ARCADIA HOME FOR THIS CITY

Century City (Ire) (Danzig) enjoyed a successful European campaign, finishing second in last year's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and winning the G2 International S. at The Curragh, but the colt had been unable to duplicate that success in the United States. Until yesterday. The Irish-bred bay, with only a narrow score in the Feb. 1 Turf Paradise Breeders' Cup H. to his credit in six North American outings, stalked the pace early and pulled clear of a calvary charge in deep stretch to take yesterday's GII Arcadia H. at Santa Anita by a neck. Century City was coming off ninth-place effort in the Mar. 23 GII Explosive Bid H., but jockey Jose Valdivia Jr dismissed that effort, saying, "He absolutely hated the track in New Orleans. He never ran." Trainer Beau Greely agreed. "He's back home," Greely said. "He likes to kind of stalk a little bit and Jose rode him perfect." Century City could start next in the May 3 GI Woodford Reserve at Churchill or the June 14 GI Whittingham Memorial H. Race favorite **Ballingarry (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) moved up three wide turning for home, but never threatened and finished seventh. Trainer Laura de Seroux said the colt, off since October, needed the race and would likely start next in the May 10 Jim Murray H.

Empire Maker on the Move

Florida Derby, worked six furlongs at Hollywood Park yesterday in 1:13. The well-bred colt, expected to make his next start in Saturday's GI Wood Memorial, will ship to New York tonight.

"Everything is good with him," confirmed Hall of Fame trainer Bobby Frankel. "He did it exactly the way I wanted him to."

Frankel also sent out GII Louisiana Derby winner **Peace Rules** (Jules), expected in the Apr. 12 GI Toyota Blue Grass, to work six furlongs in 1:11.60. Frankel's GIII Swale S. winner **Midas Eyes** (Touch Gold), prepping for the

Apr. 19 GII Coolmore Lexington S., went the same distance in 1:13.20.

Storm Flag Flying Drills

Two-year-old filly champion **Storm Flag Flying** (Storm Cat) breezed a half mile over Belmont's main track yesterday in :47 1/5. The bay, off since winning the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last October, is expected to make her sophomore bow in the Apr. 18 GIII Comely. "She worked fine," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "We're on target for the Comely. She had a good winter in Florida." McGaughey would not rule out a Kentucky Oaks start for his star filly.

Wood Notes

Indy Dancer (A.P. Indy), third behind Empire Maker in the Florida Derby, worked five furlongs over Belmont Park's main track yesterday in :59 2/5. The colt, wearing blinkers, worked in company. "He always prefers someone to go with," commented Seth Benzel, assistant to trainer Todd Pletcher. "It gives him something to aim at. The rider said he was on the bridle and I loved the way he galloped out. It was exactly what we were looking for." (*Sophomore spotlight cont. p. 4*)

Third behind the subsequent stakes scorer Sign of the Wolf (GB) on his debut at Saint-Cloud in September, Super Celebre looked something special when powering away with a similar race at Maisons-Laffitte in November. Sent off the 11-10 favourite for this contest on the strength of that performance, he confirmed that impression with a fluent first stakes score under a confident Dominique Boeuf. Always travelling easily in mid-division off the steady early tempo, he was taken wide entering the straight and asked to quicken. Showing an impressive turn of acceleration, he hit the front at the furlong marker under a hand ride before being eased near the line. "I like this colt, but he won on very heavy ground last year and I didn't know how he would act on this faster surface," conditioner Elie Lellouche said. "His performance was excellent and really stamps him as a colt with Classic potential. He will go for the G1 Prix Lupin [at this track May 11] now." Posse debuted with a 13 1/2-length victory over the Keeneland strip just four days short of a year ago and a win in the GIII Bashford Manor at Churchill in July sent him to the top of the juvenile division, but he ended the season with three straight off the board finishes. Resurgent at three, the colt set a track record while winning a five-furlong allowance at Fair Grounds by 6 3/4 lengths in his 2003 bow Feb. 10, but he couldn't catch the speedy Midas Eyes when second in the Mar. 15 GIII Swale S. last time out. Favored in the field of six, the bay colt settled in behind the early leaders and moved into contention with a four-wide move into the stretch. He collared Roll Hennessy Roll in the final furlong and drew clear to the wire. "We had a great trip all the way," said winning rider Corey Lanerie. "I let him get within himself. I was actually further back than I thought I would be. I thought they were going kind of fast up front, so I just settled back in a comfortable seat and when it was time, I moved him into contention. At the end, he had his ears up and he still had a lot left." Winning trainer Steve Asmussen added, "I am glad to get him back to the stature he deserves. Wood Memorial Notes

