### AN IMPRESSIVE SHOW OF FORCE

TDN "Dark Horse" **Vespone (Ire)** (Llandaff) rode the golden highway to his first stakes score yesterday in the G3 Prix La Force at Saint-Cloud, France, suggesting that he will be a major factor when he comes back to this track for the G1 Prix Jean Prat June 1. After an impressive conditions score at Saint-Cloud Mar. 20, he was far from disgraced when finishing runner-up to the speedy Mister Charm (Fr) in the Listed Prix Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 7. Relishing this step up in trip, but not the stop-start pace, he raced keenly under Christophe-Patrice Lemaire in third before quickening impressively through a gap on the inner to lead with a furlong remaining. His turn of acceleration proved decisive there as Christophe Soumillon struggled to make inroads on the market leader Vadalix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}). "I like this horse and last time in the Prix Djebel the trip was too short for him," commented winning trainer Nicolas Clement. "I think it was a very good performance considering he was rather keen during the race."

#### **Achy Back for Ten Most Wanted**

GII Illinois Derby winner **Ten Most Wanted** (Deputy Commander) came out of his ninth-place finish in Saturday's Kentucky Derby with a sore back, according to *The Blood-Horse*. Trainer Wally Dollase reported the colt "threw his back out" during the race and will miss at least several days of training after being treated by a chiropractor. "[The colt's back] was about a half an inch out of alignment," Dollase said. "We think he might have done it coming out of the gate." Ten Most Wanted was bumped by Scrimshaw leaving the gate in the Derby.

#### **Norse to Epsom**

David Elsworth may supplement **Norse Dancer (Ire)** (Halling) for the G1 Epsom Derby June 7, it was revealed yesterday. After his third placing behind Refuse To Bend (Ire) in Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, connections will step the colt up in trip for the G2 Dante S. at York next Wednesday. "It was a question of whether we kept him to a mile and went for the Irish Guineas or tried further at York. If he pleases us, he could be supplemented into the Derby," Elsworth told *PA Sport* yesterday.

Hishi Miracle, who won the G1 Kikuka Sho last October, finished a disappointing 11th in the G1 Grand Prix Arima Kinen in December before finishing 12th in the G2 Hanshin Diashoten in his 2003 debut. Seventh in the G2 Osaka Hai last time out, Hishi Miracle went off a 16-1 longshot to collect his first win in over seven months. Breaking from post 11 in the 18-horse field, the grey lingered near the back of the pack early, closed quickly in midstretch and took over from Sunrise Jaeger in the final strides for the narrow score. Zenno Rob Roy broke his maiden in February before finishing in the show spot next time in the Sumire Sho in March. In these days when most of the major breeding ventures have broodmare bands numbering well over 200, the Moyglare Stud Farm of Mr. and Mrs. Walter Haefner could almost be described as a small-time operation. The farm's studbook for 1999 listed only 48 mares, with that total rising to 57 this year.

Of course, anyone who closely follows international racing will know that there has been nothing small-time about the racecourse success enjoyed by Moyglare's graduates, especially over the last 18 months. One of the stud's **Danehill** fillies, the Group 2 winner Irresistible Jewel, did so well last year that she was invited to contest the Japan Cup, while another, Dress To Thrill, followed up a sparkling European campaign with a tremendous victory in the GI Matriarch S.

Over in Australia, the Moyglare-bred Media Puzzle (by Theatrical) decisively won that country's most sought-after prize, the Melbourne Cup, and Refuse To Bend, Media Puzzle's half brother by Sadler's Wells, showed tremendous potential in winning the G1 Aga Khan Studs National S. on only his second start. Now Refuse To Bend has fulfilled that promise, improving his record to four wins from as many starts with his victory in the Sagitta 2000 Guineas.

It is well worth pointing out that Moyglare owes its recent success to using high-priced proven stallions who regularly sire an impressive percentage of stakes winners. This year the farm is using stallions in Ireland, Britain, France and the U.S. (where **Kingmambo**, **Danzig**, **Gulch**, **Thunder Gulch**, **Smart Strike**, Theatrical, Diesis and **Giant's Causeway** are the chosen stallions). Moyglare's quest for top quality (and possibly some outcross bloodlines) has also extended the search to Germany, where mares are visiting Monsun, Acatenango and Big Shuffle.

Not surprisingly, Moyglare has four mares visiting Danehill, including Refuse To Bend's sister Ripple of Pride (a winner over 1 1/2 miles). Refuse To Bend's dam, Market Slide, is one of four mares booked to Sadler's Wells and Moyglare is also using Sadler's Wells's top sons **Galileo**, **Montjeu**, Barathea and In The Wings, plus his grandson Singspiel. With eight daughters of Sadler's Wells among the 57 broodmares, it is obvious that the Haefners and their manager Stan Cosgrove are great admirers of the perennial champion sire.

For a horse who won the Irish 2000 Guineas over a mile and never won beyond 1 1/4 miles, Sadler's Wells has proved a surprisingly strong influence for stamina, with his mature stock establishing an average winning distance of 11.1 furlongs in Britain and Ireland. That doesn't mean, though, that he can't get top-notch juveniles--Refuse To Bend was one of his three Group 1-winning two-year-olds last year--or horses which are highly effective over a mile. Refuse To Bend follows Entrepreneur and King of Kings as Sadler's Wells' third winner of the 2000 Guineas and the Coolmore king has also sired a winner of the 1000 Guineas and two of each of the Guineas races in Ireland.

