HOME OF THE FREE AND THE BRAV

Today's G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp was robbed of some luster with the withdrawal of Hawk Wing, but the

rain has stayed away to ensure that **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) can take center stage. Now with trainer Luca Cumani in Newmarket, the bay quickly established himself as Italy's finest performer in recent years with fluent scores in last season's G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica at the Cappanelle in May and G1 Gran Premio di Milano the following month. His influence expanded outside of the domestic sphere when he finished an unlucky-in-running third

behind Aquarelliste (Fr) in the G2 Prix Foy at this track in September. After disappointing when ninth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, he bounced back to best Sarafan by a nose in the G1 Japan Cup in November. Making his first start since that score, he is still relatively lightly raced for his age, thanks to considerate campaigning by his former conditioner Luciano d'Auria, and he can continue to reap the benefit of that. Key to the form of his rivals here is the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at Longchamp. The race was won by **Execute (Fr)** (Suave Dancer) last year, but that one could do no better than sixth under a penalty in this year's edition. **Ana Marie (Fr)** (Anabaa) emerged the winner Mar. 30, beating **Fair Mix (Ire)** (Linamix {Fr}) by a short neck.

MIDAS EYES KEEPS ON TRUCKIN'

The well-oiled machine otherwise known as **Midas Eyes** (Touch Gold) registered his second consecutive graded-stakes victory, taking yesterday's GIII Derby Trial in front-running fashion. Second to the talented Super Fuse in his Aug. 3 debut at Calder, the Florida-bred broke his maiden by eight lengths two weeks later and was promptly shelved. Acquired privately by owner Edmund Gann, the bay colt was shipped cross country for his sophomore bow and simply manhandled a solid group of sprinters by 9 1/4 lengths in the GIII Swale S. at Gulfstream Mar. 15. On the lead throughout beneath Jerry Bailey on opening day at the Downs, Midas Eyes got a bit of a breather on the far turn and easily held on to defeat **Champali** (Glitterman) by a comfortable margin. "He was very professional out there today," the winning rider commented. "He really relaxed well for me today. I never hit him. I just switched the stick to my left hand at one point and shook it at him, but that was it." Trainer Bobby Frankel indicated that the next start for the winner would likely not come in the GI Preakness, but rather in the GI Met Mile at Belmont Park May 26. Sunday Joy, third in the G2 Surround S. earlier this term, swept from fourth to earn her first group success at the highest level. In doing so, she completed a unique double for her family, with her dam, Joie Denise, and her dam's half sister, Joie de Vivre (Aus) (Vain {Aus}) each accounting for a Group 1 winner on the card. Earlier on the day, Joie de Vivre's son Arlington Road (Aus) (Danehill), took the G1 All-Aged S. She also gave trainer Gai Waterhouse a Group 1 double. "This is the most satisfying thing I've done, except getting married," Waterhouse said. The winner had to overcome a pre-race setback to earn the victory. "She had a stone bruise in her hoof this week, but she's a fighter," owner Julie Singleton said. "She has always been the most perfect horse, the most beautiful horse. She is so well-bred and so beautiful, you couldn't imagine that she would not win a Group 1 race." Runner-up Shower Of Roses will get a vacation now, returning for the spring features such as the G1 Cox Plate and G1 Caulfield Cup.

Arlington Road, who enjoyed a brief career as a stable pony when trainer Gai Waterhouse decided to give him a break from racing, made his second start off the layoff a winning one here. The gelding was a Group winner twice last season. Rated off a solid early pace, the four-year-old swept past the leaders in the straight and just outfinished Dash For Cash for the victory. "We took him to Brisbane last year for the Guineas, but he just went over the top," Waterhouse said. "The wheels fell off, as he wasn't seasoned enough. But he has a lovely temperament and he's come back a lot stronger and more focused." The runner-up has been purchased by a syndicate headed by Robert Sangster and will stand the upcoming Southern Hemisphere breeding season at Collingrove Stud. A winner of nearly A\$2 million and four group races, including the G1 Cadbury Guineas and G1 Futurity S., he was sold for approximately that amount. His stud fee has not yet been announced.

Second in the GIII Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup H. over this turf last Sept. 21, Ninebanks found Southern California less hospitable, finishing seventh in the Nov. 3 Cal Cup Mile. Returned to the main track, the bay was nipped on the wire in the Nov. 29 Forty Niner H., kicked off his five-year-old campaign with a 10th-place result in the Sunshine Millions Turf at Santa Anita Jan. 25, but bounced back in his latest to get his nose down ahead of Surprise Halo (Glomar) in the GIII Golden Gate Breeders' Cup H. over a yielding turf Mar. 16. Settled in a turf saving third for the opening half mile, Ninebanks found a seam inside the tiring pacesetter l'madrifter (Slewdledo) turning for home, struck the front in upper stretch and held off Nicobar in the waning strides. Odds-on Ladies Din (Din's Dancer) swept five wide into the lane and loomed a threat, but flattened out late to finish fourth, beaten just over two lengths. Sandown's formidable hill has tamed many front-runners, but Kevin Darley ripped up the script as he powered up Desert Deer to make all in impressive fashion. Jaber Abdullah's giant chestnut ended his 2002 campaign by beating Masterful a half length in the Listed Joel S. at Newmarket in October, thereby entering many notebooks as a horse to follow at the ripe age of five. He may have been beaten by lack of peak fitness as well as a smart rival in Olden Times (GB) when finishing runner-up in the G3 Earl of Sefton S. back at that track last Wednesday. Given his head by Darley from the gate in this contest, he surged into a clear lead, setting furiously fast fractions. He never looked in danger of coming back to his rivals as he began the drive up the straight, maintaining a relentless gallop to the line. Conditioner Mark Johnston, who has his sights set on the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury May 17, said, "He has big feet, he's a heavy horse and he likes firm ground and those things don't really go together. He's always been a horse that has been highly rated and talked about, but there have been endless niggly little problems. [Joe Mercer, racing manager to Jaber Abdullah] has always had the Lockinge as the target and that is still the aim." The legend of Bluesthestandard continues to grow, as the Georgia-bred ran his winning streak to five in the Texas Mile. Claimed by current connections for \$50,000 out of a 5 1/2-length victory at Santa Anita Dec. 31, the gelding negotiated a class hike with aplomb, taking an optional claimer by four lengths in Arcadia Feb. 17. Stretched out to two turns for his next, the bay wired a group of \$100,000 optional claimers going a mile-and-sixteenth Mar. 12 and most recently registered his first graded-stakes success with a two-length victory over Kona Gold, among others, in the Gil Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 29. Venturing outside of the Golden State for the first time and favored to continue his skein, Bluesthestandard tracked pacesetting Compendium from second through easy fractions, turned up the heat on that rival at the quarter pole and accelerated away to win by open lengths.

