FRANKLY AND EARNESTLY CANDID

A steady performer, the six-year-old gelding **Candid Glen** (El Gran Senor) entered yesterday's GII Explosive Bid H. a disregarded 84-1 shot, but exited the nine-furlong Fair Grounds race a graded stakes winner. The dark bay was fourth in the Jan. 5 Col. E R Bradley H. before an eighth-place finish in the Feb. 1 Fair Grounds Breeders' Cup H. over yesterday's course and distance. He was coming off a 1 1/2-length tally in the Feb. 15 John Connally Breeders' Cup H., his third straight win in the Sam Houston race. Candid Glen enjoyed an un-hurried trip along the rail before moving outside to overtake pacesetter **Della Francesca** (Danzig) nearing midstretch. He outbattled French Group 1 winner **Rouvres** (Fr) (Anabaa) to the wire for a narrow score. "My horse may be little in stature, but he is mighty in heart," said winning trainer Andrew Leggio. Rouvres, the 6-5 favorite under Jerry Bailey, was six wide turning for home and loomed a bold presence with a furlong to run, but couldn't overtake the winner. The four-year-old filly **Elegant Fashion (Aus)** (Danewin {Aus}) showed a nice turn of foot in the final stages of yesterday's G1-HK Hong Kong Derby at Sha Tin and

left the boys in her wake as she proved herself 1 1/2-lengths better than runner-up **Self Flit (NZ)** (Cicerao {Ire}). A triple Group 2 winner and second in the G1 AJC Australian Oaks in her native Australia last year under the tutelage of trainer Tony McEvoy, Elegant

Fashion joined David Hayes' barn late last year with this very contest as the specified goal. "It was always the plan to bring her here for this race," said Hayes, "and it's very satisfying when a plan like that comes off." The chestnut was away in good order and settled five lengths off the pacesetter Self Flit, found room entering the straight and tackled the leader once given the go-ahead by jockey Gerald Mosse. "I was a bit worried about three furlongs out as the pressure increased, but I was patient," said Mosse. "When the gap appeared at the top of the straight, she gave me everything. She is a beautiful filly." Elegant Fashion, the first filly to win the Hong Kong Derby since 1976, is expected to start next in the Apr. 27 G1 Queen Elizabeth Cup. **Chart. p3**

TOMAHAWK VICTORIOUS IN RETURN

Aidan O'Brien's **Tomahawk** (Seattle Slew) captured his sophomore debut in yesterday's Oak Lodge Sires Loughbrown S. at The Curragh. The colt, a \$2.5-million Keeneland July yearling, had been off since finishing eighth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile last October. Prior to his Breeders' Cup run, he was runner-up in the G1 Middle Park S. and in the G1 Dewhurst, both at Newmarket. "He's a horse that just got a few gruelers and was unfortunate to get a hard race in the Middle Park and the Dewhurst," O'Brien said of Tomahawk. "It was probably the wrong thing to send him to America so quickly after those, as he lost a lot of weight." Of his win in yesterday's seven-furlong contest, O'Brien added, "[Jockey] Mick [Kinane] was delighted with him today and let him have a nice time. He has a lot of speed, but I'd say he'd get a mile if he was ridden to get it. I'd like to think he's a Guineas horse."

BEND ON TRIAL

Refuse to Bend (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) is likely to run in the Listed Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial Apr. 13, it was announced yesterday. Conditioner Dermot Weld is keen to let the unbeaten G1 National S. winner advertise his claims for the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 3 in the trial, where he will have to shoulder a seven-pound penalty. "He's very well; he's a relaxed, laid-back individual," said Weld. "We're really looking at the Leopardstown Guineas Trial and that will tell us where to go; whether he's a Guineas horse or a Derby horse."

 Since winning the 2001 GI Coaching Club American Oaks over 1 1/2 miles on the main track, Tweedside has found success on the turf. Winner of the 1 3/8-miles GII Sheepshead Bay H. last June, the bay mare returned from a four-month break and finished strongly to be third in the 1 1/2-mile GII La Prevoyante H. in December before being overtaken by San Dare in her most recent outing, a runner-up finish in the Feb. 8 GIII The Very One H. Back on the main track for the first time since August 2001 when this affair came off the turf, Tweedside sat just off pacesetting Amelia (Dixieland Band), overtook that rival turning for home and spurred clear to an easy win. "It's not very often you get to run a filly that's won a Grade I going 1 1/2 miles on the dirt in a 1 1/2 mile off-the-turf situation," admitted winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "I thought the filly was going to run well no matter what surface it was on, but when it came off the grass, it didn't hurt our feelings any. I told [jockey] Rene [Douglas] not to get her to the front too early, she tends to ease up a little bit by herself. At the three-eighths pole he made his move and it worked out in our favor." San Dare, hit the gate at the start, settled off the pace and split foes on the far turn but couldn't catch the winner. Smok'n Frolic ended her 2002 campaign with a 2 1/4-length victory in the Oct. 5 GII Cotillion H. and began 2003 in a similar fashion, taking the Jan. 25 Sunshine Millions Distaff at Santa Anita by 2 1/2 lengths. She was beaten 7 3/4 lengths by Allamerican Bertie when runner-up in the Mar. 1 GII Rampart H. last time out. Heavily favored in the field of six, the filly led from the start while setting fractions of :24.22, :47.65 and 1:10.89 and easily held sway late to take her earnings over the \$1-million mark. Her victory gave trainer Todd Pletcher a graded stakes double yesterday after Tweedside's win in the GIII Orchid H. at Gulfstream Park. "She broke so good I just put my hands down and let her run," said winning rider John Velazquez. "She was real comfortable out there. She was the class of the field. Todd's done a great job with her for her to put four great races together."
