**ANEES EUTHANIZED**

Eclipse Award winner **Anees** (Unbridled) was euthanized early Saturday morning due to complications from a broken left front pastern, it was revealed yesterday. The six-year-old had been hospitalized at Hagyard, Davidson-McGee since being injured in a paddock accident at Mill Ridge Farm Mar. 31. He was buried at Mill Ridge. The champion two-year-old of 1999, Anees captured the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile by 2 1/2 lengths. He had seven career starts, with two wins and two thirds, and earned \$699,200. The bay had covered 29 mares at the time of his injury, with 17 reported in foal.

His first foals are yearlings. "We are absolutely devastated at the loss of Anees," Mill Ridge owner Alice Chandler said. "But at the same time there is relief, too, because the injury was quite profound and we never wanted him to suffer in any way."

**Supah Blitz Possible for Kentucky Derby**

**Supah Blitz** (Mecke) could make his next start on the first Saturday in May. The colt was second behind Dynever in Saturday's Aventura S. at Gulfstream Park. "I've got to think about the Derby," trainer Manny Tortora said. "That is one of the best three-year-olds in the country that beat him [in the Aventura] and we beat the rest of the field by a lot. We have to take a shot. I should have won the Derby with his daddy and, since I bred this colt and own him, I've got to take another shot at it." Mecke was fifth in the 1995 Derby. Tortora added that he would not be averse to selling Supah Blitz for the right price. "It is getting closer to the Derby now and people get Derby fever," he said. "I had some offers for him earlier in the year. I'm going to see if somebody has more money than I have brains."

**Funny Cide Heads North**

Getting in a final workout at Palm Meadows Training Center in Florida yesterday morning Sackatoga's Stable's **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) worked a half mile in :48 flat. "I had him galloping out [five furlongs] in 1:01," said trainer Barclay Tagg. "Everthing went great. It was nice and quiet down here. He's fresh." Tagg indicated the chestnut, who finished a good third behind Peace Rules and Kafwain, respectively, in the GII Louisiana Derby, would board a van bound for New York later in the afternoon. He runs next in the GI Wood Memorial at Aqueduct Saturday.

**Other Wood Developments**

After watching **Kissin Saint** (Kissin Kris) move four panels in :49 flat Monday morning at Belmont, trainer Lisa Lewis decided to enter the allowance winner in Saturday's Wood Memorial. "He came off the track feeling good," said Lewis. "He did it nicely. [Jockey] Richie [Migliore] and I were very happy." Another horse that may attempt the Wood with limited exposure is Judson Streicher's **Atfirst Blush** (Rubiano). The Sal Russo trainee breezed a half mile in :49 2/5 yesterday morning at Belmont. "The work went great," said Russo. "We'll decide later in the week if we're running." Though the colt showed little in two allowance starts at Gulfstream, he looked very sharp notching a one-length tally in an Aqueduct allowance race Mar. 16. The runner-up in that contest, Fund of Funds, came back to be second in the GII Illinois Derby Saturday.

**Velazquez Still Behind Indy Dancer**

Wertheimer Farm's **Indy Dancer** (A.P. Indy), who prepared for the Wood with a five-furlong move in :59 2/5 over Belmont Park's main track Sunday, has retained the confidence of his regular jockey, John Velazquez. The three-year-old was third in the GI Florida Derby and fifth in the GIII Risen Star S., in his last two starts. "I haven't lost confidence in him," Velazquez said. "He's just been too far back early on in his races. He's left himself with too much to do. His effort in the Florida Derby wasn't bad. I thought he ran well." Trained by Todd Pletcher, Indy Dancer will be equipped with blinkers for the first time in the Wood. "He's talented, but he loses interest on the backstretch," continued Velazquez. "If the blinkers help get him closer up, it'll make a huge difference."

Tagano My Bach's resolve was unwavering in the latter stages as he got the best of post-time favorite Magnaten in the closing strides to assert for his second graded triumph in a month's time. The dark bay won his first graded event when taking the Mar. 9 G3 Sho Chukyo Kinen at this distance and was sent off as the third betting choice here to make it two straight. Away in good order, Tagano My Bach pressured the pacesetter Magnaten from the outside, battled with that foe down the lane and asserted boldly in the shadow of the wire. Tsurumaru Boy, near the back of the pack early, closed well to get third. The 2003 renewal of the Sankei Osaka Hai marked the first time the race was open to international competition, though no foreign-based horses competed in the race.

