the G1 Canterbury Guineas in Sydney with Fine Society (Aus). Hawkes also sent out Slipper prelude winners Kusi (Aus), who captured the G3 Skyline S., and Legally Bay (Aus), heroine of the G3 Sweet Embrace S. In running his winning streak to five, Yell collected his third straight Group 1 win, bringing his earnings to A\$1,086,050 with seven wins and six placings from 14 starts. The three-year-old settled fourth on the rails before emerging on the outside at the top of the straight and driving to the wire for the win. Melbourne stable foreman Wayne Hawkes said Yell would either be given a break or pointed for the G1 Darley S. over 1500 meters at Rosehill Apr. 5. As Yell has yet to win beyond 1400 meters, another option is the G1 Goodwood H. over 1200 meters at Morphettville in South Australia May 17. Runner-up Dash For Cash was having his first start since surgery to remove a bone chip late last November.

The lightly raced Fine Society emerged as the thorn among roses at Canterbury's gala night meeting when, as the only filly in the field, she demolished a few reputations. King of Soul (Aus) (King of Kings {Ire}) set a ferocious pace in front, with Fine Society settled fourth from the rear. The winner was awkwardly positioned at the halfway mark behind a wall of horses that included highly regarded Helenus (Aus) (Helissio {Fr}) and Hydrometer. But, as Gosford Guineas winner Vital Agreement (Aus) (Belong to Me) was urged into 1 1/2-length lead as the field fanned rounding the turn, jockey Corey Brown sent the compact Fine Society forward to breeze past the leaders and win easily. She is likely to target the both the G1 AJC Derby and G1 AJC Oaks.

Quest Star picked up his first turf victory at no less prestigious a venue than Saratoga Race Course, taking the GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. as an 11-1 outsider Aug. 5. Fifth in the GIII Saranac H. at the Spa Sept. 2, the dark bay played the role of beaten favorite in his next two outings, running fourth in a Keeneland allowance test Oct. 5 and a close-up third over that course 18 days later. The four-year-old was freshened after that effort, returning to take a Gulfstream Park allowance race at a mile and three-eighths Feb. 9. The second choice facing stakes company once again, he went right to the lead, set pedestrian fractions and held favored Man From Wicklow at bay to the wire. "The only other horse with speed in the race was scratched, so I was able to take the lead nice and easy and move along at my own pace," winning jockey Edgar Prado said. The winner of the G1 Chilean Oaks in her final start in her native country, Noches de Rosa was away for eight months before making her U.S. debut, finishing fourth in the Aug. 14 Osunitas H. at Del Mar. Fourth again in both the Sept. 8 GII Palomar H. and the Oct. 5 GI Yellow Ribbon S., the dark bay mare ended the year with a sixth-place effort in the Nov. 3 GII Las Palmas H. She returned to be fourth in an optional claimer at Santa Anita Jan. 2, then finally picked up her first North American score in the Jan. 31 Reloy H. Looking to make it two in a row facing tougher here, the imported mare found herself setting a soft pace under a crafty Mike Smith. She edged clear at midstretch and was all out to beat Garden in the Rain at the wire. "I couldn't believe they let her get away with such slow fractions," winning trainer Richard Mandella said. "I thought she'd have enough left, the way she came out of the turn. She was down running and I thought she had pretty good momentum going." Added Smith, "She was trying so hard--she wasn't going to let them get by her. It's a great feeling when a horse gives you all they have. It just makes my job that much easier." The winner goes next in the Apr. 19 GII Santa Barbara H. Even-money favorite Megahertz steadied at the three-eighths pole, then loomed a danger in the stretch, but weakened late to be third. **The Making of a Hero...**

Foaled in Maryland, **New York Hero** (Partner's Hero) started his career with a second-place finish in an Aqueduct maiden Jan. 18. He returned 13 days later to notch his first win and added a six-furlong allowance success Feb. 19 before his excellent effort in his first try at a route. While his trainer felt he was ready for the step up into stakes competition, she decided that blinkers were in order as well. "Last time out he waited on [the winner], so I added the blinkers," Pedersen said. The colt will return to New York for his next start, taking on Empire Maker in the Apr. 12 GI Wood Memorial. "Bring it on, baby," the conditioner said. "I feel in my heart that he will keep winning."

**Lion Tamer Feels the Crack of the Whip...**

**Lion Tamer** (Will's Way), sent off the 4-5 favorite after his six-length victory in the GII Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream Park, was trying two turns for the first time. Caught behind horses while near the back of the pack early, he launched a bid at the top of the stretch, but hung late and could do no better than fourth. "He got too far back and that cost him the race," jockey John Velazquez said. "With this kind of track, it was tough for him to get rolling late. But...he's never been two turns before, so he should get better." Added trainer Todd Pletcher, "Obviously this is not the result that we wanted, but we are not discouraged. The [Kentucky] Derby is still in our thoughts. The question now is whether or not he needs another start before then."

