**LET'S GIVE 'EM SOMETHING TO TALK ABOUT**

Last time out, **Atswhatimtalknbout** (A.P. Indy) flew down the stretch and just missed, finishing second by a nose behind **Buddy Gil** (Eastern Echo) in the Mar. 16 GII San Felipe S. The \$900,000 FTFEB juvenile will have

an extra sixteenth of a mile to work with in today's GI Santa Anita Derby, but he also meets a whole new cast of characters. Trainer Bob Baffert sends out a three-horse entry in the \$750,000 event, including the only runner in the field who has already been tried at a mile and

an eighth. **Kafwain** (Cherokee Run) showed he could handle the distance when he finished a solid second in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. He finished second by a head in the GI Hollywood Futurity, only to be disqualified and placed fourth for an incident in the stretch. The dark bay kicked off his 2003 campaign with a dominating 4 1/2-length victory in the Feb. 1 GII San Vicente S. Second in the Mar. 9 GII Louisiana Derby in his latest, he lost that purse money and placing after testing positive for trace levels of clenbuterol. He is joined in the starting gate by stablemates **Domestic Dispute** (Unbridled's Song), winner of the Jan. 13 GII Santa Catalina S. and fifth in the San Felipe, and Panamanian stakes winner **Indian Express** (Indian Charlie), who makes his two-turn bow after finishing fourth in the Mar. 22 San Pedro S. "So far, everything looks good," Baffert said. "We're just trying to figure out what kind of trips they need, and whether they can get the distance will be crucial. I think we're all in the same boat--we're going to find out what we've got." He added, "Indian Express has a lot of talent. I don't know how good he is or whether I've had enough time to get him ready, but physically he looks fantastic. I'm hoping he might just shock and awe them."

**Another Derby for Ocean Terrace?**

Undefeated **Ocean Terrace** (Saint Ballado), who ran his record to three-for-three with a 1 1/2-length win over **Ministers Wild Cat** in the Mar. 8 GIII El Camino Real Derby, looks to pick up yet another Derby this afternoon. The chestnut, who brought \$700,000 as a KEESEP yearling, had Mike Smith aboard last time out. But, with Smith at Oaklawn to partner Horse of the Year Azeri in the GI Apple Blossom H., the colt will have Kent Desormeaux back in the saddle. "He knows this horse better than anybody other than myself," trainer Bob Hess Jr. said. "We're honored to have him back on." Desormeaux had opted to ride Ministers Wild Cat in the El Camino Real. That colt gets the services of jockey Victor Espinoza.

### MAKING HERSELF HEARD

**Yell** (A.P. Indy) became the fourth graded-stakes winner out of Wild Applause (Northern Dancer) when she galloped to a six-length win over **Ivanavinalot** (West Acre) in the GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream Park. She will try to give mom a second Grade I winner (following the example of older brother Eastern Echo) in today's GI

Ashland S. at Keeneland. Owned and bred by Adele Dilschneider and Claiborne Farm, the dark bay started her career with a third in a Nov. 8 maiden event at Aqueduct. She missed by a neck in her next outing, but was awarded the win when Cherokee Lite was disqualified for interference in the stretch. Yell made it two in a row with an allowance score at Gulfstream Park Jan. 16, then ran away with her stakes debut. She prepped for her Grade I bow at Keeneland Mar. 31, going a half mile in a bullet :48. But she faces a tough task in trying to hand **Lady Tak** (Mutakddim) her very first defeat.

The Florida-bred ran her record to a perfect five-for-five in her latest, beating Atlantic Ocean by 3 1/2 lengths in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 8. The diminutive miss was originally purchased by Bob Cunningham's C & W Farms, bringing \$7,500 at the 2001 Keeneland September Sale. Cunningham sold her for \$75,000 to owner William Heiligbrodt at last year's Keeneland April Sale. What did Cunningham see in the little chestnut as a yearling? "I buy all on looks," he explained. "I don't even look at the pedigree until I've seen the conformation. Lots of times I'll end up with horses that are a little bit on the smaller side. She was a very nice-looking filly." Trainer Steve Asmussen knew she was special before she ever ran. "I've never had anything that could work like her," Asmussen said.

