ALL IN A DAY'S WORK

Dalakhani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) mastered his rivals in workmanlike fashion to maintain his unbeaten record in yesterday's G2 Prix Greffulhe at Longchamp. His wins in last year's G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp and G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud came on softer ground than he encountered here. With that in mind, jockey Christophe Soumillon was keen to reserve as much as possible early, settling the steel grey in third off a steady early pace. Asked to lengthen at the top of the straight, Dalakhani took a few strides to pick up, grabbed the lead with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and held the late thrust of **Jipapibaquigrafo** (Irish River {Fr}) to win by a half-length. His half-brother Daylami (Ire) was not asked to tackle middle distances until later in his career, but Dalakhani appears tailor-made for the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 1. Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said, "We have to decide whether he goes for the G1 Prix Lupin back here [May 11] or straight to the Jockey-Club. Elloluv and Santa Catarina On Course for Oaks

J. P. Reddam's **Elloluv** (Gilded Time), the winner of Keeneland's GI Ashland S. Apr. 5, worked a half-mile in :47 4/5 over that track Saturday as trainer Craig Dollase tightens the screws on the bay as she readies for an upcoming start in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 2.

According to Dollase, the filly will arrive at the Louisville oval Wednesday and will have one more work next weekend prior to the filly Classic. The bay, a winner of seven lifetime starts, has amassed \$774,785 in earnings. Another Oaks contender **Santa Catarina** (Unbridled) breezed seven fur-

longs after Churchill's renovation break Sunday morning. "It was a fantastic work," said trainer Bob Baffert, who won the Oaks in 1999 with Silverbulletday. "She is coming back into her own. She has always been a good filly. She sort of went South on us after the Breeders' Cup last year [third by 10 1/4 lengths], but now she's really training up a storm." The Bob and Beverly Lewis-owned filly has won two of six lifetime starts, including a five-length romp last time out in a mile optional claimer at Santa Anita Mar. 12 and has earned \$336,180.

Brancusi Set for Churchill Downs

Michael Tabor's **Brancusi** (Deputy Commander), who ran a courageous second behind Peace Rules in last Saturday's GI Blue Grass S., drilled five furlongs in :59 at Keeneland Sunday for trainer Patrick Biancone. Regular rider Tony Farina was aboard. According to Biancone, he will send Brancusi to Churchill for a Friday morning work before returning the colt to Keeneland, where the dark bay will remain until a day prior to the three-year-old Classic.

All Systems Go For Scrimshaw

According to trainer D. Wayne Lukas, Saturday's GI Coolmore Lexington S. victor **Scrimshaw** (Gulch) came away from his three-length score in good order as the Hall of Fame conditioner eyes a possible start in the May 3 Kentucky Derby. "He came out of the race excellent," commented Lukas. "We were back here [Churchill Downs] at 8:00 last night and this morning, he was rolling around in the sandpit [behind barn 42]." Lukas said the Bob and Beverly Lewis-owned colt will return to the track Wednesday.

Champali to Derby Trial

Grade III winner **Champali** (Glitterman), who won the John Battaglia S. at Turfway Mar. 1 before a third-place finish in the GI Lane's End S. over the same track three weeks later, will make his next start in the GIII Derby Trial at Churchill Downs, according to trainer Greg Foley. Originally slated for Saturday's GII Lexington S., the bay was scratched following a sub-par workout earlier in the week.

Defending Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter), partnered by regular rider Mike Smith, showed that she is no worse for wear after a gusty score in the GI Apple Blossom H. Apr. 5 with a sharp half-mile work in :46 1/5 Saturday at San Luis Rey Downs. The five-year-old mare registered the fastest of 15 works at the distance. The chestnut will make her next start in either the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H. at Churchill Downs May 2 or the GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood Park May 24.

Midas Eyes Readies for Derby Trial

Midas Eyes (Touch Gold), a runaway winner in the GIII Swale S. at Gulfstream Park Mar. 15, breezed six panels in 1:12 4/5 at Churchills Downs Saturday as trainer Bobby Frankel prepares the sophomore for an upcoming start in Saturday's GIII Derby Trial S. The bay was forced to bypass Saturday's GII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland because of a missed workout caused by an off track at Hollywood Park Apr. 13.

Grade I Winner Awesome Humor Works

GI Spinaway S. victress **Awesome Humor** (Distorted Humor), who was sidelined following of knee surgery last fall, breezed a half-mile in :47 3/5 at Churchill Downs Saturday. A perfect four-for-four, the Winstar-owned filly may make her next start in the GI Acorn S. at Belmont June 6.

Passinetti, the winner of the Listed Derby de l'Ouest at Lions d'Angers at three, found the competition too tough in the 1999 edition of the nine-furlong GI Hollywood Derby, his final start for trainer Niall O'Callaghan, before rounding out the season with a solid third against allowance foes at Santa Anita in December. On the sidelines until a credible third in a mile allowance event over this track Feb. 16 of this year, the gelding finally scored a win, his first in over three years, in a nine-furlong optional claiming event here Mar. 19. On the heels of a flat fourth most recently in the GII Arcadia H. going nine-furlongs over this turf course Apr. 6, Passinetti was given little consideration to record his first graded victory. Content to track the early pace in fourth through 10-furlongs, the bay mounted his challenge from between horses on the final turn, took over in the final furlong and rallied under urging late for the narrow score. Clodovil emerged from this tactical affair with his unbeaten record intact after a thrilling four-way drive to the line that lit up Longchamp. Despite suffering a setback after scoring twice at Saint-Cloud as a juvenile, the grey showed he retained his ability when beating the smart Marshall (Fr) by two lengths in a conditions event at this track Apr. 6. Reserved in rear by Olivier Placais this time, he raced keenly off the steady tempo set by stable companion Shuttle Diplomacy. Making his move at the top of the straight, Placais was able to keep Michael Kinane boxed in aboard the smooth-traveling Tomahawk (Seattle Slew). That proved decisive as he sprinted in pursuit of the long-time leader, flashing past that colt and Snipewalk in the final strides. Tomahawk, who was breathing down the winner's neck, closed rapidly for fourth. Commenting on the winner, the Lagardere Family's racing manager Roland de Longevialle said, "He is a nice colt and proves that every time. He had done it well last time and won in excellent style again today. He will go for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains [French 2000 Guineas]." In a replay of the outcome of the Listed Prix la Camargo at Saint-Cloud Mar. 25, the Sheikh Mohammed colorbearer led home stable companion Fidelio's Miracle and Welcome Millenium to book her place in the line-up for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas). Positioned in a stalking second throughout, she took a lead from Etoile Montante until quickening past that rival with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and gamely holding her advantage in the drive to the line. "She is getting better with racing," said Diana Cooper, representing Sheikh Mohammed. "Last year, she had a little difficulty in her head, but she is now learning what racing is all about. We also have Campsie Fells (UAE) in the Pouliches, so we will have to decide which one to run or whether both will line up."
