FABRE FOUR?

Trainer Andre Fabre goes after his fourth victory in the G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Poulains, saddling the unbeaten **Clodovil (Ire)** (Danehill) today at Longchamp. Historically, the compact grey holds all the aces, as French-trained colts have surrendered the Classic to overseas raiders only five times since 1970. The three-year-old also took the best trial when winning the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau at this track Apr. 20. Three winners of that trial followed with a French 2000 Guineas win in the '90s; Landseer (GB), third in that prep, went on to success in this race a year ago. But Godolphin, who have provided an effective challenge to the domestic stronghold recently, hope to take home top prize with their sole representative **Bourbonnais (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}). Third in the UAE 2000 Guineas at Nad al Sheba Feb. 13, he then disappointed connections when fifth in the G2 UAE Derby Mar. 29. "Bourbonnais had a slightly frustrating winter in as far as he worked well, but then did not run as well as we hoped in the Guineas and Derby in Dubai," racing manager Simon Crisford said. "We are keen to try him back over a mile again before establishing a programme for the remainder of the season, but hopefully he will be a progressive sort." *French Guineas fields, p7*

ETOILE APPEAL

Nobody knows more about what it takes to win the G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Pouliches than Criquette Head-Maarek and she has a strong hand again today in **Etoile Montante** (Miswaki) and **Acago** (Royal Academy). Etoile Montante, second to Six Perfections (Fr) in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac in October, was favoured to make a successful return in the G3 Prix De La Grotte Apr. 20. She looked likely to do so deep stretch, but was worried out of the frame by **Maiden Tower (GB)** (Groom Dancer), **Fidelio's Miracle** (Mountain Cat) and **Welcome Millenium (Fr)** (Kendor {Fr}). That trio had experience on their side, having filled the same order in the Listed Prix la Camargo Mar. 25, but Etoile Montante may reverse placings with the benefit of that run. Acago suggested that a mile will be her forte after an impressive win in a conditions race Apr. 24. Both fillies have strong claims of providing Head-Maarek with her seventh renewal of this Classic since 1979.

MUCH ADO ABOUT NOTHING?

An explosive story printed in yesterday's *Miami Herald* suggested that Jose Santos may have carried a battery when riding **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) in the Kentucky Derby, but new developments may substantiate Santos' claims that he did not carry any illegal object in the race. The allegations stemmed from a photo of the Derby finish that ran in the *Herald*, but a black object that appeared to be in his left hand is not apparent in an enlargement of the photo. In addition, the primary author of the *Herald* story has admitted that he may have misunderstood Santos during an interview. Churchill Downs stewards announced yesterday that they have launched an investigation, but, within hours of the story breaking, the enlargement of the photo was being circulated by the Funny Cide camp. "It's absurd," trainer Barclay Tagg said. "Terry Meyocks [NYRA President] has had the picture blown up. It is clear as day. You can see right through his whole hand. You can see [Emire Maker's] colors and [his] ear. I don't know what they are talking about. They're nuts." It was also clear yesterday that Frank Carlson, the primary reporter on the *Herald* story, did not properly record Santos' comments. Santos was quoted as saying he was carrying a "cue ring," an object the report said was used to alert outriders. As it turns out, Santos was talking about a "Q ray" bracelet, which he wears on his left wrist to help control arthritis. Churchill Chief Steward Bernard Hettel was quoted in the *Herald* story as calling the photo "suspicious," but Karen Murphy, a lawyer representing Santos, countered, "The word suspicious used in this article is grossly misplaced. I can say with 100-percent certainty that the statements attributed to Jose Santos were absolutely not made by Jose Santos." Yesterday, Carlson released a statement in which he said, "It's quite possible that I misunderstood what he said and the language barrier could have been a problem." Santos, a native of Chile, speaks fluent English, but with an accent. Murphy, Santos and Santos' agent Mike Sellito will meet with Churchill stewards Monday.