### East Meets West...

The East Coast and Midwest contenders take on one of the best in the West in the Ashland. **Elloluv** (Gilded Time), on the board in all six career starts, races outside the state of California for the first time. After taking the GI Hollywood Starlet S. at two and the GII Santa Ynez S. in her three-year-old bow, the bay ran into the now-retired Composure in her next two outings, finishing a neck behind that one in the Feb. 9 GI Las Virgenes S. and 3/4 of a length back in second in the Mar. 8 GI Santa Anita Oaks. And you can't count out the consistent Ivanavinalot, who has six wins and two seconds from her nine starts. The dark bay bounced back from her defeat in the Davona Dale to take the Mar. 14 GII Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream Park. Trainer Kathleen O'Connell told the *Daily Racing Form* that her charge is ready for a big performance. "It's definitely her toughest venture, but she's coming into the race great and hopefully she'll handle herself well," O'Connell said.

It's back to work for Horse of the Year **Azeri**, who makes her much-anticipated return to the races as the defending champion here. The chestnut was nothing short of spectacular last season, winning eight of her nine trips to the post, culminating with her five-length win in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff Oct. 26. Despite a delay in her schedule caused by the now-resolved lawsuit involving her ownership group, the five-year-old is primed for a big season. "She seems stronger than ever," said Michael Paulson, lone trustee of the Allen Paulson Living Trust. "It's going to be an incredible year if she stays this way." Sixth to the pick in the Distaff, **Take Charge Lady** makes her four-year-old debut today. The easy winner of the Great State Challenge Distaff Dec. 7, the bay gets jockey Shane Sellers in the saddle for the first time. Last year's runner-up **Affluent** returns for another crack at Azeri, but was winless in three head-to-head matchups a year ago. She comes off a win in the Jan. 25 GI Santa Monica H.

After passing on the GI Santa Anita H. due to his high impost and the G1 Dubai World Cup due to the ongoing military activity, **Medaglia d'Oro** returns to the site of his maiden victory last Feb. 9. The highweight at 122 pounds here, he took the GI Travers S. last August before closing his sophomore ledger with a runner-up finish to Volponi in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. Owned by Edmund Gann, he overwhelmed fellow four-year-olds by seven lengths in the Feb. 1 GII Strub S. and is strictly the one to beat this afternoon.

**Danuta, Inamorato out of Ky Classics**

Godolphin announced Friday that three-year-olds **Danuta** (Sunday Silence) and **Inamorato** (Tale of the Cat) will not be pointed for the GI Kentucky Oaks and GI Kentucky Derby, respectively. They are scheduled to ship to the States today and will run later in the spring. Inamorato, an impressive winner of the Al Bastikiya Mar. 8 in his seasonal bow, endured a rough trip when third in the G2 UAE Derby last Saturday. Danuta followed her victory in the Moonshell Mile with a sharp success in the UAE Oaks Thursday evening. "We think a lot of Inamorato and Danuta, but we just felt it was going to be too difficult for them right now to go into those kind of races," Godolphin assistant trainer Tom Albertrani told *Thoroughbred Times*. "Right now, it looks unlikely that we will have anything there [at Churchill Downs] this May." Godolphin has had at least one starter in the Kentucky Derby since 1999.

**Brancusi Breezes for Blue Grass**

Michael Tabor's **Brancusi** (Deputy Commander) tuned up for the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. next Saturday at Keeneland with a six-furlong breeze in 1:14 over the Lexington oval yesterday afternoon. Jockey Tony Farina was aboard for the move. "He was very much in hand," said Farina. "He seemed real comfortable over the track. This work proved he is 100 percent recovered from his last race." Trained by Patrick Biancone, Brancusi was a very close third to Buddy Gil and Atswatimtalknabout in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 16.

**Outta Here Headed to Churchill?**

**Outta Here** (Dehere) could make his next start in the GI Kentucky Derby. The colt finished a troubled fourth in the Mar. 29 G2 UAE Derby at Nad al Sheba. "He had every right to finish last with the trip he had," trainer Bill Currin said. "[Jockey Kent Desormeaux] said there was a lot of interference and he was hit a few times. I was very disappointed not to win the race." The colt is scheduled to return to Southern California Sunday. If he recovers quickly from his Middle Eastern adventure, he will head to Churchill Downs to run for the roses.

**Tiger Held Back**

**Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat) will miss the G3 Castlemartin & La Louviere Studs Gladness S. at The Curragh Sunday, instead heading straight to the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 3. Aidan O'Brien told the *Racing Post* that he was keen to avoid a hard race in the seven-furlong event in which Johannesburg was beaten 12 months ago. "We are not going to run Hold That Tiger on Sunday and instead he will work after racing," he said of the G1 Grand Criterium winner. "We would like to have run him this weekend, but to carry a Group 1 penalty against older horses is very difficult and can leave its mark. It might not be fair to ask Hold That Tiger to do so."

