"We're definitely thinking Derby with him, but we have to get him back to the barn and make sure everything is all right before we can make that kind of decision,"

AZERI STARS AT OAKLAWN

Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter) spotted **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere) a two-length head start and five pounds, but still managed to run her down for a gallant head victory in the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Park. "She was standing well in the gate, then there was some commotion and she kinda tightened up and hopped out of there when the gate opened," jockey Mike Smith said. "It's a habit she had early in her career, so it didn't catch me by surprise. I was content to let the leaders go and try and save as much energy as I could for the real running. When we hit the top of the stretch, [Take Charge Lady] scooted away from them and I thought 'oh oh.' But she went after the leader the way a champion does and about three or four strides from the wire I was confident I was going to catch her." *More on the Apple Blossom, p3*

Making her first appearance outside the Golden State, **Elloluv** (Gilded Time) took on a stellar field in yesterday's GI Ashland S. at Keeneland, but proved west was best with a resounding 3 3/4-length victory. The bay bumped with **Ivanavinalot** (West Acre) at the start, recovering quickly to take the early lead. She clicked off moderate fractions and opened up on the field down the lane for her second Grade I score. "This filly has tremendous speed," trainer Craig Dollase said. "She puts herself in the race. She looked great today and she still has a lot left. She is barely even blowing. I think she has more in the tank for the [GI Kentucky Oaks, May 2]." Ivanavinalot, checked sharply at the start, raced in contention to the far turn, then faded to finish seventh and last. *More on the Ashland, p3*

Climbing His Way to the Top...

Buddy Gil did show some promise at two, following his maiden victory with a 7 1/2-length tally in the Golden Bear S. at Golden Gate Fields Nov. 24. He caught wet tracks in his next two starts and failed to hit the board, but has been perfect since switching to the barn of trainer Jeff Mullins. The bay moved to the turf for his first start under new management and captured the Feb. 23 Gill Baldwin S. by two lengths as a 26-1 outsider. He came back as a 9-1 shot in the Mar. 16 GII San Felipe S. and held on gamely to beat **Atswhatimtalknabout** (A.P. Indy) by a nose. The fourth choice at 6-1 in the Santa Anita Derby, the late Triple Crown nominee was rated in sixth as first previously undefeated **Ocean Terrace** (Saint Ballado) and then 35-1 **Indian Express** took them through solid opening splits. He closed on the leaders as they came around the far turn, grabbed a slim advantage at midstretch and gave it all he had to keep his head in front of Indian Express to the finish. "I had all the confidence in my horse, even though I didn't know we had it won until he hit the wire," Mullins said. The performance looked even more impressive when Mullins revealed that the three-year-old had missed a work since his last race. "He was supposed to work two days before his last one, but he came up lame that day," the trainer said. "He had a foot bruise in behind, so we worked on it and worked on it and finally got it right enough where he could train again. Then Gary [Stevens] worked him two mornings later and said it wasn't bothering him. He worked better than ever, so we stuck with the plan and ran him and, as you can see, it worked out great."

Stevens Surpasses Shoe...

Gary Stevens, who had been tied with Bill Shoemaker for Santa Anita Derby wins at eight, was ecstatic after picking up number nine. "When I won this race the first time [with Winning Colors in 1988], I thought it was great to win a big race like this," Stevens said. "I could never imagine winning two or three, much less nine and breaking Shoemaker's record. To win it for Jeff Mullins and [owner] Donnie McFadden, guys I've known for many years, makes it even more special."

The Favorite Falters...

Atswhatimtalknabout, the 3-2 chalk off his fast-closing second in the San Felipe, bobbled at the break and was at the back of the pack while saving ground early. He made up some real estate as they headed into the far turn, angled wide on the bend and into the stretch, but failed to mount a serious late bid and had to settle for fourth. "He made a nice little move around the turn," jockey David Flores said. "When we got to the stretch, I thought he was going to change leads and keep going, but he flattened out. I went to the stick with him. He should know what he's doing a lot better after this race." The colt still could be headed to Churchill Downs. "I'd like to go," trainer Ron Ellis said. "I'll have to check out the earnings and things like that, see what our chances of getting in are, but a mile and a quarter certainly suits him well. I think this just wasn't his day today. Maybe he worked a little too quick the other day, who knows?"

First Loss for Ocean Terrace...

Ocean Terrace was on the pace for six furlongs, but dropped out of it as they raced into the far turn, then drifted very wide into the stretch and was eased late. "I think he bled," trainer Bob Hess Jr. said. "I'm going to check him out."

Ministers Wild Cat Out With Bruised Foot...

Ministers Wild Cat (Deputy Minister) was scratched from the Santa Anita Derby after suffering a bruised right hind foot Friday. "He galloped super [Friday], but around noon he had a sore foot," trainer Neil Drysdale said. Drysdale waited until he was able to contact owner/breeders Irving and Marjorie Cowan before announcing the late defection. As for future plans, the conditioner said, "We'll see how he responds to treatment." The regally bred colt is nominated to all of next Saturday's Kentucky Derby preps and could recover in time to start in one of them, Drysdale added.