Cyber Secret was second choice to the returning Roar Emotion, but beat the favorite to earn her first graded-stakes victory. An allowance winner over this surface Nov. 9, the bay didn't race again until Jan. 26, when she successfully negotiated two turns in taking the Busanda S. After a close fourth in the Busher S. Mar. 1, her connections were eager to cut her back to one turn here and Cyber Secret responded, tracking the early leader before taking charge in the stretch. She strode home to win by daylight over GII Demoiselle S. heroine Roar Emotion. "We've always thought she'd be better sprinting," explained trainer Richard Dutrow Jr., "but we were forced into running her in two-turn races over the inner track, which didn't work out so bad. **Elegant Fashion**, the lone filly in the field, turned in an impressive prep for this race, finishing a troubled third when beaten 3/4 of a length by G1 Hong Kong Mile hero Olympic Express (GB) in the Feb. 23 Hong Kong Gold Cup. A three-time Group 2 winner in Australia and runner-up in the G1 AJC Australian Oaks, she bids to become the first distaff winner of this event since Corvette (Aus) in 1976. She would also give trainer David Hayes, who saddles a four-horse entry, his first Hong Kong Derby victory. **Jazz Beat**, a conditions winner at Cork last July, went on to run second in the GII American Derby and the GI Secretariat S., where he was beaten only a nose, but ended 2002 with a seventh-place effort in the Sept. 22 GII Jamaica H. ### TRF Animal Planet Movie to Air:

*Big Spender*, an original movie based on the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation and the positive influence it has had on prison inmates, will debut Tuesday, Mar. 25 at 8 p.m. ET/PT on Animal Planet. The movie follows Eddie Burton, a repeat offender who has been unable to put his life back together and is jeopardizing his relationship with his young son. But Burton turns his life around and he is able to win back his son after entering a prison program run by the TRF. The rehabilitation program in *Big Spender* is based on the TRF's facility at the Wallkill Correctional Institute in Wallkill, New York. Casper Van Dien stars in the role of Eddie Burton. Director Paul Schneider said his inspiration was a newspaper story he read about the TRF and how its programs had had such a positive influence on prisoners, while finding homes for retired race horses who may have otherwise gone to slaughter. "I came across a story on the TRF that appeared in the *New York Times*," he said. "The headline was something like 'Cast Away Horses, Cast Away Men.' I was immediately drawn to that. Here were these guys, nothing had worked for them until the TRF helped change their lives. That said to me, this was a story. It jumped off the page." The horse in the movie is based on Banker's Jet, who won 28 of his 106 starts before breaking down in 1991. Privately retired, he was found at a farm in upstate New York in terrible condition and was sent to Wallkill, where he was nursed back to health by the program's inmates. Once Schneider visited the Wallkill facility, he knew it was a story that had to be told. "It was such an unusual setting," he said. "You had this juxtaposition of the prison and this bucolic, pastoral farm. There were these hardened men who had this softness and affection for these horses. It was really something to see." The Paul Sutherland-trained colt earned himself a G1 Golden Slipper berth in the process and fittingly continued the success for his sire. Bred and raced by Paul Mellon, Red Ransom sired Handsome Ransom from Bianca Lancia (Fr) (Mill Reef), a daughter of Mellon's homebred European champion. Red Ransom, Australia's preeminent Roberto-line representative, has demonstrated this season he'll be a more than capable flagbearer for fledgling stud Vinery, with two stakes winners and seven winners from 18 starters here to date. Red Ransom's first black-type performer came in the shape of Markane (Aus), who placed second in the Debutante S. last October. Classy filly Halibery (Aus), raced by interests including Vinery, really put Red Ransom on the map, winning three in a row culminating with the G3 Blue Diamond Prelude, before finishing third to stablemate Roedean (Aus) in the G1 Blue Diamond at Caulfield Feb. 22. She is likely to contest the Golden Slipper on April 12 without another start. Red Ransom's first Australian crop averaged A\$109,212 for 33 sold with a top price of A\$320,000, off a '99 fee of A\$50,000. He has a sizeable draft of 27 catalogued for the Inglis Easter sale next month, with yearlings including a filly from G1SW Shizu (NZ), a colt from well-bred Sadler's Wells mare Humour (Ire), a filly from SW Danehill mare Compulsion (Aus), a filly from G1SW Stella Cadente (Aus) and a half-brother to Golden Slipper winner Catbird (Aus) among Vinery's offerings.
