WORLD SERIES 2003 GETS OFF THE MARK

Eishin Preston (Green Dancer) charged from midpack to successfully defend his title in the first leg of the 2003 World Series Racing Championship, the G1

Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin yesterday. The Japanese invader was scoring his third international Group 1 in Hong Kong after taking the G1 Hong Kong Mile in 2001 and last year's edition of this event.

Eighth in the G1 Tenno Sho at Nakayama last October, the six-year-old filled the runner-up spot for a second consecutive year in the G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto the following month. Well backed at 8-1 for the G1 Hong Kong Cup over course and distance Dec. 15, the bay was fifth, beaten 1 1/4 lengths by **Precision (Fr)** (Anabaa), but was said to be unsuited by the dirt when last of 16 in the G1 February S. Feb. 23. Breaking from the inside here, Eishin Preston was able to get a good position along the inside as the leaders set dawdling fractions. German raider **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}), a bit rank while racing with that early pace, hit the front at the 200-meter mark, but the favorite, guided out for a clear run in the stretch, charged down the center of the track and drew clear. G1 Hong Kong Derby heroine **Elegant Fashion (Aus)** (Danewin {Aus}) raced three wide for much of the journey, but could not match strides late as Eishin Preston strode home a 1 3/4-length winner. "My horse was in good condition, so I knew if I gave him a good ride, I could win," commented jockey Yuichi Fukunaga. "My horse got a clean break and he was very relaxed and answered me very smoothly when I asked him for his effort." Trainer Shuji Kitahashi, referring to Hong Kong's recent troubles with the SARS outbreak, added, "I am very happy to win during such a hard time for Hong Kong. I was very impressed with the horse's performance and the jockey gave him the best of rides." Owner Toyomitsu Hirai expressed interest in winning the World Series Racing Championship, and said Eishin Preston could return to Sha Tin for his career finale in the International Races in December. *Audemars Piguet QEII Cup chart, links, p3*

IN THE MIX

Fair Mix (Ire) (Linamix {Fr}), claimed out of the Andre Fabre stable by Marcel Rolland at three, showed he can mix it with the big boys with an authoritative score in yesterday's G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp. Sent off at 4-1, the grey enjoyed a stalking role off respectable fractions, quickened to the front at the quarter-mile marker and asserted from the luckless **Execute (Fr)** (Suave Dancer) and **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King), who appeared to struggle in the rain-softened conditions. Rolland blessed that overnight rain afterwards. "He is definitely better on soft so the rain was a great help to him," he said. Fair Mix's rise has been meteoric since last June, when he was seventh in the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly. After taking the Listed Prix de Reux at Deauville in early August, he returned at the end of the month to finish third in the G3 Grand Prix de Deauville. His two-length defeat of Jim and Tonic (Fr) in the G3 La Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte in September was followed by a respectable eighth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. There were no fireworks on his return, a fifth behind Aquarelliste (Fr) in the G3 Prix Exbury Mar. 8, but he shaped better when a short-neck runner-up in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt Mar. 30. Rolland has not committed to his next start. Frankel's Derby Duo Works

Trainer Bobby Frankel sent both of his Kentucky Derby hopefuls out to work over the Churchill Downs track yesterday morning. GI Toyota Blue Grass S. winner **Peace Rules** (Jules) drilled six furlongs in 1:14 1/5 under exercise rider Mitsu Nakauchida. "He went off a little fast and came home a little slow," Frankel said of the work. "I think he did five furlongs in around a minute, then only went in :14 for the last part. But it's OK. It isn't anything I can't adjust for." Likely Derby favorite **Empire Maker** (Unbridled), working in company with stakes winner Requete, went six furlongs in 1:12 3/5. Clockers caught the colt in fractions of :24 1/5, :35 3/5, :47 3/5 and :59 3/5. "This was a good work by a good horse," Frankel commented. "It was what I wanted. I just hope I didn't knock that other horse [Requete] out for his race [the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic]." Explaining his different training strategies, Frankel said, "Peace Rules is an aggressive worker and Empire Maker is not. That's why I can work the one alone and the other needs company. They are two different kinds of horses."

Ten Cents a Shine Works

Kentucky Derby outsider **Ten Cents a Shine** (Devil His Due), eighth in the GI Toyota Blue Grass, worked five furlongs yesterday at Churchill Downs in :59 1/5. Calvin Borel was aboard for the workout and takes off **Lone Star Sky** (Conquistador Cielo) to ride the D. Wayne Lukas trainee Saturday. "He is not a genuine work horse, but he is getting better at it," Lukas said after yesterday's drill. "At least now he throws up some decent numbers. He is starting to get more aggressive. He finished up well. They went slow enough early that he was able to finish and that is all that I wanted to see."