One of the worst things that can happen to a high-class stallion prospect is to draw a blank in his final year in training. With breeders' memories often being notoriously short, a colt's failure to win--or a failure to race very much--can quickly tarnish his glowing achievements of previous years. His predicament is then made all the more difficult by his having to compete for mares against the horses which shone on the track while he was on the sidelines.

This type of situation was perfectly illustrated towards the end of 1998, when three of Deputy Minister's Grade I-winning sons retired to stud in Kentucky. According to the International Classifications for 1997, Touch Gold was rated the best of them, his figure of 126 reflecting his Grade I wins in the Belmont S. and the Haskell Invitational. Deputy Commander was the next best, having earned a figure of 122 through his Grade I victories in the Travers S. and Super Derby, and his second-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Classic. Then came Awesome Again, winner of the Queen's Plate and the GII Jim Dandy S., who brought up the rear with a figure of 117.

The picture was very different by the end of 1998. Awesome Again had leap-frogged over his paternal half brothers, earning a rating of 130 with a string of victories which culminated in his triumph in the Breeders' Cup Classic. Touch Gold, on the other hand, disappeared from the Classifications altogether after being persistently handicapped by a sore foot which restricted him to four starts. Deputy Commander also had physical problems, including ulcers, and he failed to win in three starts before he suffered a torn suspensory, possibly in the process of finishing second under top weight in the GII Californian S. on May 31. That effort, though, was good enough to earn him a figure of 116.

Predictably, the prices set for the services of this distinguished trio were strongly influenced by their most recent efforts. Awesome Again naturally led the way at a fee of \$50,000, followed by Touch Gold on \$30,000 and Deputy Commander on \$20,000. I think it is fair to claim that Touch Gold and Deputy Commander would have started their careers at higher fees had they retired a year earlier. As it was, the classic-winning Touch Gold started at the same fee as Favorite Trick, Gentlemen and Grand Slam, while Deputy Commander was on a par with Joyeux Danseur and Souvenir Copy.

I'm pleased to say that each of these three accomplished sons of Deputy Minister has now sired at least one Graded winner in his first crop. Awesome Again, of course, is responsible for the excellent (but sidelined) Toccet. Doing even better is Touch Gold, who has made a highly encouraging start with the Graded winners Composure, Midas Eyes and Region of Merit, together with the Graded-placed Powerful Touch and Flirt With Fortune, among his 86 first-crop named foals.

Deputy Commander confirmed his potential last Saturday, when his daughter Holiday Lady finished a creditable third behind Elloluv and Lady Tak in the GI Ashland S. and his son Ten Most Wanted put himself on the Kentucky Derby trail with his decisive victory in the GII Illinois Derby. Appropriately, Ten Most Wanted is trained by Wally Dollase, who paid a sale-topping \$205,000 for Deputy Commander at Barretts' 1996 May Sale of two-year-olds. (*Pedigree Insights cont. p5*)

Deputy Commander's 87-strong first crop also contains the talented Brancusi, a close third to Buddy Gil in the GII San Felipe S. He has already had 11 three-year-old winners this year and there are probably plenty more to come.

There was always every chance that Deputy Commander's offspring would improve with time and distance. Deputy Commander himself didn't race at two--not surprisingly in view of the fact that he stands 16.2 hands--and his Grade I wins were gained over 1 1/4 miles. Also his dam, that very talented mare Anka Germania, was something of a late developer, even though she won twice as a two-year-old in France. This tough daughter of Malinowski gained her first stakes win at four, her first Graded win at five and her first Grade I win--the Sword Dancer H. over a mile and a half--at six.

Ten Most Wanted also has a measure of stamina in the bottom half of his pedigree. His dam, Wanted Again, is a member of one of only two American crops by Criminal Type. This son of Alydar was transformed after his return from France to his native USA, where he made phenomenal progress as a five-year-old. Although fast enough to win the Metropolitan H., he also defeated Sunday Silence in the Hollywood Gold Cup over 1 1/4 miles on his way to Horse of the Year honors.

Wanted Again is a half sister to another Hollywood Gold Cup winner in Cutlass Reality, who defeated Alysheba in the 1988 event. Another talented member of this family is More Than Ready, who shares the same third dam, Good Landing, as Ten Most Wanted. More Than Ready, you may recall, shared the lead entering the stretch in the 2000 Kentucky Derby before fading back into fourth. Expect Ten Most Wanted to see the distance out better than his relative.