Dynever stamped himself a serious contender for the June 8 GI Belmont S. with a breathtaking late run here. The heavy favorite off his facile 3 1/4-length score in the Apr. 5 Aventura S., the striking colt was bumped around at the break, then settled behind the early leaders while tucked in along the rail around the first turn. Jockey Edgar Prado opted to save ground again on the second turn, rather than angling out for running room, and, as they raced down the stretch, it looked as if that decision might cost him the race. Dynever was trapped behind a wall of horses, but a seam opened as the hit the eighth pole and he powered to the front to win as very much the best. "I knew I was on the best horse in the race," Prado said. "I waited some time just to find a hole and let him roll, and you saw what he did when we found that hole. He just exploded. Nothing was going to stop him. I was very impressed and I hope we can show them again next time." Trainer Christophe Clement, watching the race from New York, added, "We are all very happy. Storming Home, who beat subsequent G1 Dubai World Cup hero Moon Ballad (Ire) by a half length in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket last October, had not been out since running a lackluster 15th in the Nov. 24 G1 Japan Cup. Adding Lasix for his U.S. debut, the bay was away slowly, but moved up to track front-running favorite The Tin Man (Affirmed) as they raced down the backstretch. He forged to the lead as the pacesetter tired in the stretch and opened up a little daylight late for a comfortable score. "Things didn't really go according to plan," jockey Gary Stevens admitted. "We thought we were going to be laying closer much earlier. He didn't break real well, which is normal for horses coming from Europe. But I worked him here the other morning and had a really nice workout. It gave me a lot of confidence." Trainer Neil Drysdale said the winner's long-term goal is the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. House Party, on the board in her first six starts, finished fourth behind the ill-fated Midnight Cry in the Mar. 14 GIII Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream Park, but bounced right back last time. The 17-10 chalk in the Apr. 26 Legal Light S. at Delaware Park, she proved much the best, drawing off to win by 8 1/2 lengths. The gray, sent off the second choice against three rivals here, was a hard-held fourth as favored Cyber Secret cut out reasonable fractions. House Party forced her way between horses at the top of the stretch, collared the front runner and pulled away to another handy score. "The only way I can get her to relax is to put her right in between horses," jockey Jose Santos said. "When I asked her to run in the clear, she just took off." Trainer Allen Jerkens added, "She got a break today with it being only a four-horse race, and I guess the second horse wasn't as good today as she was last time [winning the Apr. 18 GIII Comely S.]. She finished full of run. I don't know what we'll do with her now. I haven't thought about that yet. She's had a lot of races so far this year." Randaroo (Gold Case), the second choice on the morning line, was scratched because of a lung infection. "She coughed on the track yesterday, so we scoped her and found a lot of mucous," trainer Tony Dutrow said. "I'll just put her on some antibiotics and look for another spot. A champion in his native country after winning the G1 Tanteo de Potrillos in June of 2001, Total Impact started just three times last year. Second by a half length to Essence of Dubai in the Mar. 23 G2 UAE Derby, he went to the sidelines after running fourth in an allowance at Hollywood Park May 8. The chestnut was away for 8 1/2 months and finished off the board in his first two tries this term, but turned the season around with a Santa Anita allowance score Mar. 22. He just missed in his latest, finishing second by a neck to Western Pride in the Apr. 5 GII San Bernardino H. The crowd's choice to go one better this time, he shadowed first Wooden Phone (Pick Up the Phone), then Palmeiro (Pleasant Tap) through solid splits. Total Impact came up alongside that one as they came out of the final turn, took command and held Fleetstreet Dancer safe to the wire. Hombre Rapido lived up to his name here, leading every step to earn his first stakes victory. The six-year-old was sidelined following a sixth in the the GIII Los Angeles H. June 2, but returned with a vengeance Dec. 20, setting a new track record of 1:01 3/5 for 5 1/2 furlongs in winning a \$62,500 optional claimer over a wet-fast Hollywood surface. He won again going six panels at Santa Anita Jan. 12, but got caught late in a similar test Mar. 19, finishing fourth to Men's Exclusive (Exclusive Ribot). The bay assumed his customary position at the head of affairs, made all the running with a :43.43 half and got to the wire a length clear of late-charging Publication. "He broke like a shot...and had enough wind to hold them off," said winning rider Jose Valdivia, Jr. "I think it validates it [his track record]." John Sadler, who last won the Los Angeles H. back in 1986 with Rosie's K.T., said, "He got sick after he ran this race last year, he had a fever. I sent him home to the ranch [in Corona]." Claimed for \$65,000 after running second by a neck over the Aqueduct inner track Mar. 12, Shake You Down is now a perfect three-for-three under new management. The chestnut caught sloppy tracks in his last two, going gate to wire to take an allowance race at the Big A by 7 1/2 lengths Apr. 11 and adding a front-running 5 1/4-length score over allowance foes 15 days later. Sent right to the front once again over a fast track, the 9-5 chalk dashed through a half in :44.65, then turned back the bid of Here's Zealous to make it three in a row. "He's fast and gutsy. I was a little concerned on the turn when Here's Zealous got close to us, but I had a lot of horse left," jockey Mike Luzzi said. Trainer Scott Lake added, "I was more worried about coming back on two weeks' rest as opposed to catching a dry track with him. Lightly raced Phantom Light was sent off as the second choice in this 12-horse field on the strength of an eight-length victory over course and distance Apr. 27 and drew off late to earn his first stakes victory. After a pair of losses at two, the Stronach homebred opened 2002 with a seven-length maiden score here at Woodbine, but was sidelined following an eighth in the Prince of Wales's S. last July. The grey colt returned to run fourth going seven-eighths in an Apr. 13 allowance test prior to his big win two weeks later. Breaking alertly, Phantom Light pressed the pace, put a head in front on the far turn and maintained a safe margin to the wire as third choice No Comprendre closed from last. "It's been a long time coming for this horse and it's just nice to see him reach his potential," said winning trainer Danny Vella. "He's always been a nice horse with a lot of talent. Question marks hang over any horse that goes to the unique track of Epsom Downs, but there will be none where Franklins Gardens is concerned when he lines up for the Derby June 7. Having already handled the uphill and downhill of the Surrey track admirably when taking the Blue Riband Trial S. Apr. 23, he hammered the point home with another fine balancing act on these undulations. Settled off the furious early pace carved out by the disappointing favourite Rainwashed Gold (GB) (Rainbow Quest), he made smooth progress from last position under Darryll Holland as the leaders started to capitulate. He took command with three furlongs remaining, quickened decisively and was always holding the persistent challenge of Let Me Try Again. "He's a very big horse and not the quickest out of the stalls and the others went like the clappers," Holland explained. "I thought I'd give him time to find his feet. He came good at the top of the hill and I knew I was on something special coming down." The colt is currently 33-1 for the Derby. **Click for the racingpost.co.uk chart.**

