A STAR IN THE MAKING? Dynever (Dynaformer), one of the most highly regarded three-year-olds in the nation, will face 12 rivals when he makes his graded-stakes debut in Saturday's \$500,000 GIII Lone Star Derby. Owned by Catherine Wills and Peter Karches, the dark bay aired in his first try at a route Mar. 8 at Gulfstream, then kicked away impressively in winning the Aventura S. at the same track Apr. 5. "Nobody was surprised, because we really had big, big hopes on him," said Arnaud Delacour, assistant to trainer Christophe Clement. "Even the first time he ran, I know he got beat, but it was six furlongs and

he was not that sharp. He just made a huge move and came back like it was very easy." Clement elected to bring the colt to Lone Star in order to have four weeks before the GI Belmont S. June 8.

LIDO PALACE RETIRED Multimillionaire and Chilean champion Lido Palace (Chi) (Rich Man's Gold--Sonada {Chi}, by Quick Decision) has been retired due to a wrenched ankle. Now six, the chestnut had not raced since winning the GII Clark H. Nov. 29. The grandson of Forty Niner was Horse of the Year in Chile, winning four Group 1 races in his native land, before being purchased by Amerman Racing Stables. After finishing third in the G3 UAE Derby in 2001, he came to the U.S. and won both the GI Whitney H. and the GI Woodward S. for trainer Bobby Frankel later that year. He added another victory in the Woodward in 2002 and heads into retirement with a career record of 23-11-7-2 and earnings of \$2,705,865. Lido Palace is half brother to Chilean champion Cremcaramel (Chi) (Roy) and to MG1SP Molto Vivace (Chi) (Roy). Stud plans have not yet been determined. "He's done a lot for us and we decided to get on with his second career," John Amerman told *The Blood-Horse*. "We have offers to stand him in Chile, but I would like to place him in Kentucky or Florida. We're assessing alternatives."

JULES DEAD Nine-year-old Jules (Forty Niner--Bonita Francita, by Devil's Bag) sire of Kentucky Derby third-place finisher Peace Rules, died yesterday morning at Haras Santa Maria de Araras in Brazil after suffering from laminitis and colic, according to Dr. Eduardo Vega, a veterinarian who had attended to him. "He had had laminitis for three months and was lying [down] and had really bad colic," said Vega. "It's really a shame." After breaking his maiden by 14 lengths at Belmont, Jules won the GIII Nashua S. before ending his juvenile campaign with a third in the GII Remsen S. At three, he won an allowance race and the Long Branch S. at Monmouth before he injured during a third-place finish in the Housebuster S. Retired to Bridlewood Farm in Ocala, Florida, Jules took an impressive pedigree to stud. A four-time winner herself, Bonita Francita was 3/4-sister to Coup de Folie (by Halo), a Group winner in France who at the time of Jules' retirement had already produced four group winners, headed by French champion juveniles Machiavellian and Coup de Genie, both of whom were by Jules' grandsire Mr. Prospector. Peace Rules was one of 10 stakes winners sired by Jules, who was also represented by Brazilian Group 1 winner Must Be Flying (Brz).

Just four days after stable star Russian Rhythm was allowed to win the 1000 Guineas at a massive 12-1, another Sir Michael Stoute representative Kris Kin provided a sting in the tail for those that ignored his credentials. Kieren Fallon's decision to desert the winner in favour of Big Bad Bob here was responsible for the inflated price on a colt who showed potential when winning a competitive Doncaster maiden in October. Despite being hampered leaving the gates and finding himself in last place as Big Bad Bob was rushed to the front by jockey Kieren Fallon, he was able to keep tabs on his rivals as the leader proved awkward around the turns. Lengthening under pressure inside the final half-mile, he gathered in the long-time leader with 100 yards remaining before asserting for a comfortable score. "I thought he'd win about four out as he was travelling the best and they were struggling in front," Lynch, who was dumped after the post, explained. "He's a lovely big-striding horse and when the gaps came he took them." Kris Kin is not entered in the G1 Epsom Derby June 7, but connections will either supplement him or take the route of the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 1.

