BUSINESS OR PLEASURE?

After pressing a hot early pace, **Excessivepleasure** (In Excess {Ire}) got down to business in the stretch, driving to the lead and outfinishing 3-2 favorite **Spensive** (Ponche) for a neck victory in yesterday's inaugural \$500,000 WinStar Derby at Sunland Park. The dark bay has now finished first or second in all five career starts. A Hollywood maiden winner last November, the Cal-bred added a five-length triumph in the California Breeders Championship the following month, then came up a half-length short in the Jan. 25 Sunshine Millions Dash at Gulfstream Park. He stretched out to a mile for the first time in his latest and missed by a neck after setting the pace in the Mar. 2 Borderland Derby H. at Sunland. Looking for his first win of the year, the Triple Crown nominee chased **Apalachian Thunder** (Wekiva Springs) through a half in :44.30. He dropped back as they blazed through six furlongs in 1:08.49, but came on again to take the lead in the stretch before holding off Spensive and the resurgent pacesetter to the wire. Was the victory enough to earn Excessivepleasure a ticket to the May 3 GI Kentucky Derby? "That's up to [owners Lee and Ty Leatherman]," trainer Doug O'Neill told *The Blood-Horse*. "I don't think he can go a mile and a quarter, but it's up to them. It's their money." Click [here](#) for the brisnet.com chart.

BACK ON TRACK AT LONGCHAMP

Placed in every one of her first 11 starts, **Ana Marie (Fr)** (Anabaa) offered an uncharacteristic non-show when 11th to Marienbard (Ire) in last season's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, but returned to form in no uncertain manner in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at Longchamp yesterday afternoon. And, according to winning trainer Philippe Demercastel, the best may be yet to come. "She was not yet at her best for this race, but she is a nice filly who, except for her run in the Arc last year, has been consistent at the top level," Demercastel said. After beating subsequent G1 Prix de Diane heroine Bright Sky (Ire) by a length in the G3 Prix Vanteaux going nine furlongs last April, the bay went on to finish in a dead-heat for third in the Prix de Diane, then found only the talented Pearly Shells (GB) better when second by a short neck in the G2 Prix de Mailleret. She found herself 1 1/2 lengths behind Pearly Shells as the runner-up in the G1 Prix Vermeille in September. Ana Marie belied her model-of-consistency tag in the Arc, but was back on track in her first outing of 2003. The filly was settled in a handy third early as **Without Connexion (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest) led, was ridden to challenge on the outside at the eighth pole and ran on strongly in the closing stages to overhaul **Fair Mix (Ire)** (Linamix {Fr}) in the final strides by a short neck. "She should blossom now and come on a lot for that run," Demercastel said. "We have to try and win a Group 1 race with her, so her next outing will be the G1 Prix Ganay at this track Apr. 27. Believe, daughter of the great Sunday Silence, knocked down her second Group 1 victory as she beat the boys in front of a crowd of 43,160. The bay was sent off as the public's third pick, behind last year's hero Shonan Kampf (Jpn) (Sakura Bakushin O {Jpn}) and Sunningdale. She had a perfect stalking position along the inside of the former as he quickly wrested command of the pace after the break. A patient Katsumi Ando waited until upper stretch to give Believe the go-ahead, but once asked, his mount showed a brilliant turn of foot took rocket to the lead.

Sunningdale shook free of his mid-pack position and gave game chase in the closing stages, but ran out of real estate with the wire fast approaching. The winner is out of a half-sister to recently deceased Horse of the Year Lady's Secret. Longshot Rikiai Taikan came from well back to get third. American imports Echo Eddie (Restless Con) and Disturbingthepeace (Bold Badgett), representing the first two foreign contenders to compete in the Takamatsunomiya Kinen since it was made an international race three years ago, failed to make an impact. Disturbingthepeace finished 13th as a 10-1 chance, while Echo Eddie showed brief speed before tiring to 17th as a 30-1 outsider.

HANDLE DOWN ON DUBAI WORLD CUP The North American handle on the four races from Saturday's Dubai World Cup program at Nad al Sheba was \$2,491,826, an 8.6 percent decrease from last year. The World Cup itself attracted \$1,444,272 in wagers, down 7.6 percent from the 2002 edition. In addition to the \$6 million showpiece, the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen and G1 Dubai Duty Free H. were also simulcast to more than 600 outlets.

Stepping directly into stakes competition off a good maiden win two weeks ago, trainer Shug McGaughey's Charge overwhelmed the heavy favorite Purely Classic in deep stretch to notch his first stakes success. Trying grass for the first time in a Jan. 9 maiden test at Gulfstream, Charge ran an even fifth in an unspectacular time, but looked a different horse when he came flying up the rail to shed his maiden status by 1 1/4 lengths Mar. 13. Though the dark bay was sent off as a longshot here against a more seasoned crew of three-year-olds, he was confidently handled by jockey Eibar Coa, who kept his charge close to a plodding early pace over rain-softened ground. Gaining momentum from a five-wide position leaving the turn, Charge joined the crowd's choice with a furlong remaining and was full of run late to best that foe with confidence. "This is kind of an aggressive move for me," McGaughey said of the quick jump up in company for his colt. "But I thought, chances are if we go back to New York we aren't going to get to run him until May, so we'll go on and take a chance. If we're wrong, then we'll just go back to an a-other than [allowance]." The winner could go next in the May 2 GIII Crown Royal Turf American S. on the Kentucky Derby undercard.

Sent off the 3-10 favorite, the colt took the lead at the top of the stretch, but could not hold off 21-1 **Majestic Wisdom** (Whiskey Wisdom) and finished second by a neck. "He ran a great race, but [Majestic Wisdom] was winter raced," jockey Todd Kabel said. "I'm not taking anything away from either of them." Trainer Mike Keogh added, "I think he can develop--he just came off the farm. He just got a little tired down the lane."

Winter Rears its Head Once More:

Faced with what may be the final winter storm of an especially harsh season, Charles Town Race Track was forced to cancel live racing Sunday due to a sizable weather system that dropped freezing rain and snow at tracks along the Eastern portion of the country.