Plenty has been written about Sadler's Wells' fruitful relationship with mares from the Mill Reef line, to the extent that this has possibly drawn attention away from his very good achievements with several mares from the Raise a Native male line. King's Theatre, a major winner at two and three, is out of a mare by Raise a Native's son Princely Native, while Exclusive Native is the broodmare sire of Entrepreneur and the Oaks second Dance A Dream. *Caulfield cont. p4*

Sadler's Wells' matings with mares by Mr. Prospector have so far yielded nothing more important than a pair of Group 3 winners, but it has been a different story with mares by some of his sons. **Miswaki** ranks as the broodmare sire of the Group 1 winners Galileo, Black Sam Bellamy and Johann Quatz, and now a daughter of Gulch has produced Refuse To Bend. Incidentally, it was a mating between Sadler's Wells and a daughter of Fappiano which produced the dam of Moyglare's Irresistible Jewel.

I suspect that it is more than just coincidence that Sadler's Wells owes two of his three winners of the 2000 Guineas to mares from the Raise a Native line and this could be one of the best ways to bring out some speed and precocity in Sadler's Wells' stock.

Refuse To Bend's trainer Dermot Weld never made a secret of his fears that the Guineas mile might prove on the short side, but there is no shortage of speed in the bottom half of the colt's pedigree. Refuse To Bend's broodmare sire Gulch was the best sprinter in the U.S. in 1988, and the colt's dam, Market Slide, never tackled more than seven furlongs during her time in Ireland, where she won the valuable Scurry Handicap over 6½ furlongs. She was third in the GIII First Lady H. over six furlongs as a five-year-old after returning to the U.S. So Market Slide possessed plenty of pace, even though her son Media Puzzle stays very well.

Market Slide ought to have been effective at up to a mile and an eighth, because both Gulch and her dam Grenzen enjoyed graded success over that distance. Grenzen showed a lot of ability in each of her three seasons on the track. In addition to becoming a graded winner on dirt and turf, she earned a rating of 113 on the Experimental Free Handicap at two prior to receiving *Blood-Horse* Free Handicap assessments of 122 at three and 123 at four. Again, she possessed plenty of speed--enough to equal the six-furlong track record at Santa Anita and to win the GIII Santa Ynez S. and the GII Santa Monica H. over seven furlongs.

As a daughter of Grenfall and a Cyclotron mare, Grenzen was hardly fashionably bred and she produced only one stakes winner from 13 foals for Moyglare. However, that stakes winner was Twilight Agenda, who was transformed from just a talented miler on turf in Ireland into a winner of over \$2,000,000, mainly on dirt, in the U.S. Grenzen's Alleged filly Irish Edition also underlined this family's capacity to excel on dirt when her Be My Guest colt Go And Go won the Belmont S. by more than eight lengths.

As a mile and a half should be within Refuse To Bend's range, he has a good chance of becoming the first 2000 Guineas winner since Nashwan to go on to success in the Derby. What happens afterwards could be very interesting because his connections love to challenge for the top international prizes and the colt's pedigree suggests he could well be effective on dirt.

In its heyday in the 1980s, this Epsom Derby trial was graced by blue riband heroes Henbit and Shergar (GB) as well as Law Society, Unfuwain and Old Vic (GB). Although it has since lost much of its lustre, it usually throws up a useful winner such as Armiger (GB), Broadway Flyer, Luso (GB), Millenary (GB) and Mr Combustible (Ire). Chester specialist Barry Hills, who saddled the latter to success 12 months ago, is represented by **Risk Taker**, from the family of Reams of Verse, Elmaamul and Zafonic. The colt took a Newmarket maiden by a staggering 18 lengths last time Apr. 15. He lacks an Epsom Derby entry, but **Cruzspiel**, who steps up off a Leopardstown maiden score Apr. 13, and last year's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud runner-up **Summerland**, who was sixth in the G3 Classic Trial at Sandown Apr. 25, are bidding to book their places in the line-up for that Classic June 7.

**THE BEST WON SAYS FALLON**

Kieren Fallon yesterday jumped to the defence of Sunday's G1 1000 Guineas winner **Russian Rhythm** (Kingmambo) as the post-race debate raged surrounding the luckless runner-up **Six Perfections (Fr)** (Celtic Swing {GB}). After the Sir Michael Stoute-trained filly had found the gaps that evaded the French raider under Thierry Thulliez to take the Newmarket Classic, Fallon was quick to scotch the theory that the best horse had finished second. "She's done it really well and got lucky with all the splits she got," the champion jockey said yesterday. "It was unfortunate for the French boy [Thulliez] and things didn't go his way, but I still think the best filly won on the day. The sectionals proved in the last furlong she was going the quickest." Fallon also played down the pre-race doubts surrounding the filly's well being. "I don't think there was any doubt as such that she'd be in the first four, but we thought it was a very good Guineas," he said. "As it was a hot contest and that's why she was such a big price. Everyone had seen the way she worked on Racecourse Side so there was nothing untoward with her work which was pretty good. The only place where she didn't work well was on the Limekilns gallop." Meanwhile, owners Cheveley Park Stud remained non-committal as to where the filly would appear next. "I believe she's fine this morning," Racing Manager Chris Richardson told *PA Sport* yesterday. "I saw Sir Michael on the gallops and he said she has come out of the race well. I know that there was a lot said before hand, but at the end of the day we were very hopeful she would participate and to win our first Classic is amazing." Plans will be discussed with owners David and Patricia Thompson mid-week, Richardson added.