He has now banked in excess of \$315,000 since the claim. "He just thinks he's supposed to win," said winning conditioner Ted H. West. "He doesn't care who he runs against. Kona Gold, Bonapaw or all of these horses today--he just thinks he that much better than them." The Lone Star faithful will likely get to play the 'Blues' one more time for the GIII Lone Star H. on Memorial Day. [Click here for the brisnet.com chart.](#)

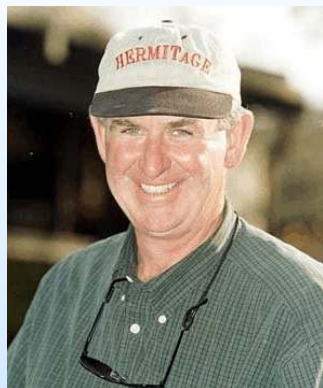

Going for the hat trick here, the gray filly tucked in at the rail as longshot Jaramar Rain cut out the running, drove through an opening on the inside as they straightened for home and drew clear. "I rode a race earlier and it seemed like the rail was a little tiring," jockey Rene Douglas said. "I was concerned, but I had no choice. I was inside in contention early and when I asked her, she responded." Added Amy Dollase, daughter of trainer Wally Dollase, "We've always done well with her wherever she travels...she did what we expected and I'm very happy with her race."

The defending champion of this event, Wake At Noon won the GIII Highlander H. Sept. 29, earning his way into the Breeders' Cup Sprint, but was bumped at the start of that Oct. 26 event and finished 12th. A disappointing third in the Nov. 30 Kennedy Road S. at Woodbine sent the chestnut to the sidelines for the winter and he returned to rally late into fourth behind Krz Ruckus (Bold Ruckus) in the five-furlong Briartic S. Mar. 22. Stretching out to perhaps his best distance for this, the homebred entire dueled for the early lead from between rivals, poked a head in front leaving the three-eighths pole and drew clear down the stretch for an easy victory. "We did a few different things," winning trainer Abraham Katryan explained. "We changed his equipment and it paid off today. 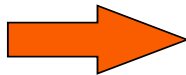

Domestic Dispute Sold, Will Start in Derby

Domestic Dispute (Unbridled's Song), most recently third behind **Scrimshaw** (Gulch) in the GII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland Apr. 19, has been sold to California-based owners David Bienstock and Chuck Winner, who intend on starting the chestnut in the Derby. Previously trained by Bob Baffert on behalf of owner/breeder Gary Garber, the colt has been turned over to Paddy Gallagher. "We've been looking at the horse for quite a while," Winner told *Daily Racing Form*. "It's not as late a deal as it may seem." Domestic Dispute has won two of his 10 career starts, including a victory over Scrimshaw in the GII Santa Catalina S. in January. His lone start at Churchill Downs resulted in a ninth-place finish in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. last November. "They're buying a good horse," Baffert told the *Form*. "They want to run in the race. The horse has a lot of residual value." Alex Solis will ride on Saturday.

Brancusi Breezes at Keeneland

Brancusi (Deputy Commander), second to **Peace Rules** (Jules) in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 12, worked a mile over the Keeneland turf course "in about 1:44," trainer Patrick Biancone said. "Grass wasn't my preference, but the dirt track was too slippery," the Frenchman said, referring to Keeneland's muddy main track. "I had him stretch out a bit in the lane. He was breezing good. It was soft ground."

Lukas Postpones Work For 'Shine'

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas opted not to work Ken and Sarah Ramsey's **Ten Cents A Shine** (Devil His Due) yesterday morning as originally planned and will instead wait for this morning. "Because of all the rain [Friday] I decided to wait and hope to get a better track [Sunday]," the conditioner explained. "I was surprised how good the track was this morning and I probably could have gone." The work is likely to determine the Derby status for the colt, who was a lackluster eighth in the Blue Grass in his last start. "Right now we are 50-50 to run," the conditioner commented, but hastened to add, "This horse is doing great right now."

Elloluv Tunes Up For Oaks

John Paul Reddam's **Elloluv** (Gilded Time), pre-race favorite for Friday's GI Kentucky Oaks, turned in her first official work over the Churchill Downs main track yesterday, going an easy six furlongs in 1:13 2/5 beneath Robby Albarado, who has the mount for the Oaks. "That's perfect," said trainer Craig Dollase. "It was just a maintenance drill and she came out of it fine. She's small, petite, but she trains like a colt. She's aggressive." The bay filly will now just gallop up to the Oaks.