Coroner edged out Touch of Land to underline the form of the G2 Prix Noailles in which he was runner-up at this track last time Apr. 6. That day, he struggled to contend with the impressive winner Super Celebre (Fr), but had subsequent G2 Prix Greffulhe runner-up Jipapibaquigrafo back in third. Held up by Stephane Pasquier throughout a pedestrian early pace this time, he made steady progress on the outer in the straight to lead with a furlong remaining. Despite the persistent attentions of the runner-up and the threat of the late closer Risk Seeker, Coroner had enough in the tank to hold his slender margin in the drive to the line. "He is such a tough little colt and he always gives his best," conditioner Jean-Claude Rouget commented. "He must go for the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [at Chantilly June 1] now and the softer the ground there, the better."

Empire Maker Heading to Empire State

Juddmonte Farms' **Empire Maker** (Unbridled), second as the favorite in the G1 Kentucky Derby, will skip the May 17 G1 Preakness S. in favor of a tilt at the G1 Belmont S. June 8. "He's not running," said trainer Bobby Frankel. The second jewel in the Triple Crown did pick up another starter in **Senor Swinger** (El Prado {Ire}). The Lewis runner, who won the GIII Crown Royal American Turf S. last Friday, will be ridden by Pat Day.

Asian Heights was beaten a short head by Warrsan (Ire) in the G3 John Porter S. at Newbury on his latest start Apr. 12 and that level of form made him a confident choice among the Cheshire crowd. He did not let his supporters down, taking up where 2001 and 2002 winner St Expedit (Fr) left off for owner Jeff Pearce, conditioner Geoff Wragg and jockey Darryll Holland by providing that combination with their third consecutive renewal of this contest. He did so cleverly in the end, stalking the early pacesetter Compton Bolter in third before challenging three wide on the turn into the straight and getting on top at the furlong marker. "He's a horse that has become very relaxed in his races," Holland explained. "He just seems to go to sleep slightly early, but this track kept him interested and he was very much on his game all the way around and travelled beautifully. They didn't go over-quick, so it enabled me to get that pitch early--I was very happy from three out and picked up like a good horse." Although he is lightly raced due to injury and training setbacks, Asian Heights was deemed good enough to take his place in the line-up for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in October. He was subsequently disappointing when only 14th there, but Holland described that run as a "mystery" and owner Jeff Pearce is keen to revisit that hunting ground in the fall.

REPENT TO CLOVERLEAF Multiple graded-stakes winner **Repent** (Louis Quatorze--Baby Grace {Arg}, by Cipayo {Arg}), retired earlier this year with tendon problems, has been purchased by Cloverleaf Farm in Ocala, Florida for an undisclosed amount. Taylor Made Farm's Steve Castagnola brokered the deal on behalf of Jerry and Feye Bach's Select Stables, who raced the dark bay colt. "We are thrilled to add Repent to our stallion roster," said Brent Fernung, director of operations at Cloverleaf. "His precocity and great looks make him a perfect fit for us. He was a Derby favorite and arguably one of the best horses of his generation." A half brother to Canadian champion King Ruckus (Bold Ruckus),

Repent was a \$60,000 KEENOV weanling and a \$230,000 FTKJUL yearling before he developed into one of the top runners of his crop. At two, he captured the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. and was the runner-up to Johannesburg in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile while defeating Officer and Came Home. Repent was one the winter-book favorites for the Kentucky Derby and won both the GIII Risen Star S. and the GII Louisiana Derby prior to finishing second in War Emblem's GII Illinois Derby. He was given some time off after a chip was discovered and returned to run a bang-up second to Medaglia d'Oro in the GI Travers S. Aug. 24. Repent sustained a tendon injury when seventh in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Sept. 28 in what would be his final career start. He heads to stud with a record of 10-5-3-1 and earnings of \$1,255,660.