"I really liked what I saw today, and it is the first time in my career that I have trained a filly I feel could do really well in the 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. We will have to make a decision with the owner and racing manager, but I would certainly not be against it." Niarchos Family racing manager Alan Cooper added, "Obviously, the trainer is keen to take her to Newmarket and we will listen carefully to his advice, but we also have to wait to talk to the owner before making a final decision."

## WRITERS UP

### RAISING THE GAME

by Dave Keena

Famed for his unassuming nature, trainer John Oxx was lifted into the limelight by the exploits of dual Derby and Arc winner Sinndar (Ire) in 2000. Yet despite that incredible success, the master of Currabeg Stables remains grounded. He has been around long enough to know that you are only ever as good as your horses and your owners, especially in the increasingly dynamic environment of Irish racing. "It is very, very competitive and the standard is so much higher than it was 10 years ago," he explains. "Now you need a higher-class horse to win a good race. The standard is very high and Ballydoyle is a huge operation. There has been nothing quite like it ever before on a worldwide scale and nowhere has there been a stable like it." Do not let his quiet demeanor fool you, however. Oxx is ready for any challenge, as he proved last season when his 79 winners helped yield no less than €1.75 million. "But at the same time, I haven't found that people are shying away from such strong opposition," he continued. "If anything it is making people even more determined and it's bringing up the standard of a lot of other people's horses. I think there is nothing like competition and I think other stables have upped their efforts."

Among this year's inmates to help with the cause is His Highness the Aga Khan's unbeaten colt **Alamshar (Ire)** (Key of Luck), who had the current ante-post Epsom Derby favourite Brian Boru (GB) a head behind in the G3 Beresford S. at The Curragh in October. He may follow in the esteemed steps of former Oxx hero Sinndar now by taking in the Listed Ballysax S. at Leopardstown Apr. 13, where he is likely to meet Brian Boru again. "Alamshar is a very relaxed, lazy sort of horse who wouldn't show you as much at home as he does on the track and I like it that way around," Oxx commented. "He has matured and strengthened up nicely and we might start him off in the Listed Ballysax S. [at Leopardstown Apr. 13] and take it from there. He is a nice horse, his dam stayed well and even though he is by Key of Luck, who tends to get mile or mile-and-a-quarter horses, this fellow has a very good chance of getting a mile and a half."

Among Oxx's juveniles of last year, the highest-rated in the International Classifications was **Hanabad (Ire)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), who finished fourth behind Refuse to Bend (Ire) in the G1 National S. at The Curragh in September. "He has done alright and he had a couple of little setbacks," he explained. "He is a horse that wants good ground, so we wouldn't be in a hurry with him anyway and it will be May before he runs. His best distance has yet to be established, but it may turn out that he will best at seven furlongs. What we did find out last year was that he doesn't like soft ground and he's done okay."

Others to note include four-year-old **Bowmore (Ire)** (Desert King {Ire}), who was struck into when winning the Listed Oyster S. at Galway in September. "I'd be hopeful that he will make into a nice four-year-old and his dam Eurobird (Ire) won the G1 Irish St Leger for me." **Calorando (Ire)** (Green Desert), who has recovered from a fractured pelvis, "could be a nice prospect," while four-year-old fillies **Zafaraniya (Ire)** (Doyoun {Ire}), fourth in last year's Irish Oaks; **Ridakiya (Ire)** (Desert King {Ire}); **Carallia (Ire)** (Common Grounds {GB}); and **Miss Honorine (Ire)** (Highest Honor {Fr}) "look a nice bunch."

Of the less-exposed fillies, Oxx says that the three-year-olds **Elasouna (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest), **Alliata** (Southern Halo), **Juliette (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Canouan (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) are "a number of nice fillies" who "might develop into decent types." Of the colts, Leopardstown maiden winner **Sea Dart** (Diesis {GB}) won't run until May, but heads an inexperienced group.

Ultimately, Oxx's expertise means he will be able to trade blows with Ballydoyle and co well into the 21st century. "Everybody just has to up their game in this competitive environment--it's as simple as that," he said. "I am very lucky with the clients that I have. They are all horse people and they have seen it all before and they let me get on with the job."