Elloluv picked up her first Grade I score as a 30-1 outsider, rolling to a four-length victory over Composure in the Dec. 14 Hollywood Starlet. She dropped back to seven furlongs for the Jan. 20 GII Santa Ynez S. and made it two in a row, but ran into Composure again in her next two appearances and came up just a little bit short. The Hollywood Starlet runner-up turned the tables with a neck decision in the Feb. 9 GI Las Virgenes S. and beat her arch rival by 3/4 of a length in the Mar. 8 GI Santa Anita Oaks. But Composure has since been retired, and the East Coast contingent could offer Elloluv little competition yesterday. The speedy filly went right to the front, shook off a mild challenge from Holiday Lady after six furlongs and drew off under only moderate urging from jockey Robby Albarado. "She broke really sharp, so I let her run a little,"

Albarado said. "I was surprised that nobody came up and challenged her. I have a feeling, though, that if somebody would have tried to run with her, she would have run away with them anyway." He added, "This race didn't take much out of her. She galloped out real nice." Lady Tak, the crowd's choice, came out of the gate on top, but was settled back off the early pace. She came with a run in the stretch, but was no match for the winner and had to settle for second. Yell (A.P. Indy) never looked comfortable while racing in midpack and couldn't mount a late bid, finishing an even fourth.

She hadn't been out since her five-length romp in the Oct. 26 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, but Azeri picked up right where she left off, successfully defending her title in the Apple Blossom with a determined late run. The chestnut suffered her first and only career defeat when running second to Summer Colony in the GII La Canada S. last February, but rebounded to roll through seven straight graded stakes wins--five them Grade I. Looking to make it eight in a row, she was off a step slowly, then settled just off the leaders through the first quarter. The reigning Horse of the Year kicked it into gear as they came around the final bend, but front-running Take Charge Lady had opened up some daylight and looked like she might have it won. Azeri would not be denied, however, closing the gap with every stride before getting her head in front as they hit the wire. "Champions overcome obstacles," trainer Laura de Seroux said. "It was her first start in a while and she didn't break well. She was under the stick a lot, like she was in the La Canada, but she won today off only four works." The runner-up was far from disgraced in her first outing since taking the Dec. 7 NTRA Great State Challenge Distaff S. at Sam Houtson. "When we straightened out in the lane, I just said to myself, 'let her come and get me,'" jockey Shane Sellers said. "I thought we had enough left to hold her off. It was a big effort off a layoff." The winner of the G1 AAMI Victoria Derby last November, Helenus returned to be fourth in the G2 Hobartville S. at Randwick Mar. 8 and most recently endured a troubled trip when unplaced in the G1 Canterbury Guineas Mar. 22. With the addition of a bar shoe to protect his near fore hoof, Helenus settled towards the rear of the 16-horse field, but loomed a threat into the stretch and came running late to score narrowly. A claim of foul lodged by the connections of Sunday Joy was dismissed and the result was allowed to stand. "It's a great relief to see him back at his best," winning trainer Leon Corstens told *Australian Associated Press*. "You really can't afford for things to go wrong when on the way to the Derby." The bay colt could make his next start in the G1 BMW Apr. 12, but his main target remains the G1 AJC Derby at Royal Randwick Apr. 19.

"He's 'King of the Hill' now," owner Jack Ingham said. "Darren Beadman gave him a great ride and he just seemed to take off and leave them effortlessly. Bring on the mile at Royal Randwick." The first three finishers will go next in the 1600-meter G1 Doncaster H. Apr. 19 at Royal Randwick.

Medaglia d'Oro has missed the board on only two occasions, running fourth in last year's GI Kentucky Derby and eighth in the GI Preakness S. The ebony colt turned his Triple Crown season around with a solid second-place finish in the GI Belmont S., then romped home to a 13 3/4-length score in the GII Jim Dandy S. He followed that effort with a half-length win in the GI Travers S. and was sent off the 5-2 favorite in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, but proved no match for longshot Volponi and had to be content with second. The four-year-old made his 2003 bow as the 2-5 choice in the Feb. 1 GII Strub S., leading gate to wire in a seven-length blowout, and was 1-10 this time. Sent right to the front, he was clicking off nearly perfect 12-second furlongs for the first three-quarters of a mile, then surged through the next two furlongs in :11.67 as he pulled away to win handily. "The race developed just about the way I figured it would, with us on the lead," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "The pace felt honest and he wasn't at all bothered by the pressure behind him. He usually wants to pull away from the rest as he comes around the final turn, but today he waited for me to ask for his best. I think that's a real good sign. I had to get into him a little through the stretch, but not much." Trainer Bobby Frankel added, "He was not really cranked up for this one, but I thought we could get away with it. He can do anything, so pace or lack of it is no big thing with him. I am happy we passed [the Dubai World Cup]. Next start is the Pimlico Special [May 16]." "Today he was really focused and really into the game. He settled nicely and was there for me when I called on him. He was really punching hard at the finish and galloped out strong." 



A year ago, **Ballingarry** prepped for the European Classics with a win in the G2 Prix Noailles. The bay tired to be sixth in the G1 Prix Lupin, but acquitted himself well when finishing second in the G1 Derby Italiano and third in the G1 Irish Derby and G1 Irish St. Leger. 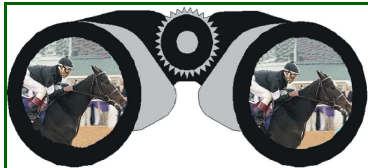

HKJC TAKING WAIT AND SEE APPROACH Officials at the Hong Kong Jockey Club are cautiously optimistic that they will be able to run the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup as scheduled Apr. 27, despite the recent outbreak of SARS in that part of the world. However, an advisory issued earlier in the week by the World Health Organization has cast some doubt over the event. "We feel the [QE II] situation changed on Wednesday with the release by the World Health Organization warning business and tourist travelers against coming to Hong Kong," HKJC Executive Director of Racing Winfried Englebrecht-Bresges told the *South China Morning Post*. "We can run the race no problem--the horses are not at risk--but our concern is with the owners and other people associated with the visiting horses. We are not under pressure to decide on our course of action right now. We will wait and see next week how things are developing."