White Cat had turned in three excellent performances on the turf, with no wins to show for those efforts, but that all changed yesterday with a narrow victory in Keeneland's opening day feature. Sixth in the GIII Tropical Park Derby in his turf bow Jan. 1, the chestnut was a neck second in the Jan. 26 Dave Feldman S. at Gulfstream and most recently runner-up by 1/2 length in the GIII Palm Beach S. in South Florida Feb. 21. 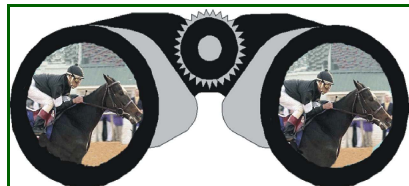

### U of K Prof Offers Caterpillar Update:

Prof. Dan Potter of the University of Kentucky, an entomologist who has been working on ways to control Eastern Tent Caterpillars, Thursday issued an update to Grayson-Jockey Club Foundation for Kentucky farms. The caterpillars came under suspicion as one of the possible causes of Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome. According to Potter, "The window for caterpillar management has just opened, and now through the next week or so is the ideal time for control actions. The options are: 1) treat infested trees with foliar spray...2) inject the trees with bidrin [Inject-a-cide B] within the next week. We found that was quite effective so long as the larvae were less than half their full size. The injection must be done by the Mauget system by a certified applicator." Potter recommended two foliar sprays--Talstar, which he said gave near 100 percent control and provided a week's residual from a single application; and Dipel, which gave approximately 75 percent control and was not effective for as long as Talstar.

### U.S. Purses Increase:

The National Thoroughbred Racing Association and Equibase have released first-quarter statistics for purses and wagering. Purses have increased by 4.3 percent from first-quarter 2002. Total wagering was down by 1.17 percent, a result attributed to the number of cancelled racing days in the first few months of the year. "Pari-mutuel wagering is showing considerable resilience, given that, overall, 92 scheduled racing days were cancelled in the first quarter due to weather," said Tim Smith, NTRA commissioner. "The figures for U.S. purses, with sustained growth over the first quarter of 2002, also are welcome and positive, especially under the circumstances." Through the first quarter, all wagering on U.S. races totalled \$3,663,328,278, compared to \$3,706,610,193 in 2002. For the same time period, U.S. purses added up to \$208,840,231, ahead of the \$200,213,290 achieved last year.

**LATEEN SAILS INTO THE PICTURE**

**Lateen Sails (GB)** (Elmaamul), winner of a Newmarket maiden last Oct. 2, took Godolphin's main trial for three-year-old colts over a mile at Nad al Sheba yesterday to stake his claim for the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 3. Held up in the rear in the early stages by jockey Frankie Dettori, the unbeaten colt quickened to the front inside the final eighth to beat **Graikos (GB)** (Rainbow Quest) by 1 3/4 lengths in a time of 1:38.17. Last year's G2 Gimcrack S. winner **Country Reel** (Danzig) was a further 1 1/4 lengths back in third. "Lateen Sails really pleased us," commented Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford. "He finished very strongly, showing a nice turn of foot. He is a possible 2000 Guineas contender at this time and it looks like he will stay further as well. He would be at the forefront of our Guineas colts." Crisford indicated that Graikos would be pointed for the G2 Dante S. and Country Reel would be dropped back to six furlongs. In the first trial, **Alajwad** (Storm Cat), a son of La Afirmed, covered the same trip in 1:38.90 when beating **Amandus** (Danehill) and **Qais** (Seeking the Gold) by 1 1/2 lengths and a short head. Of the fillies, Fantastic Light's sister **Hi Dubai (GB)** (Rahy) recorded a better time than the colts when besting early leader **Gonfilia (Ger)** (Big Shuffle) by a nose under Frankie Dettori in 1:37.79, with **Echoes in Eternity (Ire)** (Spinning World) 3/4 of a length back in third. "We are delighted with Hi Dubai, and Sheikh Maktoum will finalise a programme for her closer to the time," Crisford said. "She is a filly with stacks of potential for the summer and she will stay well." Hi Dubai holds entries in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 as well as G1 Epsom Derby June 7 and Oaks June 8.