Mummify, the overwhelming choice to give trainer Lee Freedman his second win in this race, drove through from the inside as the field fanned wide on the final bend to win this Classic going away. Freedman was concerned when he saw his runner tucked in behind horses as they approached the stretch, but praised jockey Danny Nikolic's ride after the race. "I was very worried that he'd be buried in the field, but it's become a brilliant ride now," he told *Australian Associated Press*. "I thought he was the best horse in the race and just needed the right run to win--and that's how it panned out." Mummify, third in the G1 AJC Australian Derby, added this to his victory in last week's Veuve Cliquot S. He is favored in the early betting for the two-mile G1 Adelaide Cup May 19, but Freedman may opt to skip the race and give the gelding a break. "We'll see how he pulls up," he told *AAP*. "He's had a long campaign in three states. I've no doubt he'll run two miles, but it may not be best for the horse at this stage of his career. We might have to wait for the spring."

Empire Maker In, Then Out Of Preakness

It seems a longshot that Funny Cide will lose his victory in the GI Kentucky Derby, despite the ongoing investigation surrounding a photograph of the finish that may or may not show an object in jockey Jose Santos' hand, and trainer Bobby Frankel, who had briefly considered sending **Empire Maker** (Unbridled) to the May 17 GI Preakness S., will now go with his original plan and wait for the June 8 GI Belmont S. with the colt. Second as the favorite in the Derby, Empire Maker would be moved up to first in the unlikely event that Funny Cide is disqualified, thus making him a potential Triple Crown winner. Frankel's initial reaction was, "If they disqualify Funny Cide, even if it takes years in court, I got a shot at the Triple Crown. How can I not run? I don't know what the stewards are going to do, but they do say it looks suspicious. I had already resigned myself to the fact that I lost the Derby, and now, you never know. The drama continues." But, after reviewing tapes of the Derby, Frankel changed his mind, announcing he will skip the Preakness with **Empire Maker**, and instead will be saddling his stablemate **Peace Rules** (Jules) in the second leg of the Triple Crown.

Funny Cide Schools at Belmont Park

Unconcerned with the controversy surrounding his win in the Kentucky Derby, **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) took a tour of the Belmont Park paddock after the second race yesterday. The colt took two turns of the walking ring, was saddled, then took a couple more turns before being unsaddled. "I thought he needed more schooling," trainer Barclay Tagg explained. "This gave him another crowd to get used to. I wouldn't want to have to school him twice at Pimlico." The three-year-old is scheduled to have his final prep for the May 17 GI Preakness S. Tuesday at Belmont. It has not yet been decided when he will ship to Maryland. "I want to go to Baltimore as late as I can," Tagg said.

Champali Joins Preakness Field...Again

Champali (Glitterman), runner-up in the Gill Derby Trial last time out, is back in the picture for Preakness. "The distance is a question, but his style fits Pimlico, with the tight turns, perfectly, because he is a real athletic horse," trainer Greg Foley said. The colt will ship from Louisville Wednesday.

POMPEII DIES AFTER PADDOCK ACCIDENT

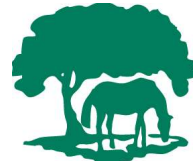