Camp Atswhatimtalknbout Happy With Work

Connections of GI San Felipe S. runner-up **Atswhatimtalknbout** (A.P. Indy) gained added confidence after their colt worked five furlongs in company with stablemate Carthage yesterday at Churchill Downs in :59 2/5. Jockey David Flores, in the irons for the work, returned from the track all smiles. "He handled this track so much better than Santa Anita," Flores commented. "He likes it. I could feel it right away when he broke off at the pole. I'm feeling good [about him]. I've got that feeling. And he's hardly blowing. This was a very good work." Atswhatimtalknbout was wearing blinkers for yesterday's work. "David said that when he went to that other horse, he never even looked at him," trainer Ron Ellis said, while commenting on the effectiveness of the newly added blinkers. "That's a first for him. He's usually turning his head when he's next to other horses. But today he was all business. David was very encouraged by the work and, of course, that makes me very happy."

Senor Swinger on Track

Trainer Bob Baffert's **Senor Swinger** (El Prado {Ire}), still considered a possible Derby starter, breezed five furlongs yesterday at Churchill Downs in 1:00 3/5. The colt, fifth in the GI Wood Memorial, may instead start in Friday's GIII Crown Royal American Turf. "He's ready for turf or dirt," Baffert said yesterday. "I'm still leaning toward the turf race and then maybe running him back on dirt in the Preakness. I've got a couple of days to decide." Baffert also trains Derby hopefuls **Kafwain** (Cherokee Run) and **Indian Express** (Indian Charlie).

O'Brien Ponders Two-Pronged Attack

Aidan O'Brien is considering sending Tomahawk (Seattle Slew) to Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket alongside Hold That Tiger (Storm Cat), it was revealed yesterday. Last year's G1 Dewhurst S. runner-up had been expected to wait until the following Sunday for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) at Longchamp, but the Ballydoyle conditioner has not ruled out a tilt at the Newmarket Classic. "It is so far, so good with Hold That Tiger," he said. "It is possible we could run more than one in the race, maybe Tomahawk, but we won't decide until Wednesday, after they have worked on Tuesday." O'Brien also confirmed that Yesterday (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) will run in Sunday's fillies' Classic if Newmarket provide "safe ground." *Classic Corner cont. p. 6*

Electronic Unicorn capped a memorable day for trainer John Size with an easy win in the Champions Mile. Second in the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 15, the dark bay bounced back to win the G1 Stewards' Cup Jan. 19 by 3 3/4 lengths and continued his dominance over local milers with yet another facile score in the G2 Chairman's Trophy Mar. 23. Aiming for three straight here, jockey Robbie Fradd took hold of the Unicorn as soon as the gates opened and let the seven-year-old amble along near the back of the pack as they went a slow pace up front. He gained ground on the outside approaching the stretch, glided to the front approaching the eighth pole and was gathered up late as much the best. Meridian Star, who tracked the eventual winner's every move from just behind that one, got his nose down on the line to snatch second while no match for Electronic Unicorn. Grand Delight held off a furious rally from Cape of Good Hope to win the Chairman's Sprint Prize, completing a sweep of Hong Kong's Champion Sprint Series, and earning a bonus of HK\$2 million for the accomplishment. A Group 1 winner in his native Australia, the bay won the G3 Chinese Club Challenge Cup Jan. 1 before winning the first leg of the Sprint series, the G1 Bauhinia Sprint Trophy, by a length over Firebolt. He bested that foe again by 3/4 of a length in the G1 Centenary Sprint Cup Mar. 23 and was favored to remain unbeaten in 2003. Drawn widest of all, the gelding showed good early speed and laid close to the pace while racing three wide to the far turn. Classics rarely go to script, but this one was on the button as Le Vie Dei Colori made no mistake under Dario Vargiu to remain unbeaten in his home country. Held up in rear throughout the early stages of this contest, he was delivered wide in the straight by his confident jockey and quickened decisively at the quarter-mile marker to put his seal on the race. Frankie Dettori attempted to make a fist of it on Royal Dignitary, but Vargiu's mount had too many guns, powering clear for an emphatic score. Le Vie Dei Colori boasted an impressive portfolio at two, when his scores included the G3 Premio Primi Passi in Milan in June and G3 Prix la Rochette at Longchamp in September. Only Hold That Tiger, current hot favourite for the G1 2000 Guineas, has beaten him when coming from out of the clouds to rob him of the G1 Grand Criterium by a half-length at Longchamp in October. Connections will now run him in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) at that track May 11. Golden Nepi led home a domestic one-two-three in impressive fashion to complete a Classic double for jockey Dario Vargiu. Always prominent, she collared the long-time leader Buy The Sport (Devil's Bag) in the middle of the track with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before delivering a devastating turn of acceleration to leave her rivals trailing. Campaigned over sprint distances at two, Golden Nepi more than met her match when beaten five lengths by the smart Pleasure Place (Ire) in the five-furlong Listed Premio Divino Amore at this track in October. She was closer to that rival when beaten only 1 1/2 lengths on her return here in a conditions race over six furlongs. On her two previous starts over course and distance she had suggested that the step up in trip suited, finishing third behind Kiralik in a conditions race Apr. 1 before winning the Listed Premio Torricola Apr. 13. She will now be aimed at the G1 Oaks d'Italia in Milan May 18. She did that one day at Santa Anita by herself. And she looks superb. Her coat was glistening and shining and she just looked fit enough."