In other Wood developments, trainer Sal Russo said yesterday there is a slight chance that **Atfirst Blush** (Rubiano), an Aqueduct allowance winner last time out, might start in the Grade I race. "The Wood might be a little tough for him at this point, but there's a chance he could run." A more likely target for the colt would be the GIII Withers on May 3. Team Valor's **Colita** (Grindstone), beaten favorite in the GIII Gotham, will not start in the Wood and is instead pointing towards the Apr. 19 Federico Tesio at Pimlico. "He was a little sore behind Thursday after a two-minute lick," said trainer Carlos Morales. "It's nothing to be worried about, just something that will force him to miss a breeze. It looks like he's doing better now."

Lion Tamer on Keeneland Worktab

GII Hutcheson S. winner **Lion Tamer** (Will's Way), most recently fourth behind New York Hero in the GII Lane's End S., breezed a half mile at Keeneland yesterday in :49.60. "He worked well," trainer Todd Pletcher commented. "We are still considering the [Apr. 12 GI] Blue Grass, but he could run in the [Apr. 19 GII] Lexington or [Apr. 12 GI] Wood Memorial." Pletcher also sent out GIII Tampa Bay Derby runner-up **Aristocat** (Tale of the Cat) at Keeneland yesterday. Preparing for the Apr. 12 GII Arkansas Derby, the colt worked four furlongs in :48.

Santa Anita Derby Wrap-Up

Buddy Gil (Eastern Echo), winner of Saturday's G1 Santa Anita Derby bled slightly in the race, despite running on Lasix. Under California Horse Racing Board rules, the gelding cannot work for 14 days after such bleeding and then can be removed from the list by a CHRB veterinarian following a five-furlong work in 1:03 or faster. "He's all heart," Jeff Mullins said of Buddy Gil, who is now unbeaten in three starts for the trainer. "At the end of the day, we'll have some kind of plan [to ship to Kentucky], but I haven't talked to the owners or anything yet. But he came out of the race good."

Atswhatimtalknbout (A.P. Indy), a disappointing fourth in the Santa Anita Derby, is expected to ship to Kentucky Wednesday, but trainer Ron Ellis will have a blood test taken today to make sure the colt is healthy. "Physically, he couldn't look any better," Ellis admitted. "It was just a bad day. He didn't run a jump and [jockey] David [Flores] said he was going up and down most of the race instead of actually levelling out. It was kind of an unusual race because three or four horses were eased, so I don't know if the track was a little different or what. But he wasn't acting the same yesterday morning. He was a little bit quieter than usual, so it might have just been a bad day for him."

Indian Express (Indian Charlie) and **Kafwain** (Cherokee Run), second and third for trainer Bob Baffert on Saturday, will both be pointed for the Kentucky Derby, but Baffert's fifth-place finisher **Domestic Dispute** (Unbridled's Song), is off the Derby trail.

Ministers Wild Cat (Deputy Minister), scratched from the Santa Anita Derby with a bruised right hind foot, is "sound, he's doing much better this morning," according to trainer Neil Drysdale. Drysdale said that no race had been picked out for the colt.

Tiger Works

Aidan O'Brien was on hand to oversee the post-racing workouts of Guineas hopefuls **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat) and **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) at The Curragh. Covering a mile with stable companion **Twentytwoandchange (Ire)** (Lure), Hold That Tiger showed his trademark acceleration at the end of the gallop under Michael Kinane. "Mick was very happy with him," O'Brien reported of the G1 Grand Criterium winner. "He needed to be away from home as he's a big strong colt and needs a bit more. It is hard to rule anything out or in at the moment but the G1 2000 Guineas [at Newmarket May 3] is more realistic than the G1 Kentucky Derby. He can always go to America later on." Of Listed Eyrefield S. winner Yesterday, who worked over the same strip with **In The Limelight (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), the Ballydoyle conditioner said, "If she goes to the G1 1000 Guineas [at Newmarket May 4] she will go there without a run." Kinane added, "She and Hold That Tiger have both done very well physically over the winter."

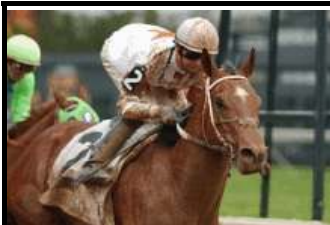
